Since I last communicated with you, many of us have been busy down at the ground.

The clubhouse has had a makeover, the pitch is prepared ready for the pre-season friendlies whilst myself have been in discussions to make ourselves a viable team on and off the pitch.

I would like to thank those supporters who attended the Pants on the Pitch event it raised some needed income as did the Prosecco Rounders. Not only that it raised a substantial amount for Charity.

Due to rising costs it is with regret that we will have to put match-day entrance fee up a pound across the board.

I hope you will appreciate that it has only been £7.00 for a number of years now, and to have a chance of having a competitive budget we have to put this extra pound on due to the rise in electricity costs also ground equipment has risen above inflation.

The other changes you will notice is that the two cans for a fiver will rise to £6 and the Cost of a pint will be £5.00.

Last season we paid out over £500 in debit and credit card fees therefore can I encourage you to bring cash on match days. That £500 in fees would have been enough for us to pay for the new water pump.

There will also be a small increase in the cost of soft drinks, sweets and crisps.

I am sorry to report that I have had to make these decisions, but if we want to have a competitive team to be proud of, we have to make these small changes in order to compete.

OUR WELCOME GUESTS TO INGLEWHITE ROAD - CHORLEY

Chorley FC were formed in 1883 after switching from rugby to football.

After playing rugby for seven years, pressure was on Chorley to switch to playing football instead, and in 1883 the switch was made.

Chorley joined the Lancashire Alliance, a league which they were crowned champions of in 1892-93 and runners-up in 1893-94.

Chorley bid farewell to the Lancashire Alliance at the end of the 1893-94 season and joined the Lancashire League, winning the championship in 1896-97 which also saw them sell attacker Jack Lyden to Wolverhampton Wanderers for £100 (around £6,000 in today's money), A substantial fee for a non-league player considering that this was eight years prior to the first £1,000 transfer deal.

Chorley spent the first ten years of the 21st century in the Northern Premier League Division 1, the 8th tier of English Football. Following promotion to the Northern Premier League Premier Division at the end of the 2010-11 season, they would end up in the National League not even ten years later.

Unfortunately they suffered relegation back to the National League North the following season.



The club's proudest moment in their recent history, would be the 2020/21 FA Cup run, which saw them be the lowest ranked side in the fourth round proper.

They bested Wigan Athletic, Peterborough United and Derby County before narrowly bowing out to Premier League Wolverhampton Wanderers 1-0

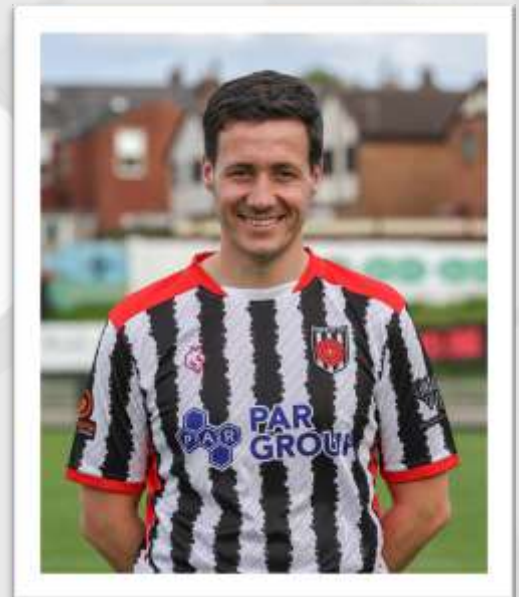

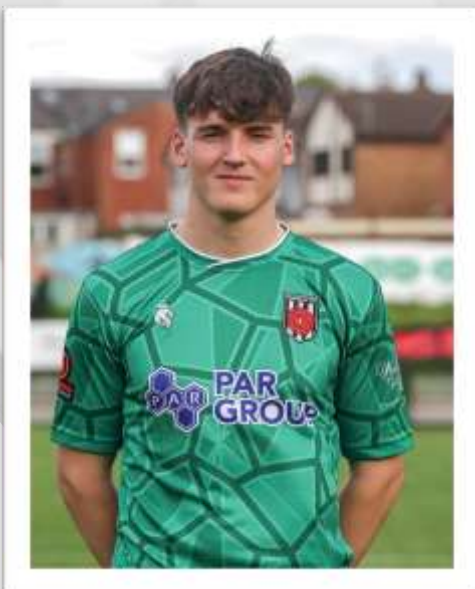
ADAM BLAKEMAN

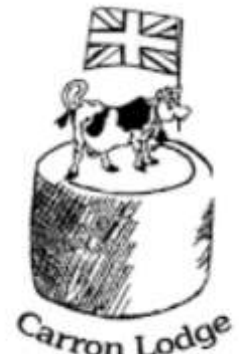

HOW TO DO CPR

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation, or CPR for short, is a simple life-saving technique given to someone in cardiac arrest. It aims to take over the job of the heart and lungs by keeping blood and oxygen flowing through the body.

- 1 CHECK FOR DANGER**
Look around for risks to make sure you won't be putting yourself in danger by helping. 
- 2 CHECK FOR RESPONSE**
Gently shake the person by the shoulders and ask if they can hear you. 
- 3 SHOUT FOR HELP**
If you don't get a response and the person is not breathing or not breathing normally (do not put your face next to theirs when checking), they are in cardiac arrest and you should shout for someone to help you. 
- 4 CALL 999**
Call 999 and make sure an ambulance is on its way. You will be talked through what to do and given the location of a defibrillator if there is one nearby. 
- 5 COVER MOUTH AND NOSE WITH CLOTH**
If you think there is a risk of infection, place a cloth, towel or piece of clothing loosely over the patient's mouth and nose. 
- 6 START HANDS-ONLY CPR**
Put your two hands together and interlock your fingers, place your hands in the centre of the chest and push hard and fast to the beat of Stayin' Alive or Baby Shark. Keep going until professional help arrives or the person starts to regain consciousness. 
- 7 USE A DEFIBRILLATOR**
