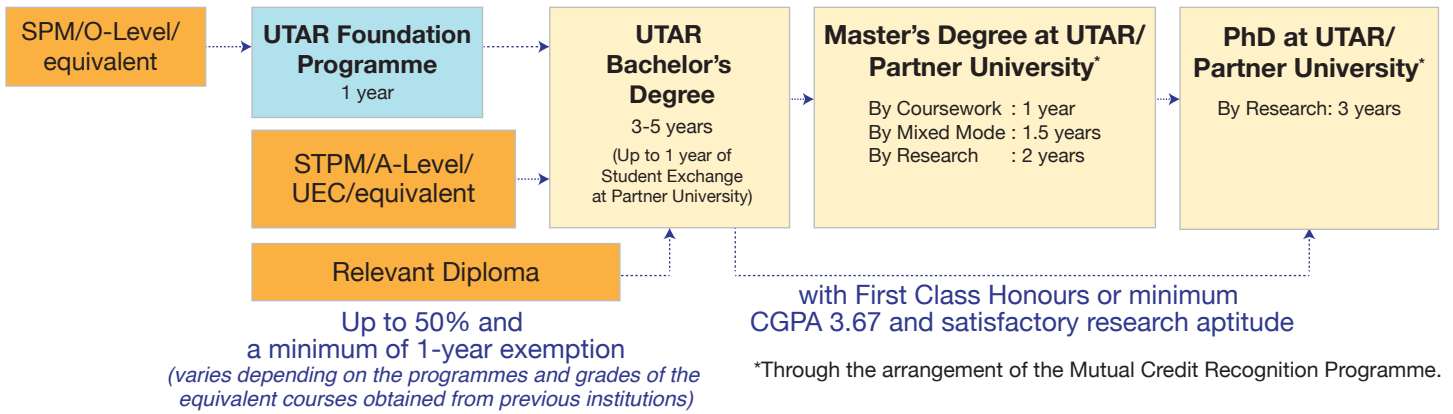

- UEC: Grade B in Mathematics and 2 Science subjects

Applicants (without formal qualifications) who are at least 21 years old and have relevant work experience can apply for APEL for Access [APEL.A] on the MQA website and receive the APEL.A Certificate to enrol in relevant undergraduate programmes at UTAR. 5. MARA Loan: Tertiary Education Sponsorship Programme (TESP)

Eligible Bumiputera students who will be pursuing or are currently pursuing enrolled in selected full-time undergraduate programmes can apply for the Majlis Amanah Rakyat (MARA) loan under TESP to support their education at UTAR.

6. Study Grant for Sibling and Parent Alumni (Effective June 2023 Intake)

A study grant of RM1,000 will be awarded to students whose siblings are currently studying or have completed their studies at UTAR. A similar grant will also be provided to students whose parents have completed their studies with UTAR. Eligible students need to apply via Web2 during weeks 1-4 of the enrollment intake.

7. EPF Withdrawal

Parents can use their EPF savings from Account 2 to support their children's education.
