- No make-up classes permitted unless cancelled by Plainfield Parks and Recreation.

Group Fitness

Aqua X

This class is designed to increase cardio fitness, increase flexibility, build lean muscle, reduce body fat, and strengthen muscles without the impact on the joints by using the resistance of the water.

Arthritis Aqua X

Taught by instructors certified through the Arthritis Foundation. This program is designed to improve range of motion, muscle strength and endurance by combining the buoyancy of the water and the warmth of the heated pool. It is ideal for relieving pain and stiffness through exercise.

Boom

Have you hit a fitness plateau? Do you like fast-paced workouts that are done in 30 minutes? Can you handle a challenge? BOOM was developed by leading fitness experts to improve strength, flexibility and endurance in convenient 30-minute workouts. These classes will challenge you, but don't worry one-handed pushups aren't required. The instructor will go through 3 different types of workouts that focus on cardio, muscles, and mind.

A full body, low impact workout combining ballet-inspired moves with elements of Pilates, Yoga, and Strength Training. Full Body Toning

HIIT

Pilates

This class will help you develop core strength and a leaner body by lengthening and strengthening muscles without building bulk. You will improve balance, poise, stability, and flexibility! The class works with the deepest muscles of the body to build strength and control to improve mind/body awareness, reduce stress and fatigue, as well as relieving pain, stiffness, and tension. It is suitable for anyone regardless of age or level of fitness.

Jr. Kid's Club

Jr. Kid's Club is available for toddlers 1-2 years of age and is supervised by our Playworld staff. This program is for children that are not quite old enough for Kid's Club but are capable of being supervised by staff for a limited period of time.

This program is not childcare yet a supervised play program. Please review the Kid's Club guidelines before participating. **Children in Kid's Club must be potty trained.**

- If a child needs assistance using the restroom, the parent will be notified, and they are responsible for assisting the child.

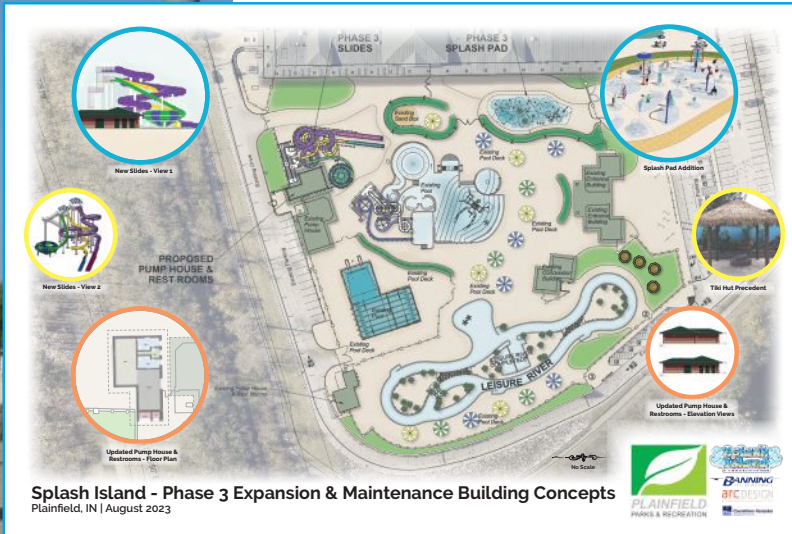
Town of Plainfield Invests in Community Amenities

The Town of Plainfield is a community of over 35,000 residents located southwest of Indianapolis near the Indianapolis International Airport. Plainfield is also known for excellent schools, an extensive trail system and its recreation and aquatic center that includes Splash Island Waterpark.

Splash Island Expansion Opens in 2024

The Plainfield Town Council approved a \$8,364,500.00 contract with Patterson Horth Inc. to expand Splash Island Outdoor Waterpark in August. The expansion includes three new waterslides, a splash pad, tiki hut cabana rentals and an updated pool maintenance building.



we believe these additions will continue providing lasting memories for everyone.”

With the addition of three additional waterslides, the expansion improves the waterpark by offering guests six large waterslides. A new splash pad will be installed within the park, as well, extending the department’s aquatic operations beyond the established pool season. Visitors will have new opportunities for private spaces within the park, with the new tiki hut cabana rentals. The project also includes replacement of the kids’ play structure located in the main pool.

The 4 ½-acre Caribbean-themed outdoor waterpark, which opened to the public in June of 2004, currently features three waterslides, a 900-foot leisure river, an interactive children’s play area and more.

“As we gear up to celebrate the 20-year anniversary of Splash Island at the Richard A. Carlucci Recreation and Aquatic Center, we’re excited to bring these new amenities online,” said Robin Brandgard, Town of Plainfield Town Council President. “The Plainfield Parks & Recreation Department has established themselves as a department that creates memories for our residents and visitors, and

The Splash Island expansion began in September of 2023, with plans to open in time for the 2024 Summer Season on Memorial Day weekend.

Franklin Park Under Construction

The Town of Plainfield broke ground on the Franklin Park renovation in July.

Franklin Park, the Town's oldest park, will see several new and improved features, including: crosswalk and sidewalk intersection improvements, enhanced playground equipment, dog park with shade structures, resurfaced tennis court, Anderson Baseball Diamond enhancements and updates, full-court basketball with side goals, 8 Pickle Ball Courts with shade structures, path improvements to Pinnacle Lane, redevelopment of Franklin Park Trail Loop, enhanced updates on park restrooms and shelter houses, community greenspace and additional parking.

In 2021, the Town of Plainfield hosted multiple public input sessions for the Franklin Park Masterplan. Plainfield residents participated both virtually and in-person to provide their voice in the redevelopment. The Parks and Recreation Department took the community's



input to create the Franklin Park Masterplan, helping enrich the future of our Town and positively affect the quality of life provided to residents. On May 22, 2023, the Plainfield Town Council approved contract with Patterson Horth for the Franklin Park Improvements Project.

The project is scheduled to be completed in December of 2023.

Lights! Camera! Action!



As a part of the Greater Downtown Conceptual Redevelopment Plan adopted in 2017, the Town of Plainfield is currently building a new destination for entertainment in Downtown Plainfield. Located at the corner of Main and Center Streets, Hendricks Live! will be the premiere destination on the westside for local, regional and national art and entertainment. Hendricks Live! will be in the Plainfield Civic

Center, where the Plainfield Government Center is currently housed. As part of the development, the Plainfield Chamber of Commerce has recently moved their operations into the Plainfield Civic Center.

Town Council, Town Boards and Town Commission meetings will also soon relocate to the Government Center. These meetings have taken place at the Plainfield Fire Territory Headquarters for over 3 years.

Hendricks Live!, the operator of the new Performing & Fine Arts Center, will present and host year-round exhibits and performances for all ages and interests. The venue will feature a 600-seat performance hall and a 150-seat event space.
