

We've heard these terms a thousand times and more this year after restrictions, shutdowns, and educational disruption caused by Covid and the global pandemic. Never before has a class navigated the challenges presented in academics, athletics, and personal lives like our dear Class of 2021.

In March of 2020 during their junior year, the Class of 2021 experienced an overnight transition in their method of schooling to that of a remote environment. Until recently, they had only known school to be in a remote or hybrid fashion with varying schedules based on social distancing regulations and mandates. Jennifer Emard, senior English teacher, said, "It would have been so easy for the Class of 2021 to excuse their way out of working hard this year. Not these young men. I feel that our Class of 2021 is uniquely close because of our shared, uncomfortable growing pains. We persevered through this together."

More challenges were thrown at this class but they handled themselves with poise, innovation, and everything expected from a Servite gentleman. The lessons they learned are significant in their development as Faith-Filled Leaders as well. "The struggle has been one of the best parts of senior year. It showed me that nothing can keep

the community of Servite Friars down, especially when everything and everyone is committed to living like Christ, a living example of Him," says senior Matthew Greenlee, Chairman of the Student Ambassador Program.

The challenges the Class of 2021 experienced may have told the boys that "it" – academics, athletics, Eagle Scout awards, scholarship awards, Kairos retreats, theater productions, and more – couldn't be done. But this special class of Servite men found their ways. Ben Van Dyk '01, Social Studies Teacher, summarizes it best saying, "The Class of 2021 has shown there is no challenge too great for them. In fact, they have shown they welcome a challenge; they thrive in the fight. And they won't simply endure, they will persevere over it. From that perseverance, they inspire others to rise to that challenge with confidence. Don't ever count this class out. They are fighters." Go with God and persevere, Servite Class of 2021.


CLASS OF 1971 PLAYING IT FORWARD

In the summer of 2017, graduates of the Servite High School Class of 1971 made a commitment to mentor the students who would be graduating 50 years after them. Beginning as volunteers during Freshman Formation Weekend, the Class of '71 graduates connected with their much younger counterparts over the years, sharing life lessons and laughter in classrooms, at retreats, and through social events like bowling and a poker tournament. Over these same years, the leader of the program, Mike Freeman '71, experienced a traumatic injury that resulted in paralysis. His story of determination and recovery served as an inspiration to our young Friars graduating 50 years after he and his Servite brothers collected their diplomas. The tradition has continued with the Class of 1975, the latest to adopt a class.


Anthony High School community."





ATHLETIC YEAR IN REVIEW

In a year like no other that brought challenges greater than any scouting report could predict, Servite student-athletes and coaches rose to the occasion and made the most of the opportunity to play the sports they love.

An athletic calendar that is traditionally stretched over 10 months was played in four with up to 10 teams competing simultaneously throughout the year. In a time that called for COVID testing, social distancing, masks, extensive cleaning protocols, limited fan attendance, constant schedule changes, and so much more, it seemed like a victory every time players were able to compete. And it was.

From hypothetical victories to actual ones, Servite teams experienced unprecedented success in 2021. All 10 spring sports made the playoffs, a first for the Friars, with three winning Trinity League Championships, one winning a CIF-SS title, and one taking home CIF Regional honors. Of the seven team sports, five advanced

to the quarterfinals or further in postseason action with three moving on to the semifinals and one to the championship.

Under the direction of Coach JP Jugo '05, the tennis team shined, finishing 20-1 overall while winning their first league title since 2003 and first CIF Championship since 2001! The duo of Andrew Loughran '22 and Christopher Marci '24 won the Trinity League Doubles title as well while advancing to the quarterfinals of the CIF Individual Tournament.

Golf also boasted the Trinity League Individual Champion as William Sung '21 (Columbia) won the title for the first time since 2015 narrowly edging his teammate and fellow senior Benjamin Hong (Boston College) who took 2nd. The two went on to lead the team to victory at the CIF/SCGA SoCal High School Regional Championships winning the title for the first time in school history, an impressive feat considering the tradition of excellence Coach Dane Jako has established

within the golf program.

As far as individual efforts go, Max Thomas '22 ran away from the competition, quite literally, during the 2021 track and field season. Not only did he win Trinity League titles in the 100, 200 and anchored the 4x100 relay, he stood atop the podium at CIF in both individual events while breaking Matthew Slater's Servite records dating back to 2003 with times of 10.58 and 21.37 respectively. He did all this while also competing for the soccer team which won its 8th consecutive Trinity League Championship and advanced to the CIF-SS Division 1 semifinals.

It wasn't uncommon for traditional multi-sport athletes to compete simultaneously this year due to the condensed schedule. Brad Riehl '21 joined Thomas as another soccer-track athlete to make his mark in both sports after winning both the 110 and 300 Hurdles at Trinity League Finals as well as running in both relays at CIF.

Thomas wasn't the only Friar to add his name

to the record books in 2021. After deep playoff runs that saw basketball advance to the quarterfinals and volleyball to the semifinals, two players from each sport posted record-breaking performances. Carroll College basketball signee Andrew Cook '21 set a new record for most points in a season with 617 while fellow Class of 2021 graduate Bradley Smith netted a new single-game high making 12 3-point baskets. Meanwhile, in volleyball, Tetairoa McMillan '22 tied Madison Hayden's record from 2012 for most kills in a match posting 36 with fellow junior Jack Morikawa breaking the single-match assist record tallying 64.

There was no shortage of standout performances this year with over 80 student-athletes earning All-Trinity League


recognition while six Friars garnered well-deserved MVP honors including Jared Steins '22 (cross country), Noah Fifita '22 (football offense), Joey Lutfi '21 (soccer), Jesus Melgoza '21 (soccer offense), Merrick Cook '22 (soccer defense) and Roman Martin '23 (baseball Rookie of the Year).

With the continued success of our student-athletes, it's no surprise that 26 Class of 2021 graduates have earned the opportunity to compete at the next level with football leading all sports with eight followed by baseball and soccer with four each.

After such a whirlwind year it's hard to believe that we are already gearing up to do it all again with summer practices underway and the countdown to fall sports beginning!
