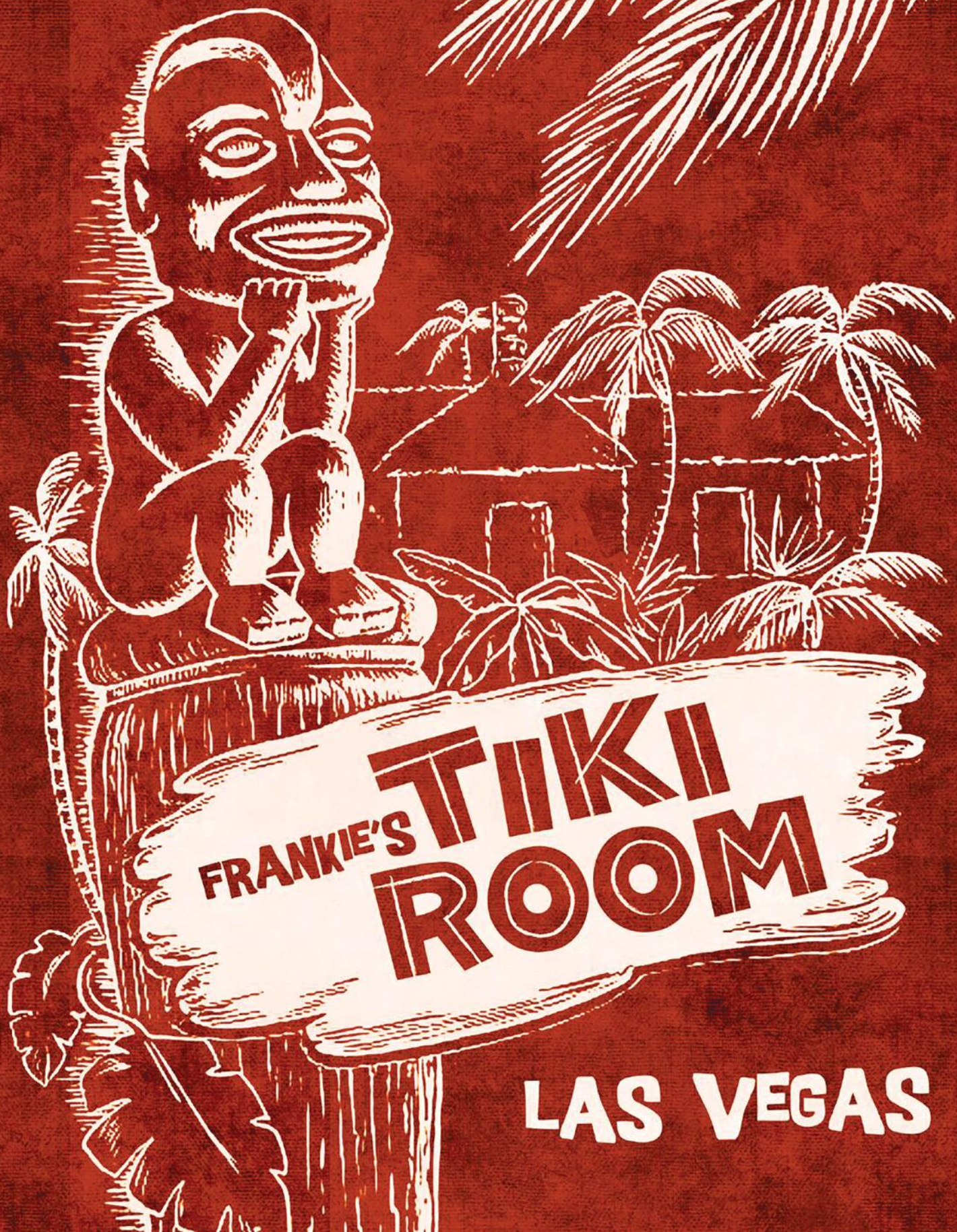

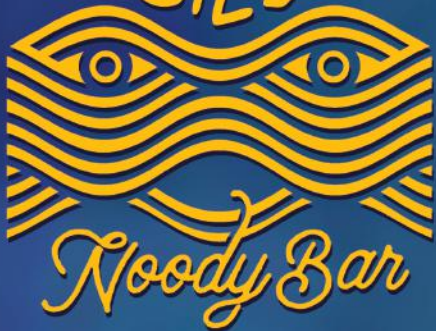

The Catamaran Motor Hotel: A Vacationist's Delight

As Tiki Oasis marks 25 years as the nation's premier island-themed weekender and musical event, we look back on the historic venues they have collaborated with and shared with you.

From humble beginnings at Caliente Tropics Hotel in Palm Springs in 2001, Tiki Oasis had set out to save that location from a de-tiki remodel. Having successfully saved the Tropics but faced with growing pains the event relocated to the legendary Hanalei Hotel in San Diego. Since 2006, Tiki Oasis has been associated with many classic historic locations in San Diego including: Hanalei Hotel (Crowne Plaza) in Mission Valley, Vacation Village (Paradise Point) on Mission Bay, Bali Hai Restaurant on Shelter Island and Town & Country Resort in Mission Valley. Since 2024, Tiki Oasis has included another destination for the mid-century vacationist to add to their long list -- the Catamaran Resort Hotel & Spa. A classic Pacific Island-themed hotel on Mission Bay in San Diego, and home to the area's longest-running annual summer luau, it is now included as Tiki Oasis' opening night party!

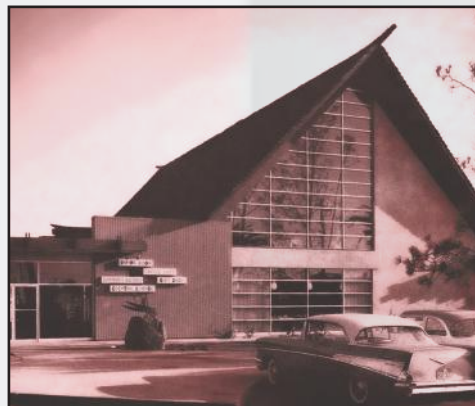
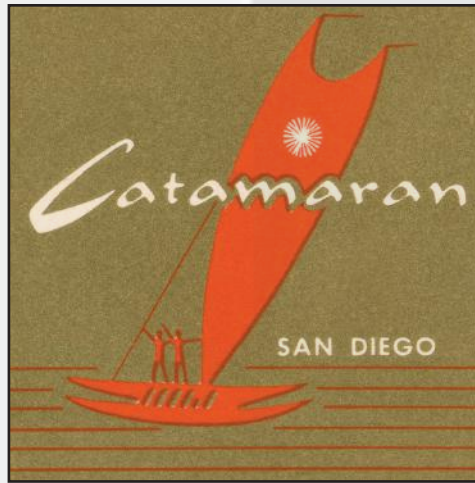
Five years after opening the Bahia Resort Hotel (1953), William and Anne Evans (The Lodge at Torrey Pines) acquired the right to develop land on the northwest beach of what was then called False Bay. The Evans family built their new tropical resort — The Catamaran Motor Hotel. The site was where San Diego's influential Scripps family had built the Braemar Manor. Initially established by Fred and Emma Scripps in 1898 as a Stratford-on-Avon style manor with its own wharf, the seven-acre estate grew to be well-known for its Japanese teahouse, log cabin, and even a replica of the Mayflower on its private beach for the kids. Its gardens and walks hosted annual "garden

fete" fundraisers for the neighboring ZLAC Rowing Club, America's oldest women's rowing club.

The Catamaran Motor Hotel opened in the summer of 1959 with 82 air-conditioned, king-sized rooms furnished by Barker Brothers, two pools (one fed by a "giant waterfall depicting a Hawaiian scene"), and a modern innovation for Southern California hotels — the first system to feature free dial-up phones in each room! A blinking light on the James Bond style panel in your room meant there was a message for you at the front desk. And you could control piped-in music from one of three network channels! It was high technology at its finest.

International cuisine was served in the exotic main dining room. What could be more fun than flaming sword entrees like shish kebab and crab brochette? And how about a stiff drink in the "most spectacular cocktail lounge in Southern California?" Yes, please. The resort featured the large Kon-Tiki banquet room and the smaller Mai Tai room, each with its own restaurant and private bar. The Kon-Tiki Room hosted functions and group events — the Hawaiian treasure/ambassador, Hilo Hattie appeared there with her floor show! The Kon-Tiki Room eventually became the Cannibal Bar offering a variety of dance music from classic rock to reggae (it is now called Moray's Lounge). And who can forget suave San Diego hypnotist Dr. Michael Dean's long-running show at the Cannibal Bar?

The Evans family imported traditional Pacific Island art to decorate the facility, including spears, personal jewelry, hand-woven rugs, and warrior shields from New Guinea. A monumental Tapa cloth made of mulberry bark is proudly displayed above the black



koa wood front desk. The tapa cloth is from the New Hebrides Islands, located off the coast of New Guinea. When it was commissioned, it was the largest created since 1920, and took many different island families over a year to make. Take a stroll through the grounds and you'll see totem poles throughout the lush property, handcrafted in Bali specifically for the Catamaran. And at night you'll get a feeling of being Waikiki

walking by gas lit tiki torches.

To make transportation between the Bahia and Catamaran hotels more convenient for guests, Evans Hotels purchased a 45-foot ferry. They reconstructed it as an authentic Mississippi-style sternwheeler, the Bahia Belle, in 1961. In 1986, they added a second sternwheeler to their fleet, the William D. Evans, a 99-foot ship with capacity for up to 600 passengers. You can still ride the Bahia Belle to the Bahia hotel for free from the Catamaran Hotel!

The Catamaran has continued the tradition of animal shows, offering an exotic bird exhibit and show for its guests. For the past 25 years Catamaran guests have been treated to a Macaw and Parrot show, adding to the jungle feel of the hotel grounds.

Luau on the beach at the Catamaran are family-friendly events with Polynesian food, music, and dance. Some of the Catamaran's first summer luaus were held around 1960. Today the Leiataua family's local luau group, Pride of Polynesia, provides authentic song and dance for the luaus from four of the central Polynesian Islands — Tahiti, Hawaii, Samoa, and Aotearoa (New Zealand), featuring hula and fiery torch dancers, along with the traditional Roasted Kalua Pig.

THE GHASTLY ONES

The Ghastly Ones emerged from the grave to haunt the SoCal surf and garage scene in 1996. These swingin' undertakers took their inspiration from the hopped-up sounds of early sixties surf and hotrod outfits like The Lively Ones and the Fender IV and mixed it with their obsession with monster movies, Halloween records, and Screaming Lord Sutch to patent their "spooky surf" sound. After a record release, tours, creating music for *SpongeBob Squarepants*, and a 20 year hiatus, the band returns!

BLUE HAWAIIANS

The L.A.-based Blue Hawaiians formed in 1994 to play at the newly opened Lava Lounge. Los Angeles scenesters, including Quentin Tarantino, soon became fans of the group's retro exotica sound combined with a seedy, slightly dark edge. In 1995, they recorded their classic album, *Live at The Lava Lounge*. Studio recordings (*Sway*, *Christmas On Big Island*, and *Savage Night* on Interscope Records) soon followed.



THE BOMBORAS

Los Angeles instrumental surf band, The Bomboras, formed in the summer of 1994. This fivesome, donned in Day of the Dead regalia, brings you blazing surf and garage rock inspired by The Ventures, Booker T, and The Sonics tempered by the spirit of The Ramones and The Pandoras. Often accompanied by frenzied go-go dancers and spitting flames, while sometimes destroying their own equipment, the Bomboras' livid funhouse take on surf rock became an object of fan adoration. 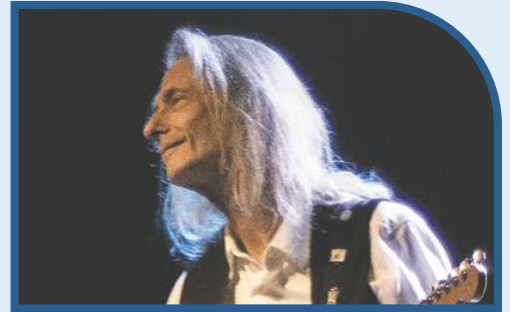

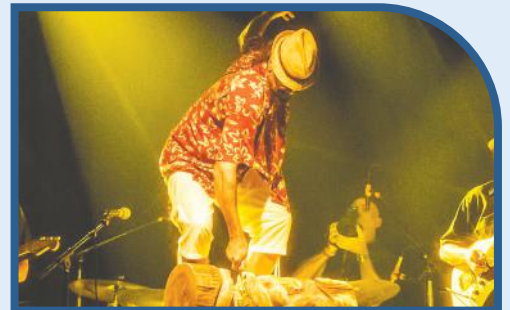

APE is a six-piece band from San Francisco and the only band in the world that features a live Tiki Carver. Rooted in exotica, rock, jazz, and Hawaiian music, their instrumentation is a nontraditional mix of steel guitar, ukuleles, odd-tuned baritone guitars, and more. THE EVOLUTION FROM SKA TO ROCKSTEADY

Ska is a vibrant fusion of musical styles which originated in Jamaica in the late 1950s and early 1960s.
