2022-23 Annual Report

With the closing of our 2022-2023 fiscal year, it is a time of reflection, celebration, and gratitude for all the students, families, educators, volunteers, donors, partners, and funders who make up the HDF Familia.

We are grateful for our dear friends at the Hispanic Federation, Inc. (New York) who partnered with HDF once again to grant \$200,000 to 8 Kansas City Latino-serving nonprofit organizations. We invite you to read about the incredible work our grantees are doing to improve the lives of Latino families on pages 6-9 of this report.

We are indebted to our community who demonstrates its philanthropic power through our annual Cambio para Cambio campaign. Nearly 50 fundraising teams participated in the 2022 Cambio campaign, engaging over 800 individual donors, and collectively raising \$430,000 in support of the HDF Scholarship Program. Cambio para Cambio continues to prove what we have always known: the Latino community is as giving as any other, and the strength of our community stems from our families.

We are thankful for our volunteers, college and university match partners, and donors who helped us eclipse the \$1 million milestone in HDF Scholarship awards to support 550 Kansas City Latino students in pursuit of 2- and 4-year college degrees. Since 1984, HDF has been steadfast in our belief that higher education is the best catalyst in advancing our community, and we are incredibly proud of the community effort to make the HDF Scholarship Program one of the largest Latino-serving scholarship programs in the country.

The growth of the HDF Scholarship Program is also attributed to the support we receive from our Named Scholarship Program. To the individuals, families, organizations, and companies who have established an HDF Named Scholarship, we say thank you! We are especially appreciative of the Hall Family Foundation and Sherman Family Foundation for this year's creation of a renewable scholarship to increase the number of Kansas City Latino educators, social workers, and mental health professionals.

We could not do this work without our high school and community partners who work alongside our dedicated, bilingual, and professional HDF Family College Prep Program advisors to support thousands of students and families in the college-going process. This year, the FCPP team and program grew to serve 9 of Kansas City's largest Latino-serving high schools on both sides of the state line, as well as our first nonprofit community partner, Harmony Project KC. Through partnership and collaboration, the Family College Program increases access to college through bilingual family nights, college campus visits, scholarship and FAFSA workshops, and one-on-one college advising.

Finally, we are so proud of the 9 HDF Scholars who answered the call and established HDF's inaugural Scholar Advising Board. Their work is helping us realize our vision of not only supporting HDF Scholars to and through college but to develop leadership skills and live out our ask of all HDF Scholars – to give back to the Kansas City Latino community who has supported them along the way.

I am personally thankful for the leadership of our HDF Board members and Team who work selflessly and tirelessly to advance the Kansas City Latino community every single day. Alex, Liz, Robert, Elizabeth, Paola, Melissa, Ayanna, Adriana, and Lucerito: thank you for all you do for HDF and the community!

We have much to be grateful for this past year at HDF, but we know there is more work to be done. Our work will continue to be rooted in direct student and family support funding, programming and services, especially as it pertains to access and completion of higher education. We look forward to 2023-2024, and with the continued support of the HDF Familia, we're aiming for new milestones and expanded services in the communities we have the privilege of serving every day.

GRANTMAKING

Since 1983, community grantmaking has been a pillar of HDF's mission and work. This year, HDF partnered with the Hispanic Federation, Inc. (New York) to grant **\$200,000** in support of 8 Kansas City Latino-serving nonprofit organizations:

The funding allowed Center of Grace to provide a free English Language Learner Preschool for the children of newly arrived immigrant parents attending Johnson County Community College English classes. According to Pastor Sylvia Romero, Center of Grace Executive Director, "offering the preschool at the same time as the adult English classes helps the parents who otherwise cannot afford childcare." This past year, **25 children were enrolled in the preschool, including 10 who will enter kindergarten in the fall.**

The funding provided by HDF/Hispanic Federation has helped provide tuition assistance to families who have children enrolled in the Academy for Children - Early Childhood Education Center. **Thirteen families have been supported thus far**, and without the financial support, these children would not have access to a quality early childhood education environment, and as important, a program that embraces and values diversity, culture, and language.

El Centro, Inc. - Academy for Children

With these funds, The Toolbox successfully hosted an 11-week Intro to Computers for Business Owners program focusing on Google Sheets in Spanish. This program saw **12 dedicated graduates, including two young learners aged 11 and 12**, who are now leveraging their newfound knowledge to assist their parents in their businesses.

Thanks to the \$40,000 grant Westside CAN Center has been able to provide basic services to the Hispanic community of the Westside and surrounding communities. A total of **1,376 bags of fresh food** were distributed to single dads, single moms, seniors and families around the Westside and Kansas City metro area.

The Guadalupe Centers offers a variety of social support and emergency assistance services to clients through the Family Support Program. This year's grant supported **57 households comprised of 214 total individuals** who were provided various types of assistance, including: housing related assistance, medical services/support and transportation.

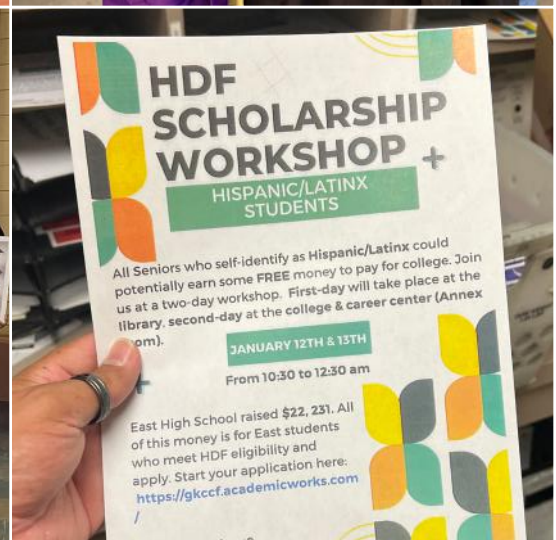

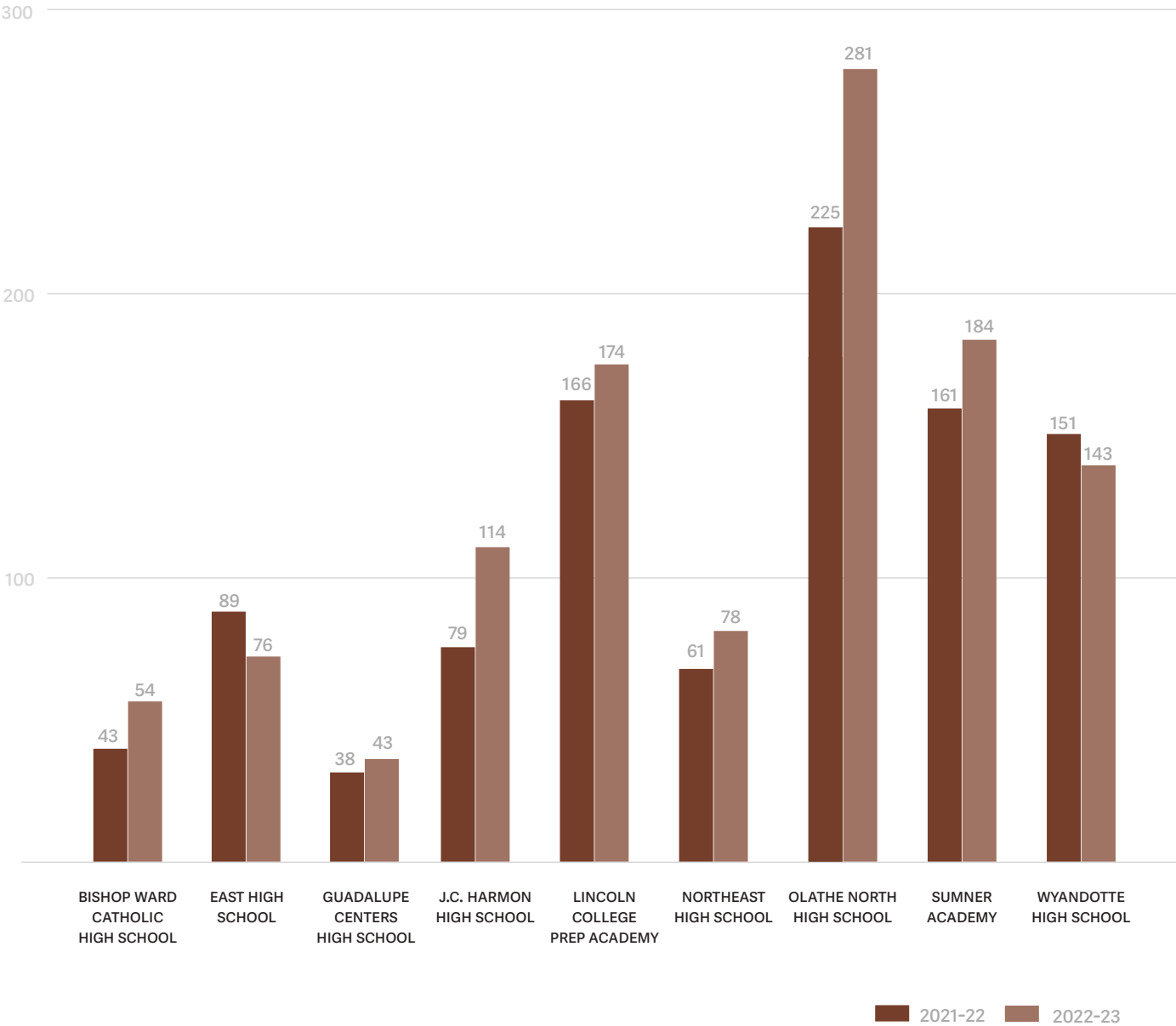

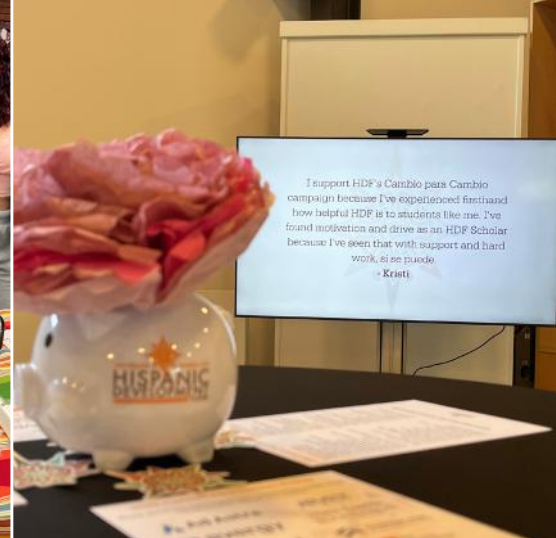

HDF SCHOLARSHIP

As we enter our 39th anniversary of the Scholarship Program, we are humbled by the generosity of our community, matching partners, and donors for continuing to believe in HDF's mission by supporting the post-secondary dreams of Latino/Hispanic youth in Kansas City.

The class of 2023 saw a new organizational milestone, where for the first-time in history, we surpassed the million dollar mark, awarding a record amount of **\$1,177,650** to **550 scholars**. This simply would not be possible without our robust group of over **100 volunteers** who help us grade applications, guide applicants with their essays/resumes, and join us at our fundraising and celebration events.

We're excited to see what our 40th year will bring as we continue to show our scholars that their community believes in them and that they are not alone in their higher education journey.

As our scholarship program continues to grow, we are grateful to the families, organizations, businesses and community partners who have created a Named Scholarship through HDF. These scholarships are founded in memory or in honor of a loved one, to affirm and inspire scholars pursuing a specific career path, to support undocumented students, amongst other reasons. Through the Named Scholarship Program, we have also increased personal outreach to scholars, improving retention and graduation rates. This year, the Named Scholarship Program has 27 scholarships established and together supports 121 HDF Scholars (22% of the class of 2023).

Within the Named Scholarship Program, we have also partnered with the Hall Family Foundation and the Sherman Family Foundation to address the shortage of educators and mental health providers our nation is facing. With a renewable scholarship for majors in the Education, Social Work and Therapy fields, 50 HDF scholars are now receiving additional support from HDF staff. These scholars have check-ins throughout the year, are connected with potential internships and career placements, and are provided with additional resources as they navigate college and prepare to enter the workforce.

Pictured to the right, are some of these scholars at our scholarship awards celebration. During this time, they were able to meet one another and connect with our partners from both the Sherman and Hall Family Foundations.

One of the most exciting developments for HDF this year was establishing the inaugural Scholar Advisory Board (SAB). This group comprises of nine current HDF scholars, with different fields of studies who meet monthly, in-person and virtually.



Representing the 415 HDF Scholars, the SAB has kept at the center of their decisions the diverse views and voices of all of our students. They have helped steer the direction of programming, sharing ideas of ways to improve our services, participated in civic engagements and worked directly with the HDF Advisory Board.

More recently, the HDF Board approved that the SAB take ownership of granting **\$10,000** to a Latino serving grassroots organization. With support from HDF's Staff and Board, the SAB executed the process, drafting the grant application, conducting site visits, and ultimately selecting and awarding the grant. Through this opportunity and thanks to a grant from the **Loose Family Foundation**, the SAB acquired new professional development tools, one of the reasons SAB was created in the first-place; to ensure our scholars have opportunities beyond a scholarship, helping them network, connecting them with community leaders and helping them develop their own leadership skills.



The SAB also helped plan and lead a few events throughout the school year. Our favorite being a first-year college students' end-of-semester game night, where new HDF scholars met one another, allowing them to start building connections. SAB also attended scholarship application workshops to mentor high school seniors, held informational interviews with younger scholars sharing about their academic journey, and joined some of the scholarship surprise reveals on announcement day.



We look forward to continuing to learn from our scholars and are excited to support their goals and growth.

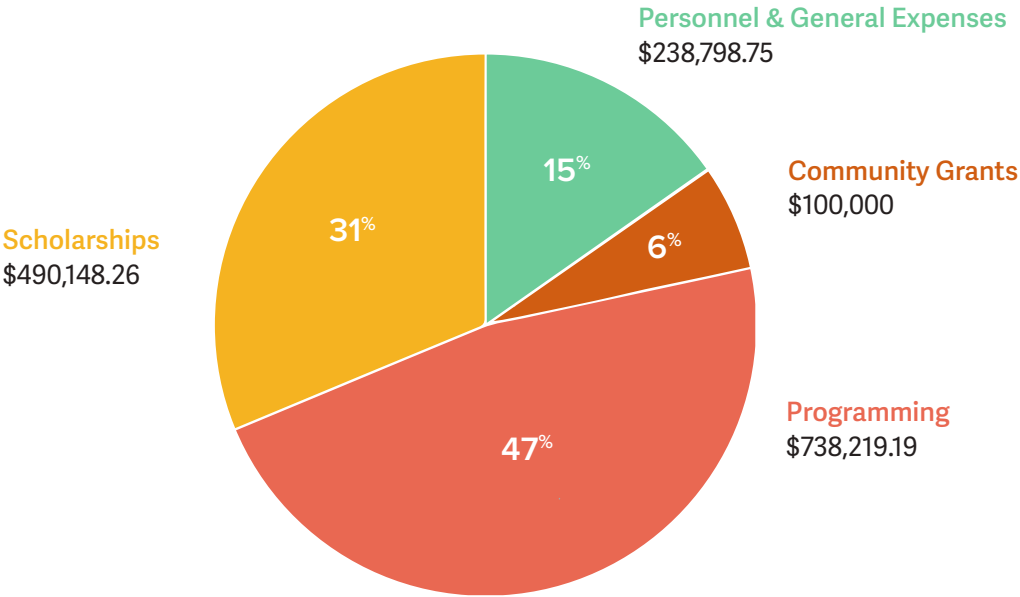
HDF Scholarship Matching Institutions

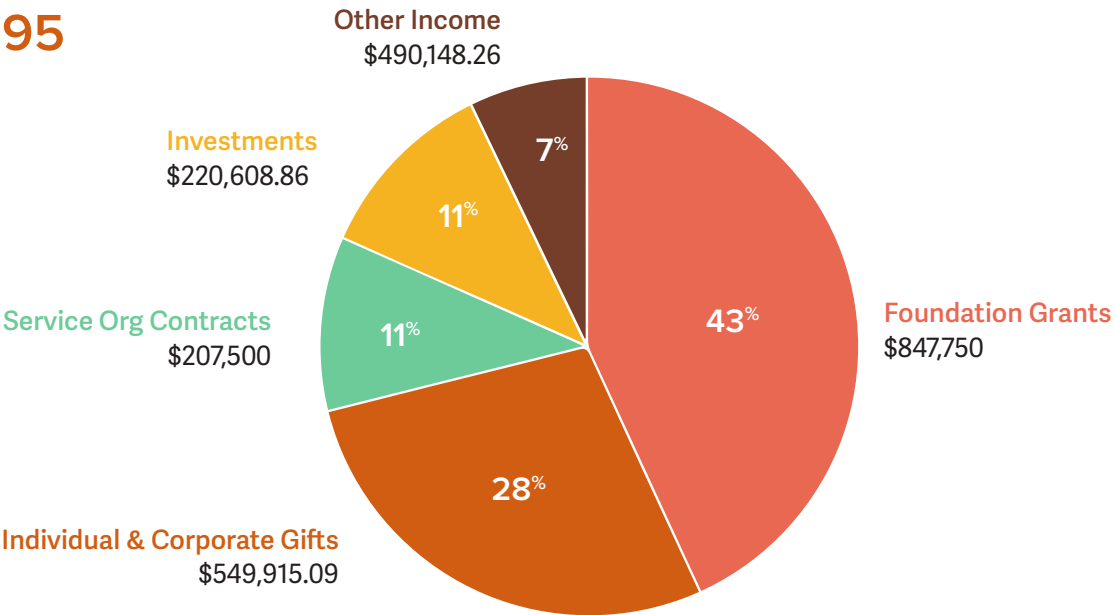
