Ally stands in the driveway and can be seen from afar. Friendly "Ally" the Alpaca now greets the children at the entry of Ally's Kindy everyday.





David Joffe was engaged not as the creative director to develop this project but as the technical director to enlarge this dreadful model to gigantic proportions so it could lay claim to being the biggest dinosaur in the world. It was built in pieces in the Philippines and shipped in 10 x 40ft containers to Drumheller, Calgary, Canada where it was erected.

"I was appalled when told that after much discussions, the client had approved this pathetic T-Rex toy like model". I was told to shut up and just make it bigger."

Giant Matilda Kangaroo - 9 metres Tall

The original Matilda stood at 12 metres tall and made her debut at the Commonwealth Games in 1988. She was the star of the show, but was never designed and fabricated so as to weather the elements and the passage of time.

She was stored away in a paddock and forgotten about for some years before being bought by the Matilda Petrol Station Group in about 2007.

They spent well over \$100,000 to renovate her and relocated this icon to their signature servo north of Gympie, where she now resides hidden from the passing traffic in the new roadhouse sold by the Matilda Fuel Group to the new owners "PUMA" who relinquished their connection with the kangaroo.

Prior to the sale Matilda Group intended to use this ICONIC figure as their mascot, to reside over their vision

for what was to be hundreds of Matilda service stations Australia-wide.

Natureworks Pty Ltd a specialist art fabrication company in Highvale (nr Samford) north of Brisbane was engaged to re-design a slimmer version without losing the spirit of the original sculpture.

The rear end of the original roo was over 4.2 metres wide and posed a problem for both fabrication and transport of the piece, so this width at the hips was reduced to 2.4 metres and the height to 9.0 metres, making it easy to transport. The head and ears were built as separate components and Natureworks installed the first piece at Tugun on the Gold Coast in 2009.

When negotiations for the sale of the service station group later began the fabrication of further pieces was put on hold. A year later the concept died once "PUMA" took over the group.

The Tugun fuel depot now owned by "Puma" sold the sculpture back to Natureworks who is now offering the piece for sale in Australia.

Tropical Landscape Life Size Moais & Erupting Volcano - Smorgy's Restaurant - Melbourne



In 2015, Yeppoon City Council commissioned Natureworks to sculpt a series of sea creatures incorporating interactive water play for the central art feature of a new 'sprayground' to be constructed on the Yeppoon foreshore.

Working closely with landscape Architectural firm Vee Design, Natureworks developed an abstract interpretation of Kraken tentacles (giant octopus), a stingray, a starfish, turtles and a giant crab for the new wet playspace. Utilising a range of surface finishes, Natureworks created larger-than-life art-forms with precise mosaic patterns and a unique 3D bronze appliqué that hugs the free-flowing sculptural forms. The 3D micro-bronze patterned inlay utilised tells the story of the sea creatures fringing the coral reef off Yeppoon - the mid-QLD coastline devastated by Cyclone Marcia in February 2015.


The challenge of the Yeppoon project was to produce large wet-play sculptural icons of local significance that would meet Australian Playground Standards. The brief called for a concrete substrate with no softball, requiring the tall sculptures to be designed as unclimbable, but still inspirational and with great visual impact.

Natureworks is renowned for its exacting replication, to museum standard, of all forms of animal art; for the Yeppoon project Natureworks branched out beyond its traditional realm of realism and ventured into the world of abstract contemporary art.

Each sculpture created for the sprayground was designed with a 75-year lifespan. They incorporate stainless steel armatures and reinforced heavy duty polymer-modified 75mpa concrete, to withstand strong weather conditions. The solid forms were then overlaid with a bronze sealife appliqué and colourful mosaics to provide a spectacular surface finish. The hero piece of the Yeppoon series is the 'Keppel Kraken". At a height of 4m this central sculpture towers over the other elements, periodically dumping an avalanche of water over the unsuspecting children below. An additional series of intermittent spray and jumping jets of water add more surprises and a ton of fun

Product Details:-The original piece for the National Botanical Gardens was not painted but was negatively coloured in a buildup of semitranslucent gelcoat layers, which was then heavily reinforced with fibreglass whilst still in its silicone mould. This Technique "bakes" the colour deep into the laminate and is a superior finish to traditionally painted fibreglass sculptures. It is made from fibreglass and has an internal steel armature.





This 3 x larger than life Tasmanian Tiger or (Thylacinus Cynocephalus) was commission by the Launceston City Council as a playground feature in 2014.


Thylacinus Potens the "powerful thylacine" was a larger and more heavily built ancestor of the modern thylacine, but nowhere near as big as the sculpture below.

In developing this piece, we ensured that it was built to Australian standards and is a heavily steel reinforced sculpture in fibreglass.

It is now a centre piece for the Launceston Park in Tasmania - This sculpt also provides an education based play experience of the unique megafauna of Tasmania that has only become extinct in the last 50 years.


Stage 1 Original Scaled Model

The Tumblebug of Luna Park in Sydney was rebuilt based on a small plasticine scale replica of the original.



Stage 2 - Building the Body

The Tumblebug is based on massive steel pipe leg supports, the sculpture was formed in a 10mm mild steel bar frame to which perforated silver builders paper was stapled. This was then sprayed with a high density polyurethane foam both internally and externally, which was then fibreglassed and colour - gelcoated.









Tree - Largest Artificial in the World

Tree of Life - Sopoong Shopping Centre - South Korea - 2006



In 2006 Natureworks was contracted to build the largest indoor artificial tree on the planet. It was to grow through the atrium space of 6 floors of retail shopping in the largest shopping centre in Asia, reaching a height of 32 metres at the ceiling where the trunk still had a diameter of 6 metres. At ground level the 11 metre diameter featured a walk through "cave". The tree weighs 30 tonnes and includes 12 primary branches weighing an average of 1800kg each.





The clients' intent was to lay claim to building the largest artificial tree in the world. It is over 11 metres in diameter at the base, through which the public can walk and the diameter where it "breaks through" the ceiling is still 6 metres wide.
