### A Nation Mourns as Families Seek Closure After Tragic Attack

he serene valleys of Pahalgam, once known for their breath-taking beauty and tranquility, now stand as a solemn reminder of lives cut short in an act of senseless violence. Twenty-five Indian citizens and one Nepali national never returned from what was meant to be a journey of discovery and joy in the picturesque Kashmir valley.

Tuesday's attack has left a nation in mourning, with families across India grappling with the sudden, incomprehensible loss of their loved ones. In countless homes, there are now empty chairs at dinner tables, voices that will never again be heard, and memories that must now substitute for futures that will never unfold.

"He was so excited about this trip," shared the sister of one victim, her voice breaking with emotion. "He sent us pictures of the mountains just hours before... he said it was the most beautiful place he had ever seen."

The victims came from diverse backgrounds, teachers, engineers, doctors, students, and retirees, all united in their love for travel and appreciation of Kashmir's natural splendor. They were mothers and fathers, sons and daughters, friends and colleagues whose absence leaves an irreparable void in the lives of those who knew and loved them.

In Dombivali near Mumbai, heart-wrenching scenes unfolded as the wife of Atul Mone received her husband's body. Her silent tears spoke volumes about the personal tragedies behind the headlines. Similar scenes of grief played out across the country as communities came together to support bereaved families.

The attack has sparked an outpouring of solidarity from Kashmiris them-

selves, who have taken to the streets to condemn the violence. "These were our guests," said Umar Nazir Tibetbaqan, a local resident who joined protests. "In our culture, guests are sacred. We feel this pain deeply and stand with the victims' families in their hour of grief."

Memorial services across India have become gatherings of collective mourning, where strangers join hands to honor those lost. In Delhi, Mumbai, Bangalore, and countless other cities, candles flicker in the night as silent tributes to lives abruptly ended.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi expressed the nation's anguish: "Each life lost is a national tragedy. We embrace the families of our brothers and sisters in their darkest hour and promise that their loved ones will not be forgotten."

The tragedy has particularly resonated with India's tourism community. "They were simply people seeking beauty and peace," said a tour operator who had guided visitors through Pahalgam for decades. "That such violence could find them in one of nature's most peaceful sanctuaries is beyond comprehension."


As funeral pyres burn across the country, the nation grapples not only with grief but with the responsibility to ensure such a tragedy never recurs. The most fitting memorial to those lost might be a renewed commitment to peace in a region that has seen too much suffering.

For now, families keep vigil with photographs, personal belongings, and memories of those who will never return from Pahalgam's valleys. In their honor, the nation pauses, remembers, and pledges never to forget.

# Indian American Community Holds Vigil for Pahalgam Attack Victims in NJ

In a powerful display of unity and solidarity, more than 35 Indian organizations gathered for a prayer service and candlelight vigil in Edison, New Jersey on April 27th, 2025. The solemn event, held at the Indian market near Edison Cinema, brought community members together to honor victims of a recent terrorist attack in Indian-administered Kashmir that claimed 26 lives.

The vigil began at 5 PM with prayers led by an Iskcon priest, invited by event organizer Smita Gandhi. Participants expressed their grief and solidarity by holding pledge cards and banners, initially chanting "Bharat Mata Ki Jay" and "Vande Mātaram" before Edison Police requested they maintain a silent vigil.

Mr. Vishal J Harsh, Deputy Consul General of India in New York, addressed the gathering, stating that the Indian government was pursuing "every terrorist and their backers" responsible for the attack. He noted that India had implemented several measures in response, including closing its border with Pakistan and restricting special visa programs, despite Pakistan's denial of involvement in the incident.

Edison Mayor Samip "Sam" Joshi spoke passionately about his sadness for the innocent victims and those injured in the attack. He emphasized the

suffering caused by such acts of terror and called for an end to cross-border terrorism. Mayor Joshi encouraged attendees to keep the victims in their hearts and prayers.

FISANA Chairman Piyush Patel expressed the deep sorrow felt by Indian-American seniors, particularly condemning what he described as a cruel attack primarily targeting Hindus. FISANA President Suresh Patel, joined by presidents from 20 other senior organizations, delivered emotional speeches denouncing the violence.

Local political leaders also offered support. Assemblyman Rob Karabinchak spoke at the event, while Congressman Frank Pallone and Assemblyman Sterley Stanley sent messages of condolence and solidarity.



# Global Protests Erupt Following Deadly Pahalgam Attack

## International Communities Rally for Justice as Tensions Rise Between India and Pakistan

Indian communities worldwide have mobilized in massive demonstrations against the terrorist attack in Pahalgam that claimed 26 lives. Protesters gathered across North America and Europe, including Canada, Denmark, the UK, France, Finland, Germany, Spain, and the United States, displaying Indian flags and demanding justice for the victims.

The demonstrations intensified as evidence emerged linking the attack to Pakistan-based Lashkar-e-Taiba, escalating tensions between the two nations. In Paris, protesters emphasized this wasn't their first encounter with Pakistan-linked terrorism, citing previous attacks in Pulwama and Mumbai.

London protesters expressed solidarity with victims' families while hoping "the Indian government gives a reply to Pakistan in a language they understand." In Washington, a Kashmiri Pandit woman shared her personal connection to the tragedy, recalling her grandfather's targeted killing and how the recent attack "brought back

a lot of nightmares."

Reports indicate the terrorists specifically targeted Hindu victims in Baisaran valley, asking about religious affiliations before executing those who identified as Hindu.

India has responded with severe diplomatic measures, including expelling Pakistani military attachés, suspending the Indus Waters Treaty, and closing the Attari border crossing. Pakistan retaliated by suspending all bilateral agreements, including the historic Simla Agreement.

Authorities have released sketches of three suspects two Pakistani nationals and one local resident with a ₹20 lakh reward for information leading to their arrest.





# President Murmu Pays Respects at Pope Francis's Vatican Funeral

## Indian Delegation Joins World Leaders to Honor Late Pontiff

resident Droupadi Murmu represented India at Pope Francis's state funeral held at Saint Peter's Square in Vatican City on Saturday, April 26. The President was accompanied by Union Minis-

ter Kiren Rijiju, Minister of State George Kurian, and Goa Assembly Deputy Speaker Joshua De Souza as part of India's official delegation.

The funeral drew representatives from approximately 130 foreign delegations, including 50 heads of state and 10 reigning monarchs, highlighting the global impact of Pope Francis's ministry. The 88-year-old pontiff passed away on April 21, leaving be-

hind a legacy of compassion and humility.

Following the Pope's death, Prime Minister Narendra Modi expressed deep condolences to the global Catholic community, describing the late

Pope as "a beacon of compassion, humility and spiritual courage." The Prime Minister recalled his personal meetings with Pope Francis and praised his dedication to inclusive development and service to the poor.

"His affection for the people of India will albe cherished," ways Modi stated, acknowledging the strong relationship the Pope maintained with India throughout his papacy. President Murmu's attendance at the funeral served to formalize India's respect and condolences to both the Vatican and Catholics worldwide during this period of mourning.

# Fundraiser Launched for Family of IT Professional Killed in Pahalgam Attack

#### Florida-Based Indian Techie Among 26 Civilians Killed

riends of Bitan Adhikary, a Florida-based IT professional killed in a terror attack in Kashmir's Pahalgam region, have launched a GoFundMe campaign seeking \$300,000 to support his grieving wife,

three-year-old son, and elderly parents.

Adhikary was 26 civilamong ians killed on April 22 when terrorists opened fire in the popular meadow of Baisaran in Pahalgam. He had been vacationing in India with his family when the tragedy occurred. His wife and son survived the attack.

"He was a beloved member of our community and his loss has left a hole in the hearts of all who knew him," the campaign statement reads. "Bitan was known for his cheerful nature, kindness, and generosity."

Friends describe Adhikary as the sole breadwinner responsible for supporting not only his young family but

also his aging parents in India. "They are now facing the financial burdens of his ongoing mortgage, auto loan, and other unexpected costs," organizers explained.

West Bengal Chief Minister Ma-

mata Banerjee expressed condolences on social media, stating she had spoken with Adhikary's wife and assured her that the government was taking steps to return his remains to Kolkata.

Rev Sports Global noted that Adhikary regularly participated in their T20 World Cup events, underscoring the community connections severed by his untimely death.

# Vance-Modi Summit Strengthens US-India Strategic Partnership

## Four-Day Visit Highlights Defense and Trade Cooperation

President J.D. Vance and Second Lady Usha Vance, accompanied by their three children, concluded a productive four-day tour of India, meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi to advance bilateral relations. Modi emphasized the "fast-paced progress" following his January meeting with President underscoring their mutual commitment to cooperation in trade, technology, defense, and energy sectors.

The leaders conducted a comprehensive review of ongoing collaborations and exchanged perspectives on regional issues, with both emphasizing dialogue and diplo-

macy. Modi conveyed warm greetings to President Trump and expressed anticipation for his upcoming India visit for The Quad meeting.



The Vance family began their journey at Delhi's Akshardham Temple, spending 55 minutes exploring its architecture and offering prayers for

world peace. Their itinerary included visits to Jaipur and Agra, with Vance receiving a ceremonial Guard of Honor.

In Jaipur, Vance praised India's "laser-like focus on the future" while noting the rich historical traditions. He suggested increased defense cooperation, including potential F-35 fighter jet purchases from Lockheed Martin. Trade discussions remain significant with bilateral exchange reaching \$129 billion in 2024, as Trump's 90-day tariff hold presents an opportunity for a potential agreement despite his previous characterization of India as a "tariff king."

Modi tweeted that the "India-US Comprehensive Global

Strategic Partnership will be defining partnership of the 21st Century for a better future of our people and the world."

# Community Gathers to Honor FSU Shooting Victim Tiru Chabba

#### Over 200 Attend Hindu Funeral Service for Aramark Executive



ore than 200 mourners assembled at Mackey Funerals and Cremations at Woodlawn Memorial Park to celebrate the life of Tiru Chabba, a 45-year-old husband and father of two who was killed in the recent mass shooting at Florida State University on April 17.

The solemn Hindu funeral service lasted approximately one hour, followed by a final cremation ceremony. Attendees shared tears and embraces while honoring the Greenville resident who had been working as a vendor on campus when the tragedy occurred.

Chabba served as regional vice president for Aramark Collegiate Hospitality, having dedicated 22 years to the company after starting as a student manager. He was shot alongside university dining worker Robert Morales, with six others injured during the attack. Twenty-year-old FSU student Phoenix Ikner was identified by police as the suspected shooter.

Jim Bannister, one of the attorneys representing Chabba's family, attended but declined to comment. The family's legal team, which includes civil rights attorney Baraki Seller, released a statement highlighting Chabba's legacy as "a loving husband, a doting father of two young children, a beloved son, brother and friend whose life was tragically cut short."

The statement expressed gratitude for community support while requesting privacy as the family processes their profound loss, particularly acknowledging Aramark colleagues whose "kindness and presence have meant so much."

From a business perspective, the label offers strategic advantages as streaming platforms eliminate geographical barriers, allowing artists to gain international recognition without relocating. For Acharia, 5 Junction represents her most significant platform yet for reshaping music industry representation.

# Tech Staffing Firm Owner Sentenced for H-1B Visa Fraud

#### Indian American Executive Receives 14-Month Federal Prison Term

ishore Dattapuram, a 55-yearold Indian American from Santa Clara, has been sentenced to 14 months in federal prison for orchestrating a sophisticated visa fraud scheme through his San Josebased technology staffing company,

Nanosemantics Inc. The U.S. District Court also imposed three years of supervised release, forfeiture of \$125,456.48, a \$7,500 fine, and a \$1,100 special assessment fee.

Dattapuram was indicted in February 2019 alongside two co-defendants on one count of conspiracy to commit visa fraud and 10 counts of substantive visa fraud. He pleaded guilty to all charges in November

2024, according to the U.S. Attorney's Office, Northern District of California.

As co-owner of Nanosemantics, Dattapuram regularly submitted fraudulent H-1B visa petitions for foreign workers, falsely claiming they had specific jobs awaiting them at desig-

nated end-client companies when no such positions existed. He even paid companies to be listed as end-clients though he knew workers would never be employed there.

The scheme's purpose was to obtain visas for job candidates before se-

curing actual employment, allowing immediate placement when positions became available rather than waiting for visa processing. This strategy gave Nanosemantics an unfair competitive advantage in the technology staffing industry, where speed of placement is crucial.

The case highlights ongoing scrutiny of H-1B visa program abuses within the technology sector.

#### India Addresses US Student Visa Revocations

#### MEA Offers Support as Trump Administration Tightens Immigration Enforcement

ndia's Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) has confirmed it is investigating reports of F-1 visa revocations affecting Indian students in the United States. "We are aware that several Indian students have received communication from the U.S. government regarding their F-1 visa status," spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal stated at a weekly briefing on April 17.

This marks a shift from the MEA's previous stance that simply advised Indian nationals to comply with local laws. The Trump administration's immigration crackdown has resulted in numerous visa cancellations, some reportedly connected to protest participation or minor violations like traffic infractions.

Among those affected is Chinmay Deore, a Wayne State University student who, with three other international students and support from the American Civil Liberties Union, has petitioned for restoration of his visa status. In Wisconsin, another Indian student, Krish Isserdasani, recently received a court-ordered stay of deportation.

The MEA confirmed that Indian diplomatic missions in the US are maintaining contact with affected students and providing guidance on legal options. US data indicates a nearly 30 percent decline in F-1 visas issued to Indian applicants in February 2025 compared to the previous year.



# Federal Court Orders Reinstatement of International Students' SEVIS Records

# Temporary Restraining Order Halts Deportation of 133 Students, Many Indian

federal judge has temporarily blocked the deportation of 133 international students, including many Indians, and ordered the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to restore their student immigration records following sudden terminations that left them legally vulnerable.

In a sweeptemporary ing restraining order issued April 23, U.S. District Court Judge Jane Beckering directed DHS officials to "set aside the F-1 student record termination decisions" and "restore each Plaintiff's F-1 student record in the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS), retroactive to the date of termination," which was March 31, 2025.

The order prohibits the government from initiating removal proceedings, arresting, detaining, or transferring students without providing adequate notice to the court and plaintiffs' counsel. Judge Beckering emphasized that future SEVIS terminations must adhere to constitutional

and statutory rights.

Lead plaintiff Chinmay Deore, a 21-year-old Indian student at a Michigan public university, stated in an affidavit: "We received no prior notice. One day we were legal students, the next day we were facing deportation." Another affected student, Krish Lal Isserdasani from the University of

Wisconsin-Madison, discovered his visa had been cancelled just four weeks before graduation.

The restraining order remains effective for 14 days and may be extended if necessary or if defendants agree. Students have been instructed to provide copies of the court's order to their educational institutions.

# Former AmeriCorps Member Honored for Literacy Initiative in Underserved Communities

YC Mayor Eric Adams recognized exceptional volunteers at the 2025 Mayoral Service Recognition Ceremony held at Gracie Mansion on April 22. Among the five recipients of the prestigious Mayoral Service Impact Awards was Indian American Rina Madhani, who received the AmeriCorps Alum Impact Award.

Madhani, a Bronx native, was honored for her commitment to addressing literacy challenges in underserved New York City communities. During her AmeriCorps VISTA service, she identified significant gaps in literacy resources across the city, which inspired her to establish Start Lighthouse.

Her organization's Literacy Hub initiative now serves 2,100 students in underserved communities, including

P.S. 214. The program provides books alongside comprehensive literacy programming, including daily literacy lessons, author workshops, family engagement activities, and mentorship opportunities aimed at improving academic performance.

"AmeriCorps didn't just shape my career path,it shaped my purpose," Madhani said of her experience.

This year's awards program received a record-breaking 164 nominations. Following committee review and public voting that engaged over 2,200 individuals, five exceptional service initiatives were selected. Each winner received an award and a \$1,000 cash prize funded by the Fund for the City of New York.

The annual ceremony, part of National Volunteer Month celebrations, also recognized more than 3,000 vol-

unteers representing over 200 nonprofit organizations and 70 businesses engaged in community service.



## **Mobile Cold Storage Transforms Lives of Jharkhand Women Farmers**

#### Innovative Solar-Powered Units Help Rural Cultivators Store **Produce and Negotiate Better Prices**

he 'Samvardhan mobile cool storage unit' is changing the economic reality for women farmers in Jharkhand's

Khunti district. Previously forced to

sell perishable crops like mushrooms at whatever price local markets offered, farmers like Basanti Devi and Sita Devi now have the power to store their harvest and wait for favorable rates.

"Mushrooms are delicate and perish fast. We did not have time on our side," explains 42-year-old Sita Devi, who has benefited from the cold storage unit. Thirty-nine-year-old Basanti Devi adds, "We had to accept whatever rates the 'mandi' decided."

The initiative, launched by

Netarhat Old Boys' Association Globabsorbers, air circulation, and eth-

al Social Responsibility (NOBA GSR) in partnership with Agri-tech innovator BMH Transmotion, features mobile units equipped with solar panels, gas ylene management systems for optimal preservation.

Om Prakash Choudhary, board advisor of NOBA GSR and the project's originator, sees the initiative as transformative: "My real happiness would

> be when I see them storing their produce without fear, selling on their own terms, and earning what they truly deserve."

Experts note these units reduce post-harvest losses from 40 percent to just three percent while potentially increasing farmers' income by 25 percent. The technology addresses a critical gap in Jharkhand, which has only 60 cold storage facilities statewide.

Already, about 2,500 women farmers from the Torpa region are joining the initiative.



# **OpenAl Projects \$174 Billion Revenue** by 2030, Led by Al Agents

### Company Plans to Monetize Free Users and Develop **Autonomous Task Operators**

penAI expects to dramatically increase its revenue from approximately \$4 billion in 2024 to \$174 billion by 2030, according to a report by The Information. While current revenue primarily

comes from ChatGPT subscriptions and API access, future growth will be driven by Al agents and monetization of the company's substantial free user base.

Al agents, including OpenAl's Operator designed to perform tasks autonomously for users, are projected to generate \$3 billion in 2025, growing to \$29 billion by 2029—representing nearly one-quarter of total expected revenue. Individual agent pricing is reportedly set between \$2,000 and \$20,000

Strategic partnerships figure prominently in these plans, with SoftBank intending to invest \$3 billion annually

> in OpenAl's agent products. The companies will launch a Japanese joint venture called Cristal Intelligence, while early partners like Uber are already receiving aggregated usage data.

> OpenAl projects reaching three billion monthly active users by 2030, including two billion engaging weekly and 900 million using its products daily. Currently, ChatGPT has approximately 500 million weekly users, with fewer than 5% being paying customers.



# **Emma Mackey Cast as White Witch** in Greta Gerwig's Netflix Narnia


"Barbie" Actor Joins Daniel Craig and Meryl Streep in Christmas 2026 Release
