**All Players, Coaches, Sports Trainers (including League Safe Officers), Match Officials, Club Officials, Volunteers, Parents/Carers and Spectators.**

Participants are encouraged and expected to:

- Show positive acts of sportsmanship, discouraging all instances of foul or illegal play, or acts of violence, both on and off the field.
- Demonstrate the greatest levels of respect, protecting the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability / disability, sexual orientation, cultural background or religion.
- Lead by positive example, and condemn the use of recreational and performance enhancing drugs and doping practices; their use endangers the health of players and is contrary to the concept of fair play.
- Celebrate the "good news" stories, and understand that cyber-bullying, which includes negative or demeaning comments, status posts, personal messages or emails, is deemed as a serious form of harassment.
- Accept that the integrity of the sport is of paramount importance, therefore, no coach, player, Club official or match official is allowed to participate, or be directly or indirectly involved in any way, in gambling.

Grand Final day is special for many reasons, and this is enhanced as today we welcome the Junior Coastal competition Grand Finals for a genuine Super Saturday of rugby league in the tropics. Eight premier matches to be played from Under 13 through to A Grade will help ensure a bumper crowd and atmosphere throughout the day. The atmosphere generated by the team supporters will go a long way to creating the memories the players take with them from today, and it is with this in mind that we must look to ensuring this is as positive as possible. As we will hear Slammin' Sammy Thaiday announce numerous times today, "It's positive or it's pointless". Good luck to everyone, may the competition be tight, the quality high, and may the best teams win.

# GREEN SOCKS CAMPAIGN



IF THEIR SOCKS ARE **GREEN**  
THEY ARE **UNDER 18**

The "If their socks are **GREEN**, they are **UNDER 18**" campaign aims to create a positive environment for referees under the age of 18 in the Queensland Rugby League. Referees in this age group wear green socks to signify their age and status.

The campaign advocates for treating these young referees with respect, refraining from abuse, and understanding that they are still learning, just like the players. By fostering a supportive atmosphere, the campaign aims to enhance the experience for young referees and contribute to their development in officiating rugby league matches.

## Key Pillars:

### 1 Respect

Treat young referees with the same respect you would expect for yourself or others. Their age does not diminish the importance of their role on the field.

### 3 Patience

Understand that young referees are still developing their skills and may make mistakes. Exercise patience and provide constructive feedback.

### 5 Learning Together

Remember that everyone, including referees, is constantly learning and improving. Approach each game as an opportunity to grow and develop skills.

### 7 Fair Play

Uphold the principles of fair play and sportsmanship, showing respect for the game and its participants.

### 9 Feedback

Provide constructive feedback in a respectful manner, focusing on areas for improvement while acknowledging successes.

### 2 Encouragement

Offer words of encouragement and support, recognizing the challenging nature of their role and the learning process they are undergoing.

### 4 Role Models

Be a positive role model for young referees by demonstrating good sportsmanship and respect for officials.

### 6 Supportive Environment

Create a supportive environment where young referees feel comfortable asking questions and seeking guidance.

### 8 Lead by Example

Lead by example, showing respect for all participants on the field and setting a positive tone for others to follow.

### 10 Enjoyment

Remember that rugby league is a game meant to be enjoyed by all. By supporting young referees, we contribute to the overall enjoyment and success of the game.

- › Make decisions in the best interests of the game of Rugby League.
- › Place the safety and welfare of players as the top priority.
- › Accept responsibility for all decisions made.

## Code of Conduct – Parent / Spectator

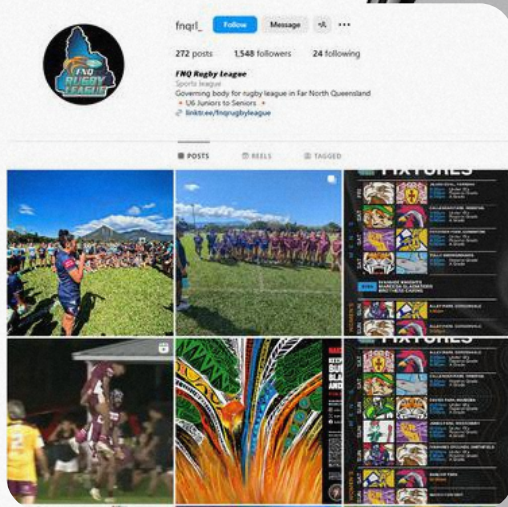
- › Condemn all violent or illegal acts, whether they are by players, coaches, officials, parents or spectators.
- › Respect the Referee's decisions – don't complain or argue about decisions during or after a game.
- › Behave! Unsportsmanlike language, harassment or aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated.
- › Encourage players to play by the rules and to respect opposition players and officials.
- › Never ridicule or scorn a player for making a mistake – respect their efforts.
- › Understand that sport is part of a total life experience, and the benefits of involvement go far beyond the final score of a game.
- › Participate in positive cheering that encourages the players in the team you are supporting; do not engage in any cheering that taunts or intimidates opponents, their fans or officials.
- › Remember that all participants are involved in the game of Rugby League for their own enjoyment, not yours!
- › At all times, follow the directions of the Ground Manager and/or other duty officials.
- › Never arrive at a Junior League game under the influence of alcohol, never bring alcohol to a Junior League game and only drink alcohol, if it is available, in a responsible manner in the designated licensed area.

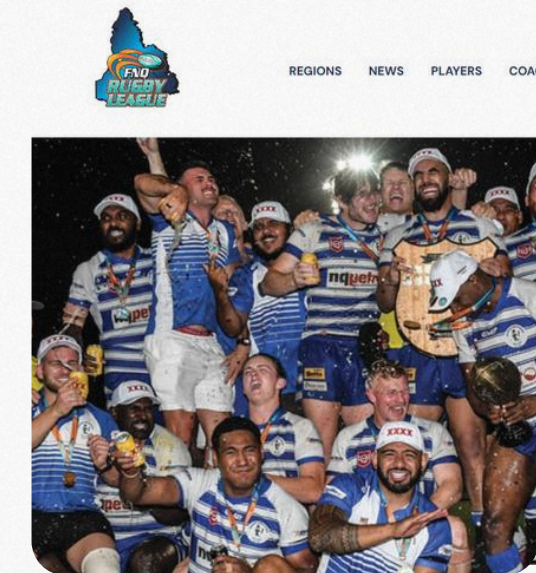

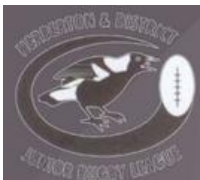
