Battling extreme cold and wind gusts reaching up to 30 miles per hour, Reece Williams and Christian Mathews led Monsignor Kelly Catholic High School to the team championship at the Nederland High School Invitational, held at Babe Zaharias Golf Course in Port Arthur, Texas. The Bulldogs captured their third consecutive victory and fourth team win of the season, continuing their dominant stretch.

Monsignor Kelly posted a team score of 315, finishing ahead of Hardin-Jefferson (318) and Port Neches-Groves (320) in a competitive field of 108 players.

Williams and Mathews both recorded rounds of 75 (+3) to tie for first place individually in the difficult conditions. Williams secured medalist honors after winning a scorecard playoff, earning his third individual victory of the season, while Mathews finished second after a strong comeback on the back nine that included an eagle and even-par finish over his final nine holes.

The Bulldogs' depth proved to be a key factor, as all five Monsignor Kelly players finished inside the Top 20 individually, demonstrating consistency across the lineup:

- Reece Williams (JR) – 75 (+3), 1st Place
- Christian Mathews (JR) – 75 (+3), 2nd Place
- Skylyn Fisher (SO) – 82 (+10), Tied for 7th
- Lucian Mazzola (SO) – 83 (+11), Tied for 10th
- Landen Roger (SR) – 87 (+15), Top 20

Team Scores:

- 1st – Monsignor Kelly Catholic: 315
- 2nd – Hardin-Jefferson: 318
- 3rd – Port Neches-Groves: 320

Hardin-Jefferson was led by Drake Andrepont, a senior and Texas Western Junior College commit, who finished third individually with a round of 77. Next up, Monsignor Kelly Catholic and Hardin-Jefferson will meet again at Rayburn Country Club in Brookeland, Texas, at the Babe Zaharias High School Invitational, hosted by Monsignor Kelly Catholic High School, on March 6–7, 2026.

Dominant performance by the Bulldogs at Magnolia Creek Golf Club, capturing the TAPPS 5A Bay Area Christian Regional Preview Championship with a season best team score of 295 and a 22 shot victory.

Lucian Mazzola, Landen Roger, and Reece Williams each fired even par 72 to tie for third place, with Roger and Mazzola recording career lows and Williams continuing his consistent top five finishes. Skylyn Fisher added a strong 79 and Christian Mathews finished with an 84, showcasing the depth of this Kelly squad.

This marks back to back tournament championships as the Bulldogs carry strong momentum into the heart of the season.

May this Lenten season be a time of renewal, drawing each of us closer to Christ and strengthening the faith that unites us as Bulldogs.



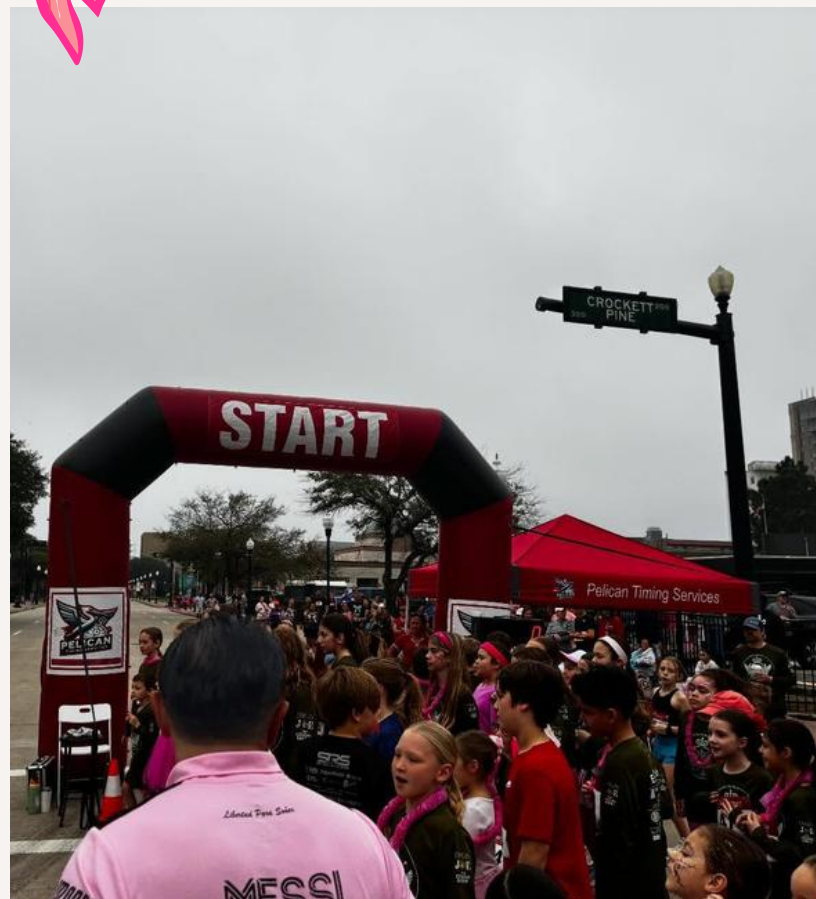

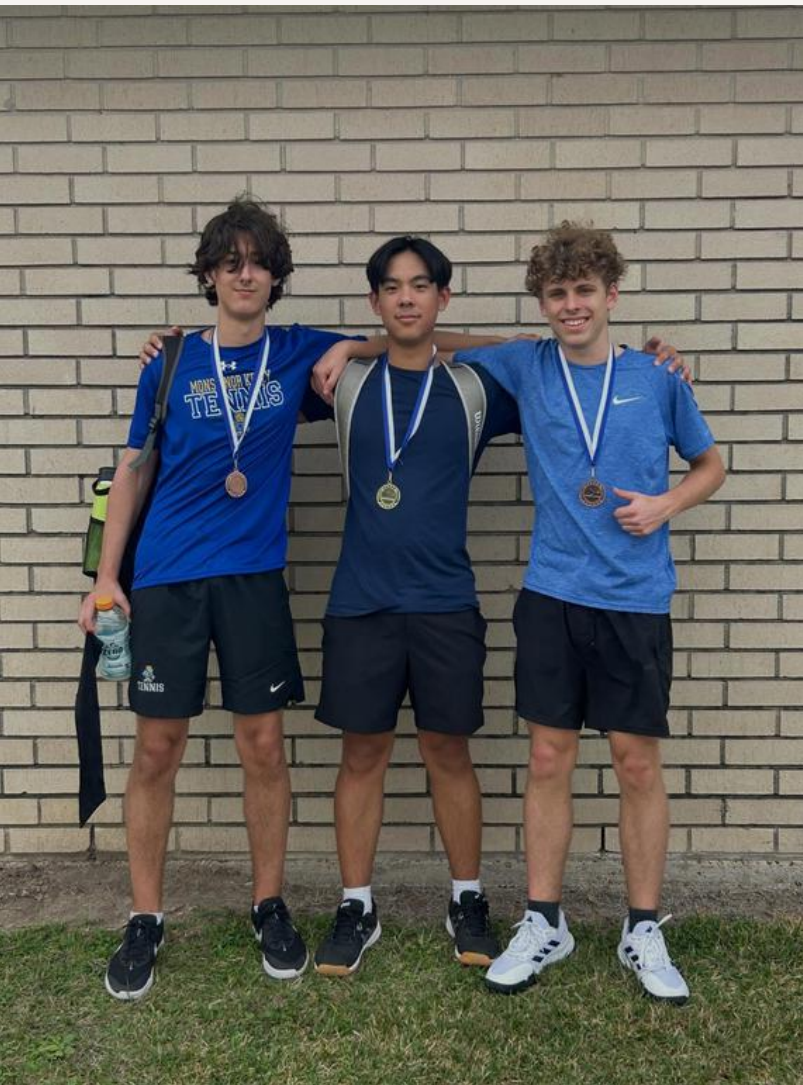
