In June 2019 the club formally changed its structure to a Community Amateur Sports Club. Today the club has roughly 220 players spanning four adult teams. Furthermore, the club supports Rudgwick Junior Football Club, Chesworth Rovers Football and Rudgwick Veterans. The aim of Rudgwick FC is to make football available to all members of our community. The club is looking to defend its Centenary Cup victory from season 2023-2024 this season for the first time in its history.
