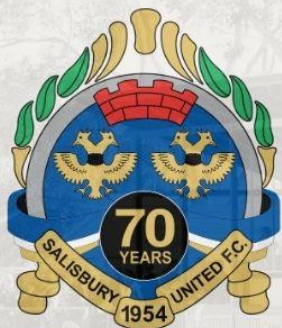

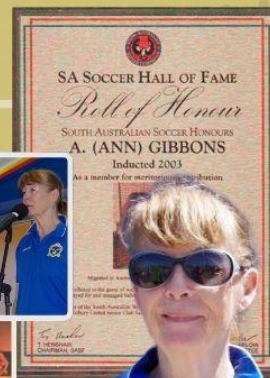

70th Anniversary LEGENDS



IRIS BUSH & ANN GIBBONS

The Bush name has been a cornerstone of Salisbury United FC since it was founded in 1954 by the late Bob Bush, a year after emigrating from Liverpool with his wife Iris and family.

Daughter Ann followed in her father's footsteps by developing a love for the game at an early age. She went on to help establish, play for and manage the first Women's team at Salisbury United and those that followed during the 1970s. Ann also took on the committee role of SUFC Secretary.

Ann was co-founder of the South Australian Women's Soccer Association in 1978 and became the club's delegate to SAWSA in 1978-80. In 2003 Ann was inducted into the Football SA Hall of Fame for her role in establishing SAWSA and for her contribution to the sport as a player and administrator.

Ann and Iris, both Life Members of Salisbury United FC, are held very dear by the entire club. They find immense joy in witnessing the shared passion of the volunteers who follow in the path they once blazed, and rarely miss a home match at the club.

As an early pioneer of women's football, it has been Ann's greatest pleasure to see the return of Women's teams to Salisbury and the establishment of new Junior Girls teams in the club's 70th season of football. Ann and Iris are true club icons.

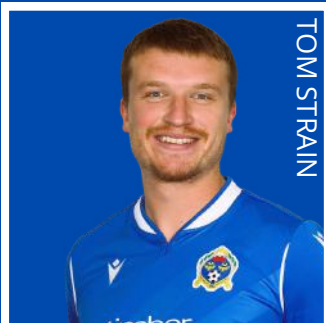

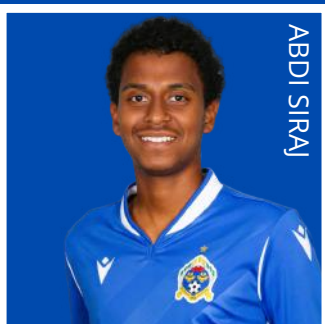

Around the Club

After years of watching games either side of a lightpole in the middle of the grand stand view, we are super excited to let our members and visitors know - the middle pitch poles are gone! This transformation was part of a Council grant to upgrade our main pitch lights to meet FSA lighting certification requirements. This week we turn on new LED lights around main pitch, which has also been moved closer to the fenceline, parallel to the grandstand. This change has allowed us to introduce 7 new small sided pitches to increase training and game day zones around the main pitch for our youngest players.

Our Senior Men's team will be first to play under the new LED lights when we meet Playford in the FSA Hahn Australia Cup Game at 7pm on Saturday 8th March. Get down to Burton to take in the match and the new view from the grandstand!

SUFC thank Salisbury Council for considering all club feedback for this ground improvement, when the existing infrastructure was no longer fit for purpose.

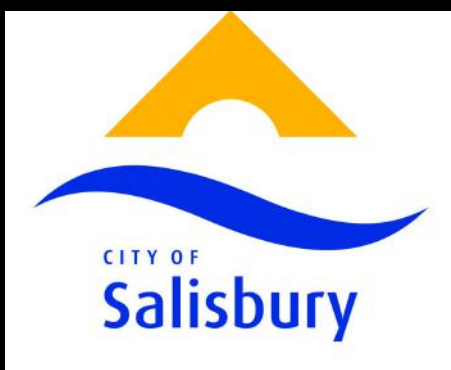

It has been an exciting pre-season for Salisbury United's women's squad. We've had a fantastic start, registering enough players to form 2 sides this year, with 10 players returning from last season. Our training sessions have been filled with commitment and dedication, despite a few reschedules due to heat, but the women have been putting in hard work and building strong momentum. We also had a lot of fun during our indoor training session at The Gardens Recreation centre.

What a start our SUFC Juniors have had to 2025!

Salisbury United is fielding 7 Junior teams this season filling all age groups Under 12s through to Under 16s in the newly structured YCC competition, along with teams for under 15s and Under 16s in the YSL competition. This growth is due to a high number of returning players and a welcoming of new players, their families and new coaches.

Pre-season started earlier than usual and presented us with some challenges; high temperatures caused cancellations to training sessions and organised trial games, then pitch repairs saw us training away from the club at Carisbrooke Park. Training off site however flipped a tricky logistical situation into a positive. Coaches and assistant coaches worked together, training as one big squad imparting their individual strengths into each other's teams. Not only did the pre-season bring our coaches together as a unit, it also helped the players gel across all age groups. This was an exciting exercise to witness and beneficial to all involved. The return to training at our home ground was welcomed by all and felt great, this brought a whole new level of unity to the group.

When the weather finally gave us a break and allowed trials to go ahead our juniors set out eagerly and in the last few weeks they have played Pontian Eagles, Northern Demons, Playford Patriots, Eastern United, Adelaide Blue Eagles with our biggest hit out being last weekend, as SUFC hosted our entire cohort of junior teams to play Para Hills Knights. A huge day of 7 games kicking off at 8am and wrapping up at 6pm. To say we have a dedicated and passionate group is an understatement.

Some results have gone our way and others haven't during our pre-season trial games, but all games have displayed the continued development and determination of the players. None of our pre-season would have been possible without the core group of Coaches, Team Managers and volunteers that we are lucky enough to have at SUFC.

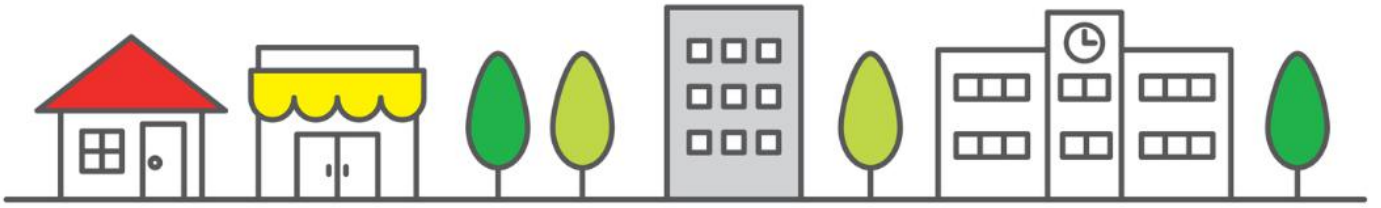

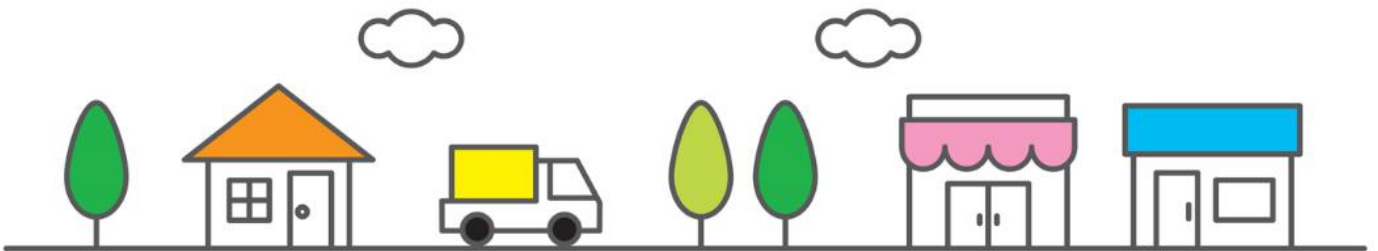
