The Squeaker Bake Off

Ask Pâtissier Steven..

Make your own incredible Pineapple Upside-Down Cake...

This month, our resident Pâtissier, Steven Newbatt, invites you to make a retro classic, the Pineapple upside-down cake



Method:

• **STEP 1:** Heat oven to 180C/160C fan/gas 4

• **STEP 2:** For the topping, beat 50g softened butter and 50g light soft brown sugar together until creamy.

Spread over the base and a quarter of the way up the sides of a 20cm round cake tin.

Arrange 7 pineapple rings on top (reserving the syrup for later), then place 7 glacé cherries in the centres of the rings.

• **STEP 3:** Place 100g softened butter, 100g golden caster sugar, 100g self-raising flour, 1 tsp baking powder, 1 tsp vanilla extract and 2 eggs in a bowl along with 2 tbsp of the reserved pineapple syrup. Using an electric whisk, beat to a soft consistency.

• **STEP 4:** Spoon into the tin on top of the pineapple and smooth it out so it's level. Bake for 35 mins. Leave to stand for 5 mins, then turn out onto a plate. Serve warm with a scoop of ice cream.

This cake serves 6 and can be frozen if required.

- 100g softened unsalted butter
- 100g golden caster sugar
- 100g self-raising flour
(if using gluten free flour add 1tsp or xanthan gum)
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 2 free range eggs

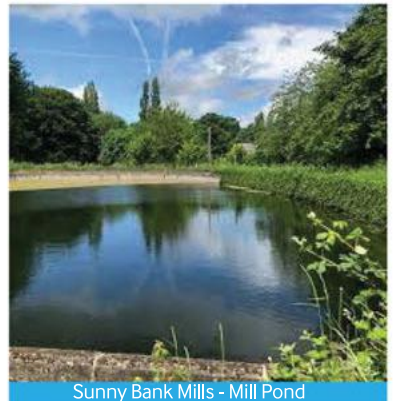
THE HISTORY OF OUR HIDDEN MILL PONDS...

A century ago our local landscapes were dotted with large numbers of mill ponds. Today, they are a rarity.

Usually, these small ponds were, and still are, rectangular or square shaped. As their name suggests, mill ponds were established close to woollen mill buildings. There, the water stored in the ponds was used to power the mills, and, in some instances, was also used to clean raw wool and to make the woven cloth ready for sale.

Almost all the ponds in our area were made between 1790 and 1870. This was a period of great expansion in the woollen textile industry but it was only made possible by creating mill ponds. Though one or two of the early mills were driven by water wheels these mills soon joined the rest in using steam power. But, of course, water was still essential to make steam. The mills could only work when steam could be generated, and this in turn depended on a steady supply of water. Unfortunately, there are long periods without almost any rain falling in our area. These periods are sometimes followed by such large amounts of rain that flooding occurs. In contrast to rainfall, ponds provided a regular flow of water. So, they were an essential means of keeping mills working at all times. Whilst the ponds were replenished by rain water, they were mostly fed by spring water or water from wells. Whilst some mills like Swinnow Moor had only one pond, some, like Wellington Mills, Pudsey had four ponds. Not many ponds were made after 1870 because by that year mains water had become available in most of the district. And by the early years of the twentieth century electric power was increasingly available.

However, many firms that already had ponds continued to use them right until after the Second World War. Thereafter, there was a dramatic decline in our woollen textile industry so today, there are only two working mills left. Some mills were totally demolished and their ponds went with them. But a handful of ponds have somehow or other managed to survive. Salter's Mill Pond at Pudsey Lowtown is open to anglers but fenced off for others. Two ponds survive as amenities at Sunny Bank Mills, Farsley, and these can be glimpsed on open days. Cape Mills Pond, Bramley is difficult to access and is still private land. New houses have replaced Low Mills, Rawdon but the pond has survived to form an attractive setting. *Anthony Silson*

The Day A Pudsey Lad Saved THE IRON DUKE

Sometimes it's the individual contributions in the heat of battle that can have significant outcomes, and one brave and tenacious chap from Pudsey may have changed the course of history itself...

Article from the 1853 Pudsey & Stanningley News:

"One of The Duke's Soldiers at Pudsey"

Benjamin Gaunt, aged 81 years, now living at Pudsey, was in the 33rd in India, under Colonel Wellesley, (*later Duke of Wellington*), and on the night previous to the siege of Seringapatam this old veteran bore the Duke on his back about a quarter of a mile, (*the Colonel*) being slightly wounded in the knee. (*Gaunt*) was one of the orderlies in the 33rd. He is now nearly worn out, and expresses himself anxious to know if there are any now living who took part in the Indian campaign from 1796 to 1805.

This short report hides an amazing story of "What if?"

Benjamin Gaunt born in Pudsey in 1772, served in the Army in 1799 in Seringapatam, Karnataka, India, when he was 27 years old. He was with the 33rd Regiment of Foot based at Halifax, also known as "*The Havercake Lads*" and later renamed "*The Duke of Wellington's Regiment*".

After he left the Army, Benjamin was granted a pension from the Chelsea Hospital.

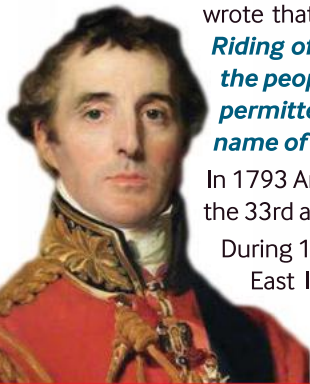
On returning home he married twice and was the father of 5 daughters.

By 1851 he was aged 79, retired and living at 105 Back Fold, Pudsey, with Nancy aged 65, Mary, Mercy and two granddaughters Sarah and Martha Ann. Not long after the newspaper article was published, Benjamin passed away and was buried in Pudsey Parish churchyard 29th May 1853.

The 33rd or Duke of Wellington's Regiment was originally formed in 1702. In 1782 Lord Cornwallis, wrote that "*The 33rd Regiment of Infantry has always recruited in the West Riding of Yorkshire and has a very good interest and the general goodwill of the people in that part of the country:- I should therefore wish not only to be permitted to recruit in that county, but that my Regiment may bear the name of the 33rd or West Yorkshire Regiment*".

In 1793 Arthur Wellesley, the future Duke of Wellington, purchased a commission in the 33rd as a Major and by 1796 had been promoted to full Colonel.

During 1799 the 33rd took part in the Fourth Anglo-Mysore War as part of a British East India Company army. Arthur's eldest brother Richard Wellesley had just become Governor General of India. So in addition to the 33rd, Arthur was given command of the 10,000 men of the Nizam of Hyderabad.



They had a decisive part to play in the Battle of Seringapatam. The regiment, involved in bitter fighting with Tipu Sultan's warriors, were repulsed with heavy losses when they attacked a wood at night, which was strongly defended by the Sultan's forces. The 33rd rallied and fought further actions throughout the battle, with the British emerging decisively victorious and Tipu Sultan being killed. The regiment won a battle honour for its involvement in the action.

Lewin Bentham Bowring gives this account:

"The second column, under Colonel Wellesley...was at once attacked in the darkness of night by a tremendous fire of musketry and rockets. The men, floundering about amidst the trees and the water-courses, at last broke, and fell back in disorder, some being killed and a few taken prisoners. In the confusion Colonel Wellesley was himself struck on the knee by a spent ball, and narrowly escaped falling into the hands of the enemy."

Thanks to Benjamin Gaunt physically picking him up and carrying him out of harms way, Wellesley avoided the grisly fate of eight of his men that were captured and taken into the fortress; they were executed by strangling or having nails driven into the top of their skulls.

Historical significance:

The Battle of Seringapatam was a watershed moment in Colonel Arthur Wellesley's life for a couple of reasons;

Firstly he could very easily have been taken prisoner or killed outright that evening. Both outcomes would have ended his career before the major battles that helped consolidate the British Empire, and the narrow escape gave him a second chance to change his approach.

Always a keen strategist Wellesley reviewed the mistakes he made in Command that night. From then on he resolved **"never to attack an enemy who is preparing and strongly posted, and whose posts have not been reconnoitered by daylight"**.

He participated in a further 60 battles during the course of his military career, leading to him being granted the title of **"Duke of Wellington"** in 1814.

Wellington is famous for his adaptive defensive style, resulting in several victories against numerically superior forces while minimising his own losses. He is regarded as one of the greatest commanders of all time.

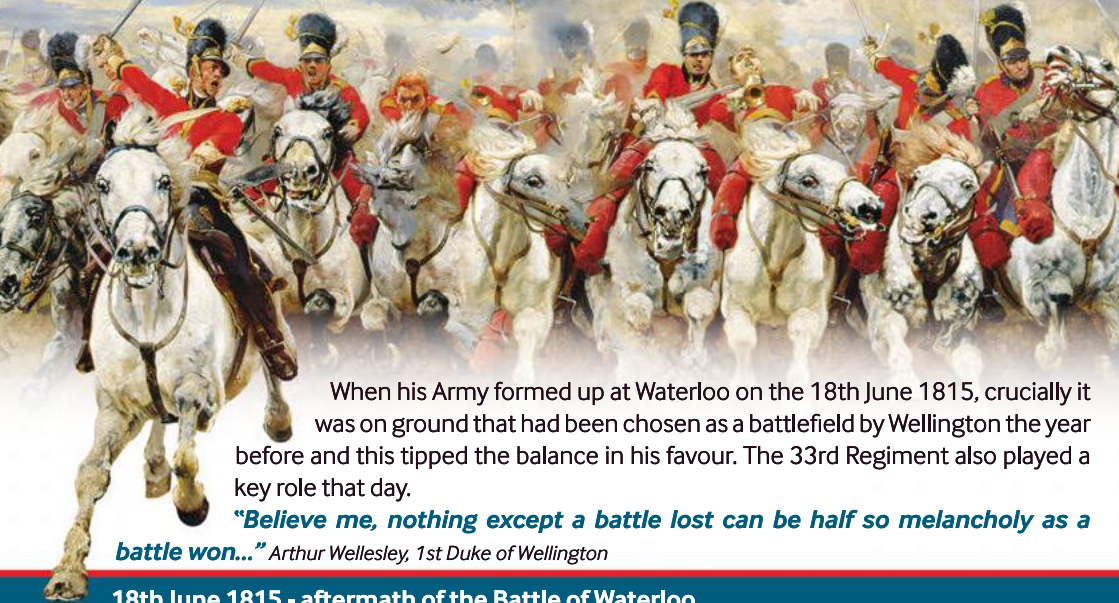

When his Army formed up at Waterloo on the 18th June 1815, crucially it was on ground that had been chosen as a battlefield by Wellington the year before and this tipped the balance in his favour. The 33rd Regiment also played a key role that day.

"Believe me, nothing except a battle lost can be half so melancholy as a battle won..." Arthur Wellesley, 1st Duke of Wellington

18th June 1815 - aftermath of the Battle of Waterloo

The victory of the coalition European forces under the Command of Wellington, against Napoleon's French Army at Waterloo cannot be understated. This changed the power balance in Europe for the next Century, allowing the British, Austro-Hungarian and Russian Empires to flourish, and the states of Germany to finally unify into one Nation.

One musket ball in one knee in India nearly changed the course of history. If Benjamin hadn't have been there, who knows what might have happened?:

No Pubs called the Duke of Wellington
No Battle of Waterloo or Waterloo estate
Nobody ***"Finally facing their Waterloo"***, no ***"Mama Mia" !!***

Certainly Britain wouldn't have been wearing the moniker ***"Great"***, we may have merely been ***"Angleterre"*** or ***"Royaume-Uni Nil Points"***.

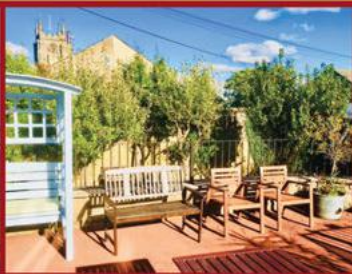

West Leeds Family Practice RISES to the challenges

West Leeds Family Practice are one of a group of practices in West Leeds called a Primary Care Network.

This month, The Squeaker met with Dr John Keene who spoke of the current challenges facing West Leeds Family Practice and their vision for the future.



Why Is It Difficult To Get An Appointment?

The practice like others in the network has been under immense pressure as the lifting of restrictions has uncovered some delayed presentations of patients with cancer and deterioration in medical conditions as well as more staff getting covid. There is also a backlog of long term condition checks, smears and also patients who have had delays in operations/scans from the hospitals. This has also impacted with more needing to be treated in primary care. Access has been difficult for many patients. West Leeds Family Practice is reopening to a more normal familiar General Practice in stages.

What Is New?

We are asking patients their choice if they want to be seen First face to Face or telephone on all 3 sites now. The options to book through the NHS app or system 1 for Nurse and GP appointments has started well. We ask for patience on the phones as we are training new staff and the demand for appointments is high.





The building work is complete now at West Lodge Surgery after nearly 7 months!! We are reopening the site to patients from Monday 18th July. The Calverley extension was opened by Councillor Peter Carlill and West Lodge Surgery was re-opened with a surgical suite named after and by Dr Adrian Lee (*GP Partner for over 40 years*) on 7th July. The building has been a doctors surgery for 150 years and we hope has been reinvigorated with 4 more treatment and consulting rooms and a minor surgical suite to treat patients for many years to come.

Vision For The Future:

The Patient Participation Group of the practice has also suggested that it would be good to share the vision and direction of the practice so the community is aware of the challenges and opportunities for the medical provision in our area:

We have a vision called 'RISE' each letter spells a new aspect of the vision.

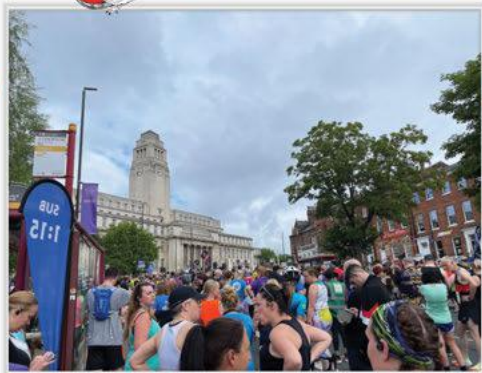

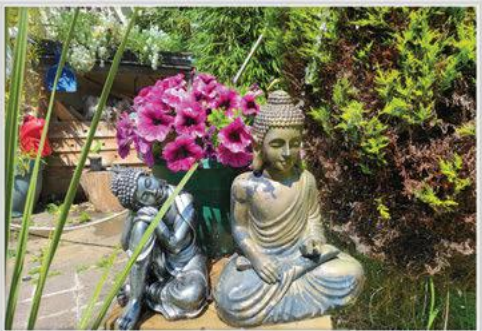

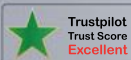
