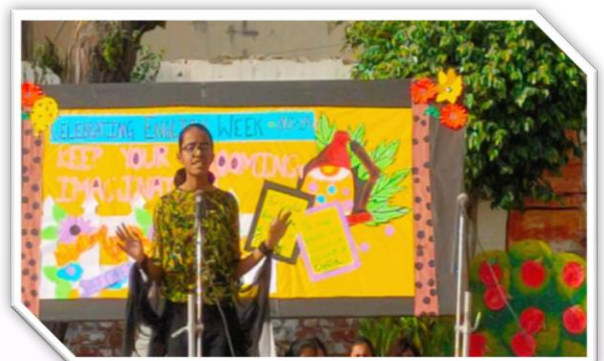
SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES

By the early 2020s, there were over 500 space travellers, representing over 40 different countries, with over 10% of them being female. At the same time, China, Russia and the United States were the only nations with the capability of sending people into space. Following the Space Shuttle's retirement in 2011, the United States lost the ability to carry out autonomous human spaceflight. This capability wasn't regained until 2020, when SpaceX's Crew Dragon—a brand-new, private commercial spacecraft—arrived.

Space travel for humans is expensive and risky. Between the first crewed Soyuz spacecraft crash landing in 1967 and the shuttle orbiter Columbia breaking in 2003, eighteen people lost their lives in spaceflights. The cost of supplying the systems that sustain crew members during their orbital stay increases dramatically for space missions. Highly reliable yet costly equipments are needed to provide the safest possible launch and flight.

They contend that robotic missions can produce equivalent or even superior scientific results at lesser costs and that there is no other plausible reason why humans would be in space. Proponents of human spaceflight emphasize that when it comes to carrying out particular experiments in orbit, repairing and maintaining robotic spacecraft and automated instruments in orbit, and acting as explorers on the first missions to other planets in our solar system, humans are still superior in terms of intelligence, adaptability, and dependability.
