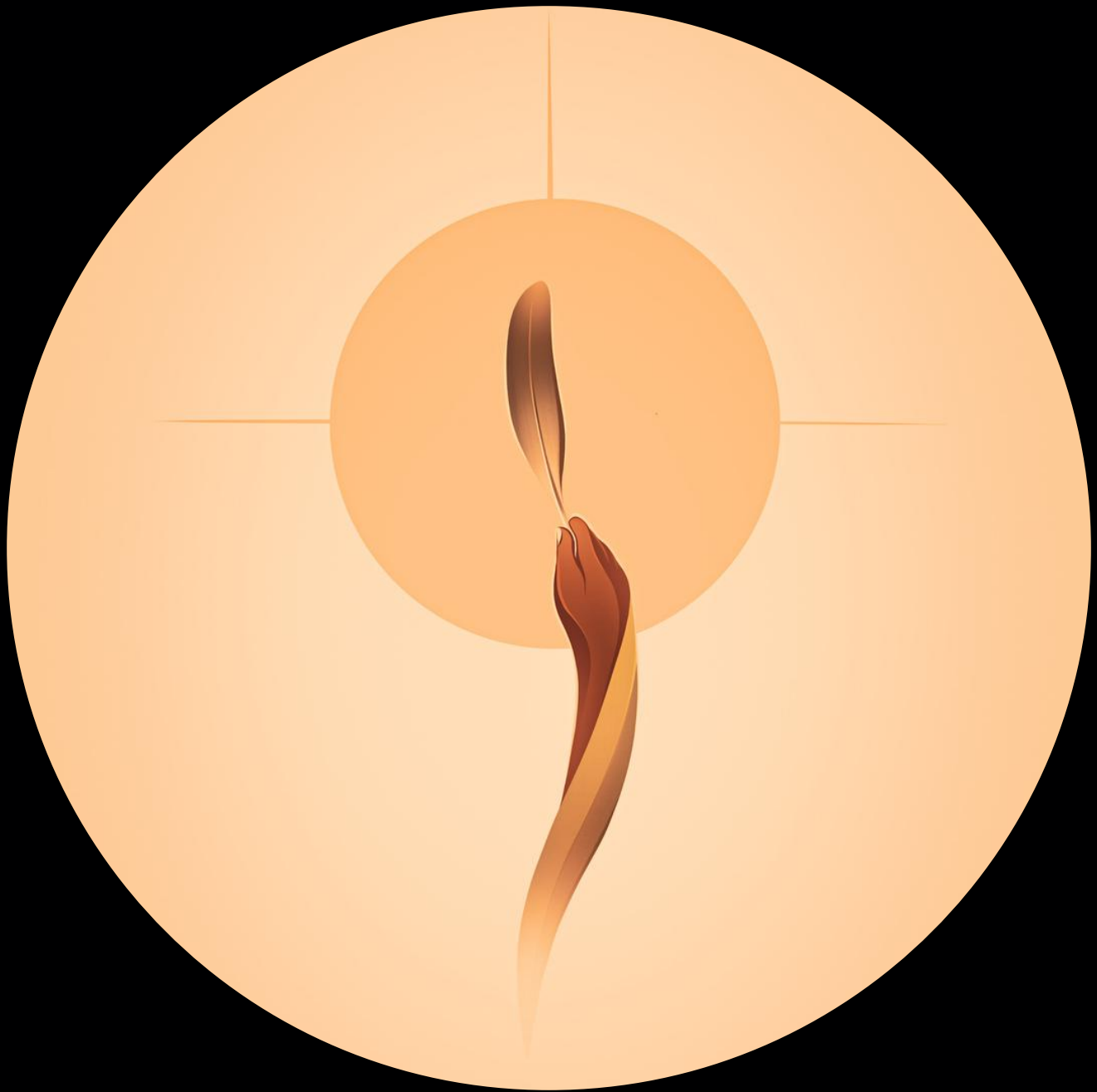

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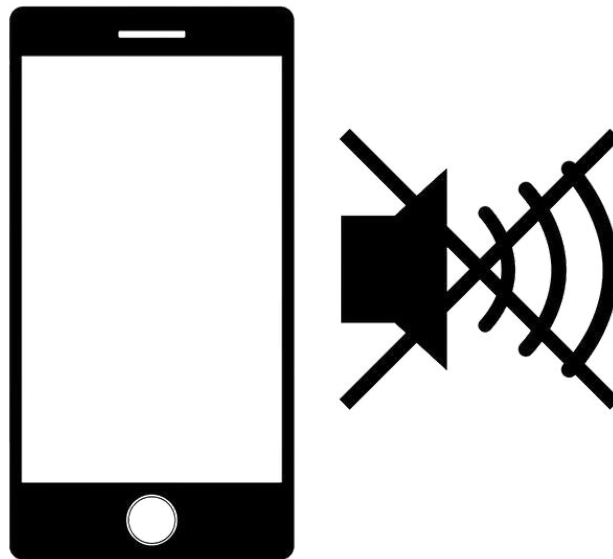

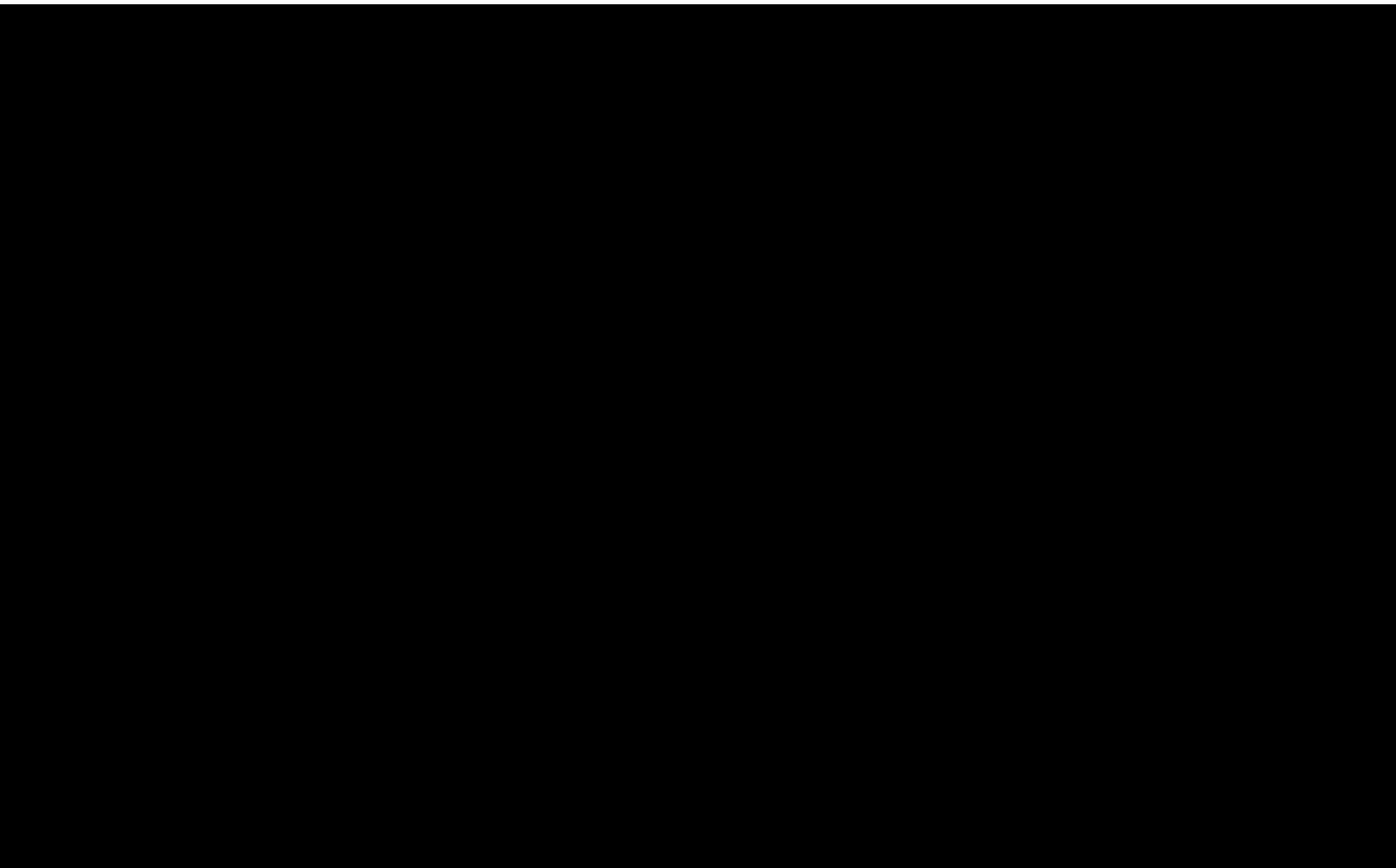

OFRA HARNOY

Cello



Ofra Harnoy is celebrated as one of the world's greatest cellists, a distinction that places her among Canada's most renowned personalities and a Member of the Order of Canada. In 1987, she made history as the first Canadian classical instrumental soloist since Glenn Gould to secure an exclusive worldwide contract with a major record label, RCA Victor Red Seal. Her career has spanned concerts on five continents, performing at the behest of notable figures including King Charles, President Bill Clinton, three Canadian Prime Ministers, and members of the Imperial Japanese family. Harnoy has garnered acclaim for her numerous music competition wins, including the Concert Artists Guild Award in 1982, which led to her Carnegie Hall debut. Her diverse recording catalog has earned her accolades such as 5 JUNO Awards, the Grand Prix du Disque, and Critics Choice Awards from international publications. Maclean's once named her one of the 12 Canadians who bring the most credit to their country.

MIKE HERRIOTT

Trumpet



Canadian trumpeter, Mike Herriott, a respected multi-instrumentalist in both the classical and jazz genres, is in demand as a lead trumpeter, jazz improviser, orchestral soloist, bassist, arranger and composer. He has toured extensively through North America and South East Asia and has shared the stage with a host of luminaries, including Maynard Ferguson, Rob McConnell, Doc Severinsen, Arturo Sandoval, Michael Buble, Slide Hampton, Kenny Wheeler, Phil Nimmons, Maria Schneider, Seth MacFarlane and more. In 2018, he began a musical collaboration with his wife, Ofra Harnoy, which has brought them international respect and recognition from touring and their recording projects. They have two previous albums released together - "Back to Bach" - 2019, and "On the Rock" - 2020 (MUSICNL WINNER 2021), with "Portrait" - 2023 marking their third. September/October 2023 brought about the release of Mike's first solo album project since 2016 entitled "Tales of Tricksters and Vagabonds".

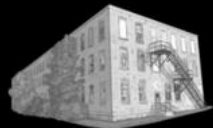

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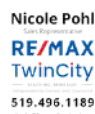
