Registration Information & Policies



Registration Information

Registration is required for the majority of activities. Summer registration will be accepted beginning February 1 of each year at the Parks and Recreation Department and online (some items may not be available for online reservation / registration). Please keep in mind that when you register for an activity, we depend on your enrollment to ensure a successful program. Preregistration is required for some activities to give staff adequate preparation time. Be sure to note registration deadlines for various activities. All activities are subject to minimum enrollment requirements. If that requirement is not met, the activity will be canceled. Effective Oct. 1, 2024, the City of Kerrville will charge a three-percent (3%) fee on all credit card transactions. This includes purchases / reservations / registrations completed in person, over the phone, or online. All activities, policies, information, and fees are subject to change.

Special Event Applications

Interested in hosting a community event in our parks system or City property? Please contact our office to begin the Special Event Application process. Pursuant to City ordinance section 74-4 (b), a Special Event Permit is required for any public event on city property, including streets.

Accessibility

The City of Kerrville promotes participation regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, religion, or disability. Upon request, reasonable accommodations or modifications may be provided as necessary in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. For assistance or to request reasonable accommodations, please call (830) 257-7300.

Cancellation Policy

Items (sites, reservations, facilities, programs, and events) may be changed or canceled without notice. If you are not completely satisfied with your service, please contact us so we can respond to your concerns. Cancellation of a reservation or program with at least 48 hours' notice will result in a \$25 surcharge per item and a refund of any remaining balance. Cancellations within 48 hours will not be eligible for a refund and will result in forfeiture of the first night paid fees at Kerrville-Schreiner Park, whichever is applicable. No full refunds will be given unless the department cancels or is otherwise noted. Some events / programs will not allow a refund under any circumstance and are noted as such in descriptions.

Photo Policy

The City of Kerrville reserves the right, and may give permission to the media, to photograph classes, programs, and participants at any of our facilities and properties or any sponsored activity. Please be aware that these photos are for promotional purposes and may be used in future publications and media communications in any format.

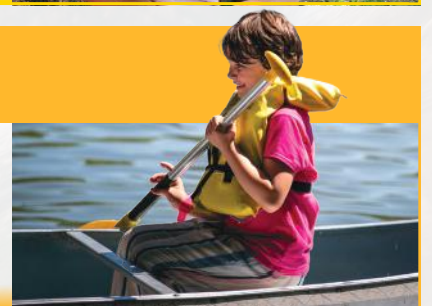

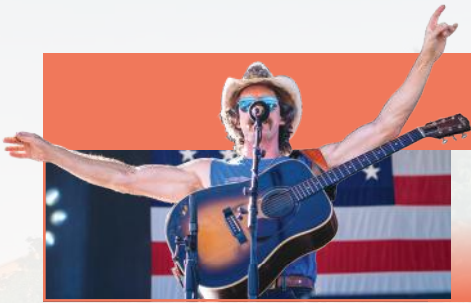

Singing Wind Improvements

Improvements to Singing Wind Park may include a disc golf course, contingent on budget. Singing Wind Park was the number one priority park identified for improvements in the Parks and Recreation Master Plan Update in 2022.

Cailloux Theater

The Cailloux Theater, owned by the City of Kerrville, will undergo a roof replacement and heating and cooling system improvements. The project is expected to commence in the Spring of 2025. The theater will be closed while the facility undergoes improvements.

Granger MacDonald Park

The project will develop the 1-acre parkland on the south side of Nimitz Lake. Development is expected to include a parking lot, a ramp suitable for launching kayaks, sailboats, and other non-combustion engine watercraft by dolly or carried (no vehicular access), a riverfront boardwalk, and handicap-accessible piers.

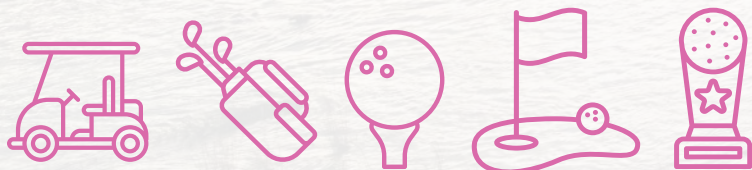
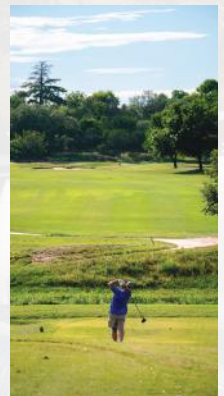

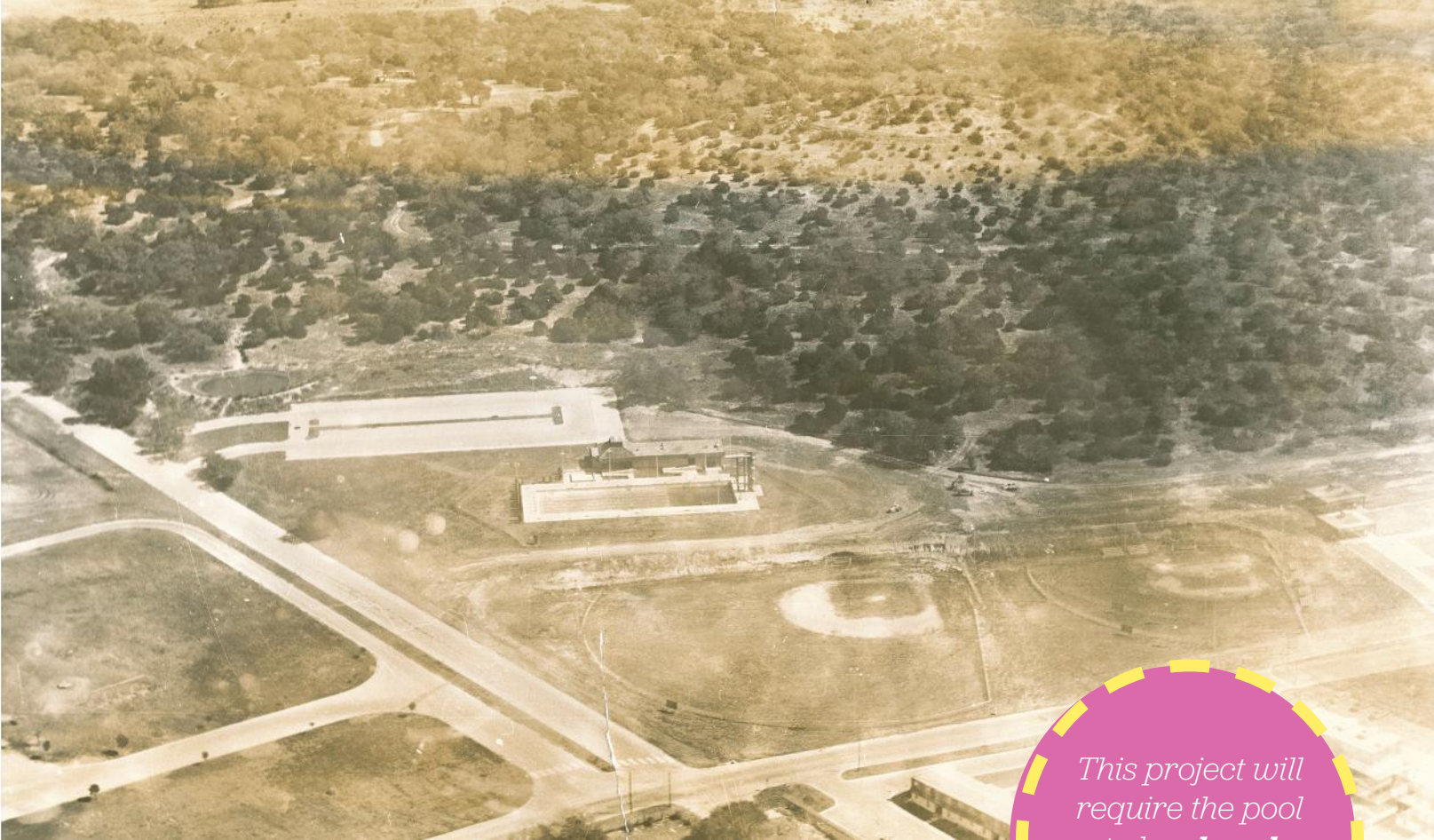

Olympic Pool Enhancements

The Olympic Pool Improvement Project was included in the sales tax revenue bond package for \$7,000,000.

Improvements Will Include:

Modifying the existing pool for an outdoor competition pool, building improvements, code compliance, and maintenance issues.

Construction expected to take place in 2025 and part of 2026.

A phased approach to the goal of a year-round facility would likely occur and may take several years to accomplish due to operations, funding, and staffing ability.

Once the project is complete, it would allow for a competitive summer swim program and an extended season contingent on budget and staff.

- No trespassing. Authorized users only.
- The use of the Kerrville Sports Complex requires a reservation.
- No alcohol is allowed in or on the facility grounds.
- No glass containers.
- Firearms prohibited unless allowed by state law.
- No pets allowed in the facility (service animals are welcome).
- Smoking (including electronic vaping devices) and tobacco are prohibited.
- Abusive or vulgar language prohibited.
- No skateboards, bicycles, scooters, roller blades or roller skates are allowed in the facility.
- No drones, generators, or grills allowed in facility.
- No artificial noise makers or air horns allowed in facility.
- Metal cleats are prohibited.
- Driving stakes, posts, or any other device for the purpose of securing tents or other structures is prohibited.
- No playing in irrigation sprinklers.
- For emergencies, call 911.
- All City ordinances apply.
- Additional rules may be enforced as deemed necessary by staff.

The City of Kerrville Sports Complex is a beautiful, high-quality 104-acre complex for baseball, softball, and soccer. This sports tourism facility provides a place for our local community to play in addition to providing an indirect economic impact to the community through hotel / motel and sales tax via tourism.

The complex features 11 lighted baseball / softball fields, 19 soccer fields, a D-BAT pro shop with merchandise, batting machines and hitting lanes, concessions, and a turf T-Ball field.

The Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department's Sports Complex Division maintains the complex and utilizes effluent (reclaimed) water to irrigate the sports fields instead of potable (drinking) water to help protect our resources. D-BAT, the City's tenant, provides the programming for the baseball / softball side and operates the indoor facility. Local soccer organizations provide youth programming for the soccer side. Reservations are required for field usage.

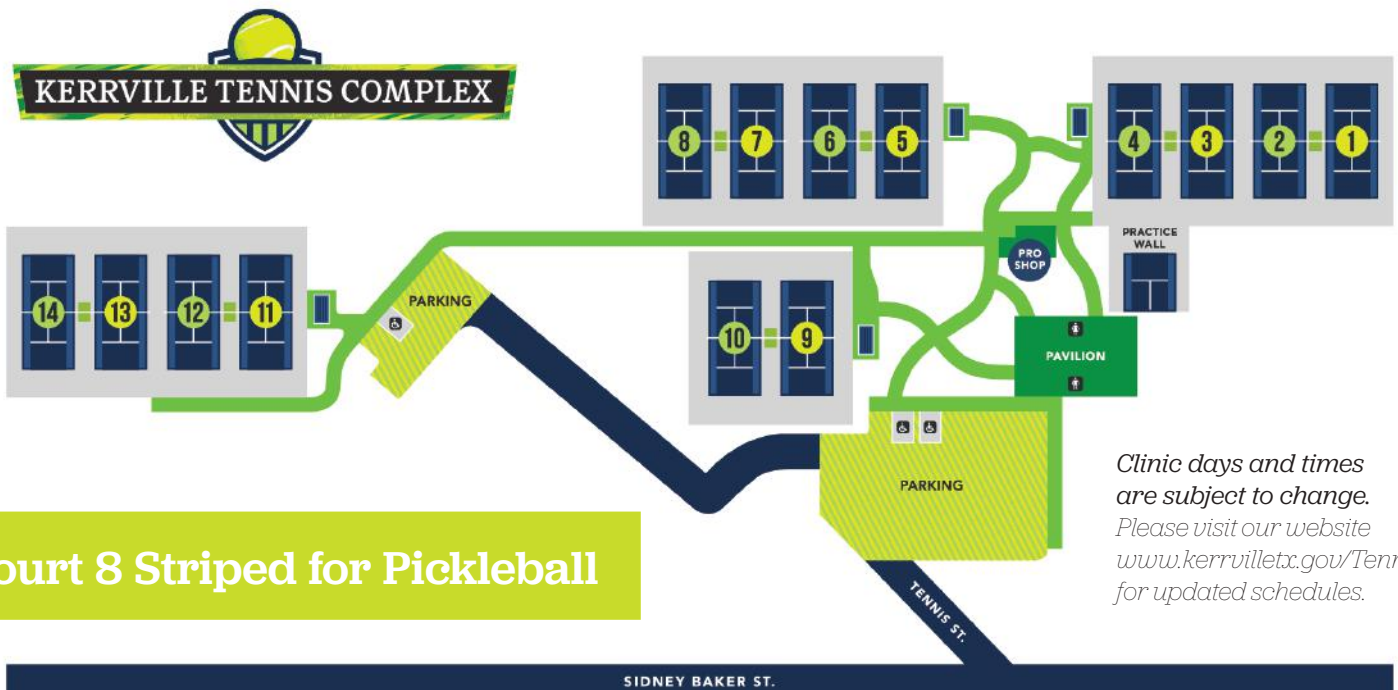

Kerrville River Trail

The Kerrville River Trail is an approximately six mile hike and bike trail along the Guadalupe River, with trailheads located at Kerrville-Schreiner Park, Birkdale, G Street, Lehmann-Monroe Park, Louise Hays Park, Riverside Nature Center, Lowry Park, the Dietert Center, and Schreiner University. The River Trail project has been funded mostly via the Economic Improvement Corporation 4b sales tax entity as a quality of life economic development project and property taxes were not used to build the vast majority of the River Trail.

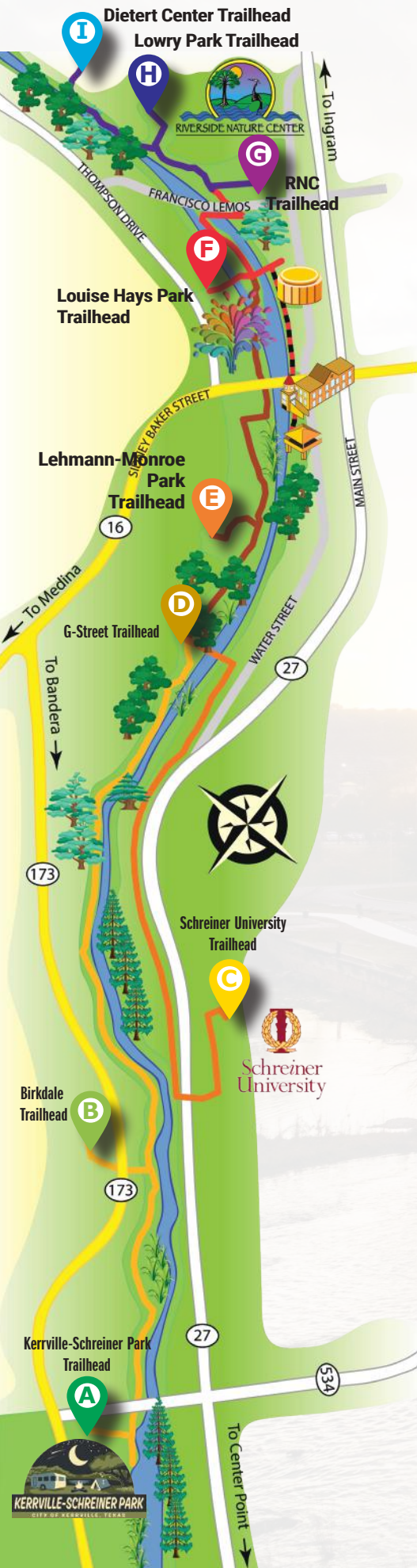

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Trail use during daylight hours only, dawn to dusk.
- Stay on trail.
- Motorized vehicles and equipment, including bikes, golf carts, utility carts, motorized hover boards, etc. are prohibited. Motorized wheelchairs welcome.
- Dogs are to be leashed at all times. Leashes must be kept short and pets controlled as to not impede others.
- Please clean up after your pets.
- Never approach or feed a wild animal.
- No skateboards.
- No smoking, including vaping and e-cigarettes.
- Observe all signs and do not go around barricades.
- All park rules and city ordinances apply. Additional rules may be enforced.

TRAIL ETIQUETTE

- Observe park and trail regulation and warning signs.
- Always stay to the right side of the trail, whether walking, running or biking.
- When approaching slower moving traffic with the intention of passing, let the slower trail users know you are behind them, and intend to pass on their left.
- Never leave the trail unless inside one of the public parks - much of the trail is on private property and we don't want trespassing to occur.
- Always carry a charged cell phone.
- Be aware of your surroundings and know where you are on the trail at all times in case you have to call for assistance or need to notify authorities about a situation - maps are located at each trailhead.
- Be aware of weather conditions and do not put yourself or others in danger during inclement weather.
- Hydrate before any physical activity and check your bike before starting so you don't have to be rescued by others.

Kerrville-Schreiner Park to G Street

This extension of the River Trail was opened in June 2015 and is just a little under 2 miles. It connects Kerrville-Schreiner Park to G Street. There are three trailheads for this extension of the trail: Kerrville-Schreiner Park, Birkdale, and G Street (near the bridge).



G Street to Schreiner University

This extension of the River Trail was opened in September 2020. This 1 mile long addition to the River Trail connects Schreiner University and surrounding neighborhoods to the trail system.



G Street to Louise Hays Park

This extension of the River Trail was opened in June 2015 and is a little over 1 mile. It connects Louise Hays Park to G Street. There are three trailheads for this extension of the trail: G Street (near the bridge), Lehmann-Monroe Park, and at the west end of the Louise Hays Park.



Louise Hays Park to Riverside Nature Center

The first section of the River Trail was opened in December 2012 and crosses the Guadalupe River over to Tranquility Island. On this 0.5 mile long stretch, you are able to walk amongst the cypress trees, and take in the natural beauty Kerrville has to offer.



Riverside Nature Center to Dietert Center

This extension of the River Trail is a little over 0.5 mile long connecting the Riverside Nature Center to the Dietert Center. Trailheads along this extension are located at the Riverside Nature Center, Lowry Park (opened May 2016) and the Dietert Center (opened November 2018)



On the next few pages, you will find descriptions of Kerrville's municipal parks. While access is free to most of the facilities within the Kerrville parks system, some facilities require a reservation, or have restricted access.

Park Rental Reservations

Rental reservations require 48-hour advance notice. Reservations for Sundays must be made before 2:00 p.m. on the preceding Friday. City Parks are open from dawn to 11 p.m.; unless otherwise designated.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Entering the water from dams, bridges, trees, streets, or any other dangerous act is prohibited.
- Use of jug / trot lines, and throw lines are prohibited.
- Motorized watercrafts are prohibited.
- Swim at your own risk.
- Smoking prohibited (including e-cigarettes).
- Motorized vehicles in designated parking and on roadways only.
- Rental times for the majority of park amenities is 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.; unless otherwise designated.
- No ground fires, graffiti, vandalism, glass containers, or firearms (unless allowed by state law).
- Dogs are to be leashed at all times; please clean up after your pets.
- Vending or sales without permit is prohibited.
- Organized group use, events, and bounce houses require a permit.
- Golfing, overnight camping / sleeping / parking is prohibited.
- Altering or disruption of vegetation, park land, and wildlife is prohibited.
- Feeding or interacting with wild / feral animals is prohibited.
- All city ordinances apply.
- Additional rules may be enforced.
- For emergencies, call 911.
- All staff have discretion and final authority over rule enforcement and must be adhered to.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Please remove dog from leash while inside the vestibule and before entering either side of the dog park. (Dogs must be leashed when leaving the Dog Park).
- All Dogs entering the small dog side must be no larger than the dog outline shown on the fence (18 inch height).
- Dog handlers are required to pick up their pet's waste and dispose in supplied containers.
- No dog can be left unattended.
- Children under 10 years of age must be under adult supervision at all times.
- Infants and small children are not permitted in the dog park. Dogs can act aggressively against small children, especially when children are running.
- Dog handlers are responsible for animals. Aggressive dogs must be muzzled or vacate the park.
- Dogs with a history of dangerous behavior are prohibited.
- Limit 2 dogs per handler.
- Dog handlers must fill in any hole their dog digs.
- Dogs must be properly licensed, vaccinated, and wearing tags.
- Puppies under 4 months old should not enter the park. They should be kept away from the dog park for their protection and that of other dogs.
- Female dogs in heat are not permitted in the dog park.
- Do not bring human or dog food inside the dog park.
- No dog training is to occur inside the dog park.
- Additional rules will be enforced to ensure safety of our guests.
- Failure to follow rules may result in expulsion from the facility.
- In case of emergency, call 911.

Kerrville-Schreiner Park | 2385 Bandera Highway

Kerrville-Schreiner Park is a beautiful 517-acre recreation and camping park on the Guadalupe River. Our park is home to an abundance of wildlife, including whitetail and blackbuck antelope, axis deer, rabbits, fox, birds, butterflies, and more. Full hook-up water / electric and sewer RV sites (30 / 50 amp), tent sites, cabins, dining / recreation halls, hike / bike trails, River Trail access, playground, volleyball / basketball courts are also available in this secure, family-oriented park.

History

Kerrville-Schreiner Park began as a city park built by the Civilian Conservation Corps in the 1930's. It was then deeded to the State of Texas and became a State Park. In 2004, Kerrville-Schreiner Park was transferred back to the City of Kerrville under authority of Texas House Bill 2108 76 Legislature.

- Only one unit per site is permitted to hook up to utilities; a maximum of 8 people per campsite.
- No pets in day use area or in water; adhere to signage available at the water front.
- No smoking throughout the park (including e-cigarettes).
- Campsite transfers are only permitted upon receipt of a new permit.
- Valid permit is required for each vehicle in the park.
- All vehicles, motorcycles, 4-wheelers, and golf carts are to remain on the designated roadways.
- No motorized vehicles on trails.
- Numbered sites are for overnight camping only.
- No gathering of firewood throughout the park.
- Maximum stay for RV / travel trailers is three months.
- Maximum two week stay for all tent sites.
- No site jumping unless prior arrangements are made with office staff.
- Firearms prohibited unless allowed by state law.
- All city ordinances apply. Additional rules may be enforced.

Expecting additional guests? The Carriage House can sleep up to 6 additional guests and has been fully furnished with two sets of bunk beds, a queen size bed, a microwave, a compact refrigerator, and full bathroom. The Carriage House must be rented in conjunction with the Ranch House, it is not rented on its own.

Fee: \$100 + \$100 deposit



Recreation Hall

The Recreation Hall is located on the Riverside of the park. It is an enclosed facility with central air/heat and has a maximum capacity of 100 people. It is also available as a day use or overnight rental. It includes indoor restrooms, kitchen, large serving counter top, and a large outdoor grill. Perfect for a wedding reception, family reunion, or birthday party.

Fee: \$375 + \$150 deposit
