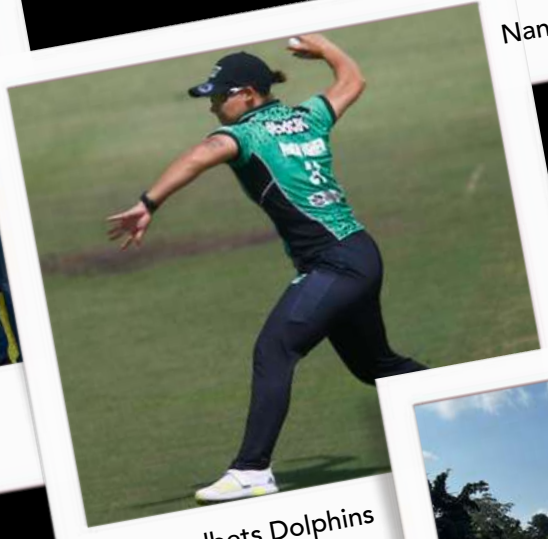

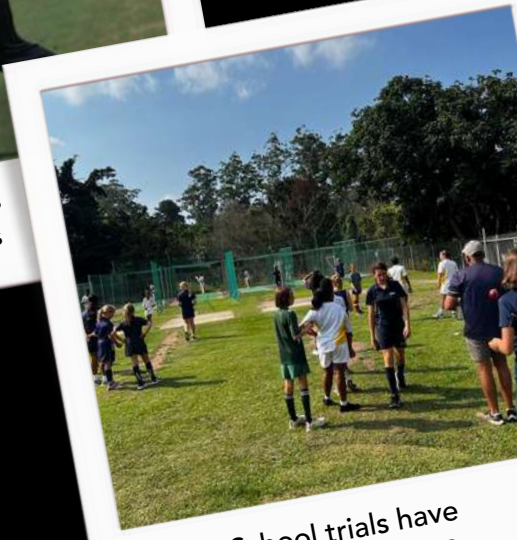

Hollywoodbets Dolphins all-rounder Jason Smith was the big winner at the Hollywoodbets Dolphins end of season awards, as he took home the Player of the Year and the Players' Player of the Year awards.

Smith played a crucial role with the bat in the Hollywoodbets Dolphins' successful CSA 4-Day Series. He finished as the Hollywoodbets Dolphins' highest run scorer and ended the competition with an average of nearly 56. The middle order batsman played a number of crucial knocks in the competition, but his 136 against North West helped set up a dominant win that was crucial in helping the Hollywoodbets Dolphins to a second competition title in three seasons. Smith also produced some fine performances with the bat in the One Day Cup which saw him finish as the Hollywoodbets Dolphins' second highest run scorer.

Preelan Subrayen was announced as CSA 4-Day Series Player of the Year as he finished the tournament as the highest wicket-taker for the Hollywoodbets Dolphins and the second highest wicket-taker in the tournament. Subrayen finished the competition with two five wicket hauls and one ten wicket haul which included best match figures of 11/97 against the Titans.

From a 50 over cricket perspective, the player of the Year went to one of the Hollywoodbets Dolphins' best break-out players Brad Porteous. Porteous made an immediate impact on the side and scored one century and fifty in the tournament that saw him finish as the Hollywoodbets Dolphins leading run scorer.

The CSA T20 Challenge Player of the Year nominees were Grant Roelofsen, Ottniel Baartman and Eathan Bosch with all three playing important roles in the Hollywoodbets Dolphins' charge to the final of the tournament. Ultimately it was Grant Roelofsen who won the award after a superb campaign that saw him finish as the tournament's leading run scorer with an average of 47.57 and 132.66 strike rate.

"We would like to congratulate all award winners and thank them for all they contributed to the Hollywoodbets Dolphins over the past season," President of the KZN Cricket Union, Yunus Bobat said. "The Hollywoodbets Dolphins had another season to remember, and we must commend the entire squad on their efforts throughout the season. The management, coaches and players can be very proud of all their efforts, and we look forward to building onto this next season."



The CEO of KZN Cricket, Heinrich Strydom, was complimentary of the players for what was another enthralling season of cricket both at Hollywoodbets Kingsmead Stadium and around the country. "It was another exciting season for the Hollywoodbets Dolphins and to win the CSA CSA 4-Day Series for the second time in three seasons was far and above the highlight," Strydom said. "Once again the players showed incredible character to claim four wins in a row to win the competition and it's very encouraging to see many different players sticking up their hands and contributing. A huge congratulations to all the prize winners - but it's a complete squad effort and we are very proud of what the players produced this season."

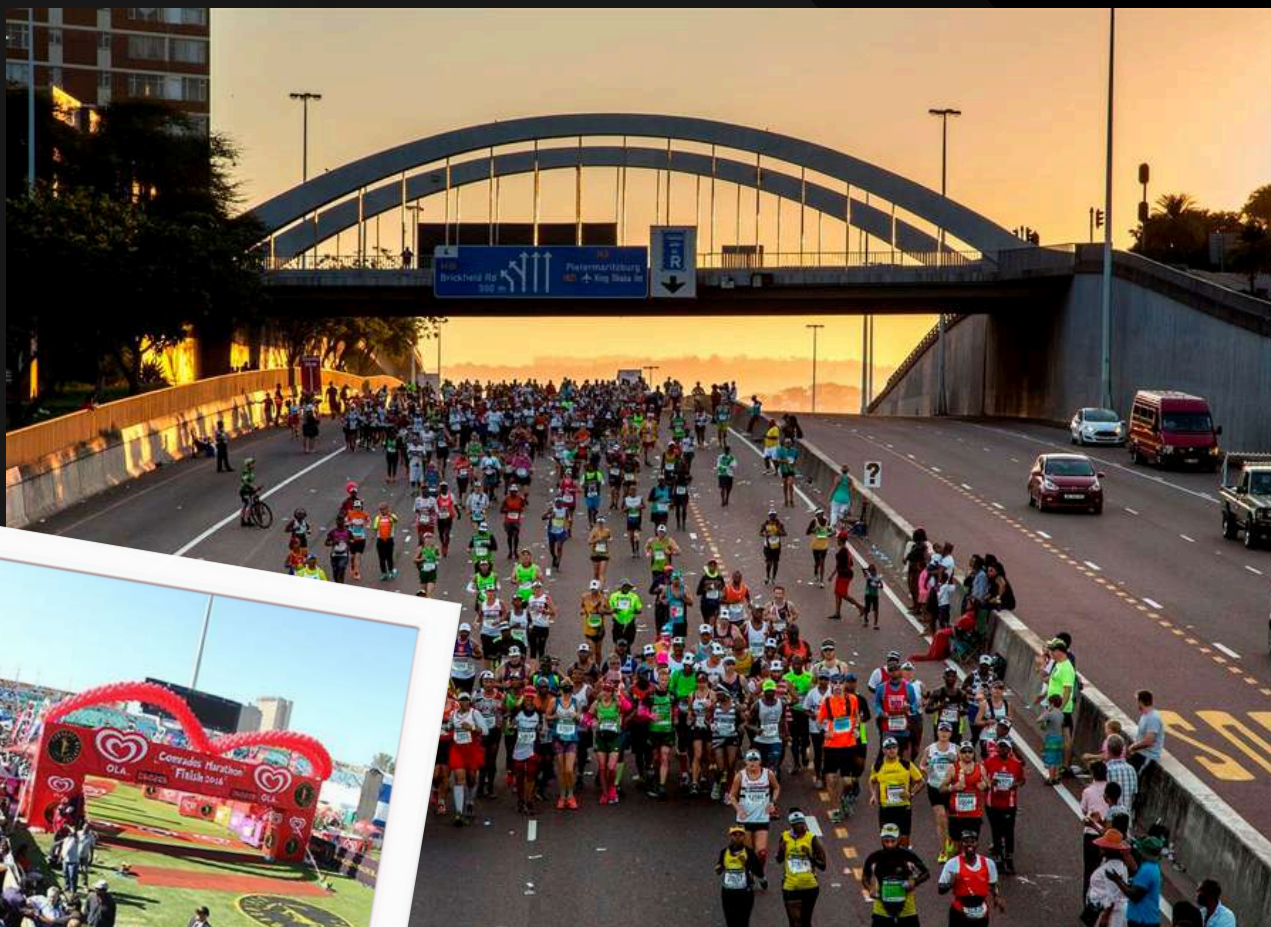
Hollywoodbets Kingsmead to host Comrades Marathon finish
