DEAR BISHOP KELLY FAMILY, FRIENDS, AND ALUMNKIGHTS,

Greetings. I hope you are enjoying the latest edition of the *Roundtable* magazine. There are so many things that our community should be proud of as we reflect on the past and look forward to a great future. Sincere thanks to Katie Hays for her extraordinary efforts on putting this magazine together each year.

As a school principal, one of my greatest fears is to experience a sudden loss of one of our students, faculty, or staff members. Every spring, as summer draws near, that fear peaks and I pray that our students will return safely in the fall when we resume the next school year. As a parent, the sudden loss of a child is unimaginable and is every parent's worst nightmare.

On a very rainy Sunday evening, this past June 12, my greatest fear as both a principal and as a father came true. My only son, Braden, along with his good friend and classmate, Henry Warner, were tragically killed in a car accident. In an instant, my life, my family's life, and the lives of so many others, changed forever. It still doesn't seem real as I type the words. Braden and Henry were so full of life and laughter, and were both kind hearted to their core. They were each just beginning the summer following their sophomore year and had big plans for a fun, adventurous summer with family and friends. These boys were a joy to be around and have left a deep gash in our hearts with their premature deaths.

As a family and as a school, we will never be whole again after this tragic loss. While we are still in the midst of relearning how to fully breathe again, we still have

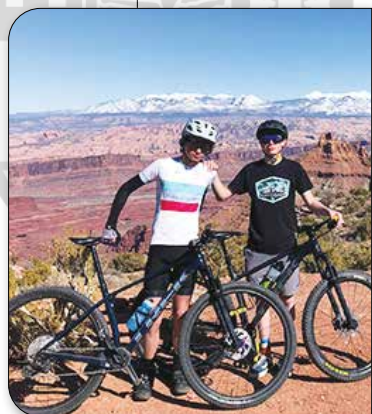
much to be grateful for. Just as there's not enough room in this magazine to tell you all the different ways Braden and Henry will be missed and how much their short time on earth impacted so many, there's also not enough room to tell you the many ways we've been lifted up by our families, friends, and by our community.

In particular, we've been so grateful for our Bishop Kelly community during this nightmare. When I stumbled onto this campus as a college student in 1994, begging Coach Brennan to allow me to be a volunteer on his football coaching staff, I had no idea of how this place would impact my life and my family's life so many years later. As I sit here today, 28 years after serving as a volunteer assistant freshmen football coach, after 17 years as a Bishop Kelly employee, and in my ninth year of serving as Principal, I feel grateful beyond words for this community. The outpouring of support my family received in the wake of our family's tragedy and still receive today has been overwhelming. We often speak of the strength of the "BK Community," and over the years I've seen this community come together in profound ways to support others. I couldn't be more proud or grateful to be part of the BK Family.

In closing, thank you Bishop Kelly family, friends, and colleagues. My family and I are eternally grateful for this wonderful community and I am so proud to be a Knight. Enjoy this year's edition of the *Roundtable*.

EVERYBODY READS

Bishop Kelly began a new initiative this school year called "Everybody Reads" as one more effort to raise the bar for Academic Excellence. The statistics on reading in the U.S. indicate that "people aged 15-44 in the U.S. spend 10 minutes or less per day reading" (Bureau of Labor Statistics), while "43 million U.S. adults possess low literacy skills" (NCES). Everybody Reads is 40 minutes of dedicated, quiet, structured time to read a book every Tuesday morning. Everybody Reads time is focused on building reading skills, comprehension, and a renewed interest in reading books, which will directly impact all academic disciplines and strengthen our focus on Academic Excellence.

What are you reading?

I am reading *The Nazi Officer's Wife*, by Edith H. Beer. It is a true story about a Jewish Woman who survived the Holocaust by hiding in plain sight. I have really enjoyed Everybody Reads because it gives me time in the day to unwind and relax. – Mr. Markosian

BISHOP KELLY'S SECRET GARDEN

Bishop Kelly's Legacy Garden was created by the Class of 2009 with a lot of help from (now retired) English faculty member, Andrea Symmonds. Each spring, BK seniors in Mrs. Symmonds' English classes would plant and tend the garden, donating the produce to local food banks. In 2018 Global Gardens worked with BK to find a new American family to work the garden space to grow food for their family. In 2021 BK began to manage the garden space through our horticulture class. Our students, with oversight from BK's horticulture teacher, Ms. Dana Hopper-Kelly and two members of our maintenance team, Cecelia

Flores and Sarah Mukandutiye, have the Legacy Garden teeming with delicious produce! Beans and tomato plants climb corn stalks, peppers grow intertwined with zinnias and tomatillos, and found objects like classroom stools and shovel handles serve as stakes for everything from eggplants to sunflowers.

WE ARE ONE SPORTS MINISTRY

The We Are One initiative, launched last school year at Bishop Kelly, is aimed at developing strong Christian values in our student athletes. This program is built on the philosophy that participation in athletics serves Christian students well, and helps to equip them with the tools they need to fulfill God's purpose in their lives.

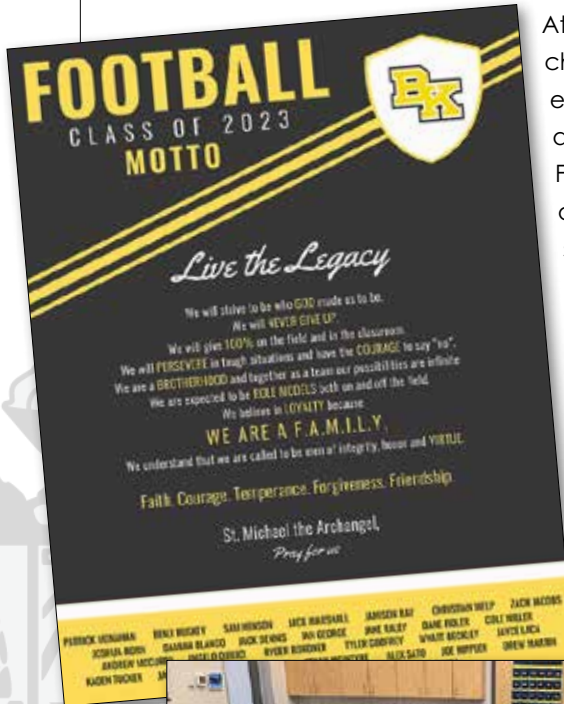
At Bishop Kelly we often talk about the need to "meet students where they are at" in their faith development journey. Since nearly two thirds of our students participate in one or more sports, intentionally including opportunities for spiritual growth in our athletics program provides an opportunity to literally do just that. And because students who participate in team sports are already building friendships, mentorships, and community with their teammates and coaches, it is a safe and trusting environment for our students to explore their faith and have encounters with Jesus.



and maintain humility in success. The desire to win and excel is important, but it should not come at the expense of Christlike behavior. Success cannot be measured solely by looking at the scoreboard. It is largely dependent on the daily commitment of coaches, parents, and athletes to grow both spiritually and physically. Bringing a strong faith focus to our student athletes creates a win-win proposition for developing faith filled individuals, cultivating faith leaders in our student body, and creating stronger programs and teams.

The We are One Initiative is supported by a team of BK faculty and staff who walk alongside coaches to help them incorporate faith formation into their program. The Support Team's goal is to help Coaches through three levels of engagement, with level one being a baseline for all teams, and level three being the ideal for all teams at Bishop Kelly. Baseline expectations include regular weekly Mass attendance by the team, establishing a prayer routine for the team, reflecting BK's Catholic identity on team uniforms and spirit gear, and selecting a scripture verse that provides a thematic focus for the season. Teams elevate to level two when they have identified faith leaders on the team to serve as Spirit Captains, participated in service to others during their season, participated in a "Level Up" experience such as a three-hour mini-retreat, and routinely build in time for prayer, faith sharing, etc. A team that reaches the level three summit is engaged with all level one and level two activities; participates in a faith based overnight retreat that focuses on goal setting, leadership, team building, and conflict resolution; has a spiritual development component such as a

Athletics reveal character, work ethic, determination, and discipline. Furthermore, athletics measure spiritual and physical strength. Athletes learn to accept setbacks in competition, rebound from team and personal failure, receive correction and instruction,

Bible study or devotional; and develops faith based traditions that are unique to their team. For example, the BK Varsity football players carry painted yellow rocks inscribed with "W.I.N." which stands for "What's Important Now" to remind them that spiritual growth, academic excellence, family relationships, etc. should be prioritized in the lives of the young men on the team.

Over the last few semesters more and more teams have begun to focus on faith formation. The Seniors on the BK Football team created a motto that begins, "We will strive to be who God made us to be ..." Additionally, this fall, students selected as Spirit Leaders for fall teams did a workshop designed to help them in their roles. And two of our teams – softball and cross country – have made visits to the Monastery of St. Gertrude in north Idaho. BK Softball Coach and We Are One Support Team member, Missy Nichols, said this about the team's visit to Cottonwood last spring, "As we drove up the snow-ridden rickety old road to St. Gertrude's, I could feel the eye rolls of my players. 'A stop to talk to the nuns Coach, great idea ... just great.' An hour later, sitting in the chapel with Sister

Lillian swapping Bishop Kelly stories, every face bore a smile. Even in the midst of their focus and quest for that third straight title, a sideline adventure to pray and appreciate the great tradition of our faith meant building not just our program, but our personal faiths in the Divine."

The We Are One initiative is still new at BK, but it's already making an impact. We are excited to see where this focus on faith in our athletics programs takes Bishop Kelly and each of the students we strive to bring closer to Jesus.

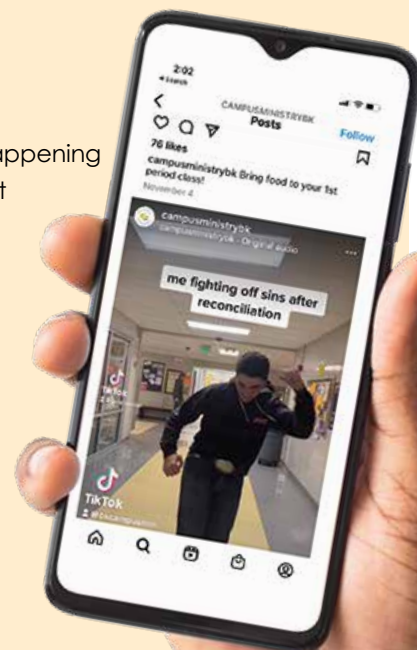

SPEECH AND DEBATE GOES TO NATIONALS

Bishop Kelly wrapped up the 2021–2022 Speech and Debate season with two more state championship trophies added to their collection. In addition, the team had numerous invitational sweepstakes wins, repeated their championships in District 3 Debate and Speech, were named NSDA Gem of the Mountains District Congress and Debate Champions, earned three invites to the National Events Invitational Tournament of Champions, had eight team members named Academic All Americans, and qualified 11 Knights to go to Nationals.

Of the 11 students who qualified, five Bishop Kelly students made the trip to Louisville, KY, in June. The students and their competition categories are:

- Justice Walker, BK Class of 2022, Informative, Impromptu, Expository
- Maggie Avey, BK Senior, Big Questions Debate
- Eleanor Lynch, BK Senior, Extemporaneous, Impromptu, Commentary
- Abigail Severance, BK Senior, Congressional Debate, Poetry, Storytelling
- Lucy Glynn, BK Junior, Original Oratory, Expository, Commentary

Bishop Kelly was well represented by these five young women, who had a great week of competition and fun with some terrific performances. Eleanor Lynch advanced through six rounds in Extemp Commentary and Maggie Avey finished in the top 14 Big Question Debaters in the country. Big Questions is a one-on-one debate, with last season's topics centered around the interactions of science, philosophy, and religion.

"I thoroughly enjoyed my time in Kentucky and was able to form friendships with debaters all around the country," said Avey. "My debate skills grew immensely, through five tough, yet highly enjoyable, days of competition."

For Justice Walker, going to Nationals was her last competition as a BK Knight before heading to Notre Dame this fall. "Speech and Debate has been influential in shaping me to be the person

I am, not only in my education, but also in my life as an active citizen in our nation," writes Walker. "Through Speech and Debate, I have met so many incredible people that are fun to be around and encourage me to become a better person."

These BK students competed with more than 6,000 students from 1,500 schools across the U.S. in Louisville. We are so proud of how they represented Bishop Kelly on the national stage. Congratulations to these young women, Coach Bob Goycoolea, and the entire Speech and Debate team for an incredible season. And a big shoutout and thanks to Mrs. Jennifer Severance, Mrs. Amy Glynn, and Mrs. Sarah Lynch who judged and chaperoned the trip to Nationals.



BK STUDENTS HELP THEIR FRIEND AT THE JIMMY DRISCOLL

More than 740 runners participated in BK's Bandanna Jimmy Driscoll 5K race and fun run this fall. One team in particular demonstrated what it means to be part of the BK Family. Juniors Phillip Janquart, Seiya Thompson, and Joe Hippler, along with BK Freshman Tensei Thompson, ran the race with their friend Ramon Valdez, who participated in his wheelchair.

Ramon lives with a genetic disorder so rare it is only referenced by the genetic sequencing impacted. Ramon adores his older brothers – Manuel, a junior at BK and Carlos, a sophomore – and loves participating to the greatest extent possible in whatever they do. He also loves to hang out with his brothers' friends, which includes many of their teammates on the BK Wrestling Team.

In 2021 Carlos Valdez ran with Ramon in the Jimmy Driscoll while his brother Manuel competed with the Cross Country team. Ramon, who had previously only watched the race with the spectators, loved being able to take part in the race. This spring, Ramon underwent a successful full spinal fusion surgery, and as a result, he spent many months in recovery. He was really looking forward to the 2022 Jimmy Driscoll, but unfortunately, this year Carlos' wrestling camp conflicted with the race. Carlos offered to cancel his plans so that he and Ramon could compete in the

race together, but Carlos' wrestling teammates jumped at the chance to race with Ramon while he went to camp.

Ramon uses a GRIT Freedom Chair thanks to the Idaho Challenged Athletes Foundation (CAF). According to his mom Angela, the GRIT Freedom Chair is the single most enabling device Ramon has had to allow him to continue to participate in all of the amazing outdoor events offered in Idaho, including the Bandanna Jimmy Driscoll 5K.

Running a 5k while pushing 100 pounds in a wheelchair is a serious workout! Not only did this team display the BK Way attributes of Community and Partnership, they finished the race with a time of 33:13.02. Way to go Knights!

The Valdez brothers' mom, Angela, says that Ramon was thrilled to have his friends from the wrestling team there for him. "We're so very thankful the entire BK community is so welcoming of Ramon and helps him really feel like he belongs."



DANIEL O'MEARA NEVER MISSES A BEAT

The first Dotty Clark Championship race at Bogus Basin took place in 1960 as a friendly competition between skiers at Boise and Borah high schools. The race was popular, and quickly grew to include other schools. Today, 26 Treasure Valley high schools and 37 Treasure Valley middle schools participate in the valley wide event. Bishop Kelly has been participating for more than five decades, and has brought home the iconic Dotty Clark trophy 18 times, beginning in 1974.

In order to compete in the Dotty Clark, skiers and boarders must participate in three or more qualifying events throughout the season. This year, Bishop Kelly had the largest team at Dotty Clark, with 66 BK skiers and boarders qualifying. The Knights had more than 100 entries, and earned 24 medals, winning the 2022 championship with 66 points over second place Centennial High School.



The 2022 Ski and Board team was coached by Bill Franklin, who is passing the reins after 10 years of serving first as assistant coach, and the last eight years as head coach. Congratulations to Coach Franklin and the 2022 Bishop Kelly Ski and Board team for bringing the Dotty Clark trophy back to BK! Stay tuned to hear how the defending champions do this season, and pray for snow at Bogus this year!



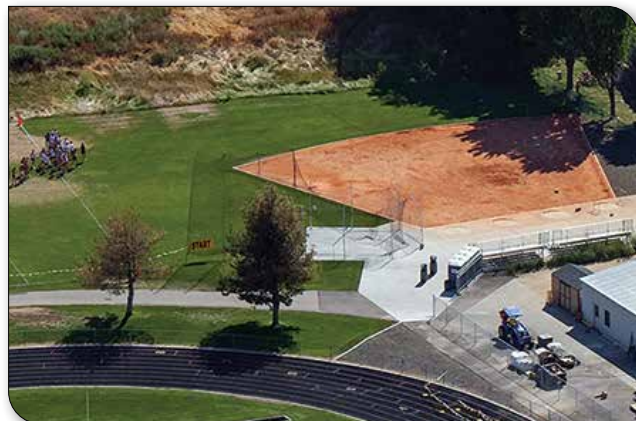
"It's fun to learn new tricks and watch what everyone does. You're there with your friends and get to cheer each other on," Maggie Scanlan.

Honoring their love for Bishop Kelly

Longtime supporters of Bishop Kelly High School and its Foundation, Dave and Mary Connolly first became engaged as involved parents years ago, and now, more recently, as grandparents. Dave spent the majority of his career working for Albertsons, last serving as the Vice President and Treasurer before eventually retiring while Mary dedicated herself to raising the family. Dave served on the Bishop Kelly Foundation Board from 1984 to 1997. Dave and Mary's first major gift to the Foundation dates to 1990, followed five years later by another major gift to fund one of our classroom wings.

In 1987, their son Michael, was tragically killed in a car accident. The Connolly's established the Michael Connolly Memorial Scholarship in his honor. They continued to contribute to their son's scholarship, and it was eventually endowed in 2010. This past July, Dave and Mary generously made a further gift of \$500,000 to the Foundation, earmarking \$100,000 of the funds specifically for their scholarship honoring Michael. The remainder of their gift was given as an unrestricted grant in support of growing the Foundation's endowment.

Dave and Mary were moved to make this significant gift because of the great impact Bishop Kelly has had on their children – and now grandchildren. Additionally, their conviction to give is deeply rooted in their belief of the immense value of a Catholic education:

"Our fondness for Bishop Kelly has developed over many years of observing the wonderful transformation of young students entering BK eager to learn, but needing someone to give them proper direction to become a well rounded member of society. We believe BK has given them that desire to have an appetite for a good education, but equally the importance of caring for everyone in a loving, spiritual way. It gives us hope that their positive influence in today's world will be a tremendous blessing."

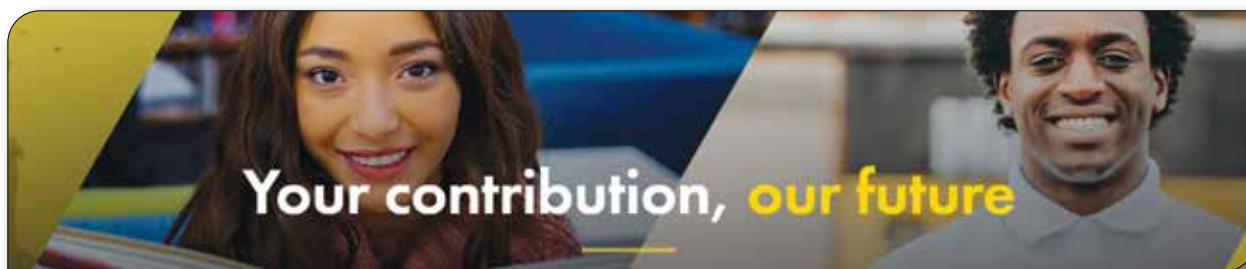
