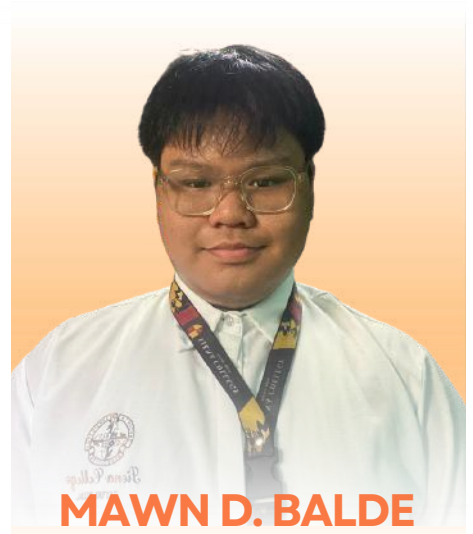

# Grade 10 Thanksgiving Ball: LUMIERE

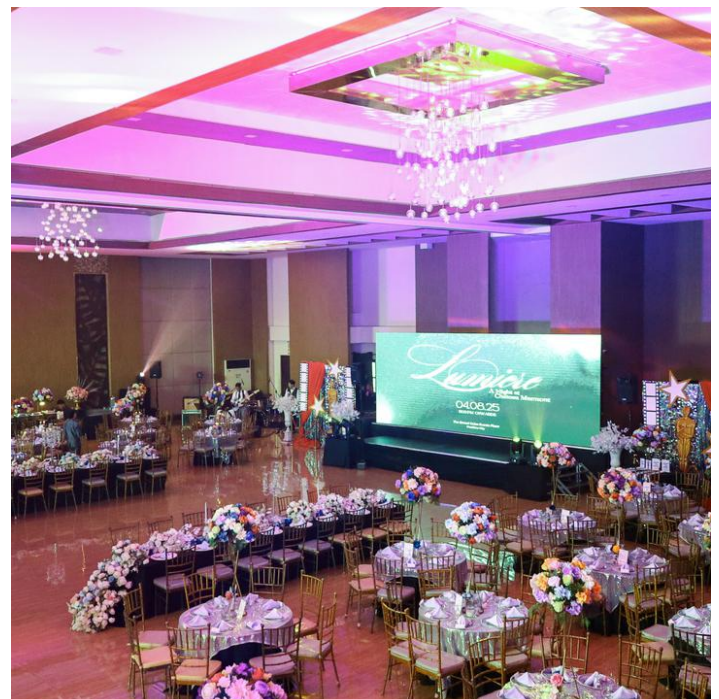


## Description
