# MATCHDAY AT HARDING FIELD

## ACCESS

We are very easy to find, right next to the junction of the M5 Motorway and the A38 Gloucester Road. For SATNAV guidance the postcode is BS32 4AA.

## PARKING

Players, officials and club members have a dedicated car park adjacent to the pitch. Access is through the main access gates, left of the tennis courts as shown on the Site Map. Spectator parking can be found surrounding the Almondsbury Creative.



## CHANGING ROOMS

Located at the far end of the car park, changing rooms are accessed via the double doors adjacent to the pitch. Officials changing is straight ahead, with Visitors changing to the right. Toilets are available in each of the changing rooms.

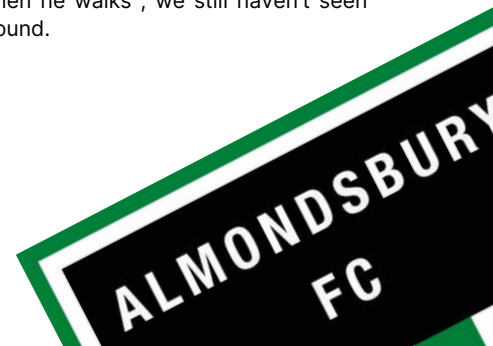

## *OUR TIME IN THE COUNTY LEAGUE*



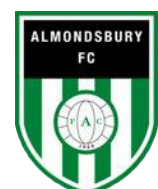

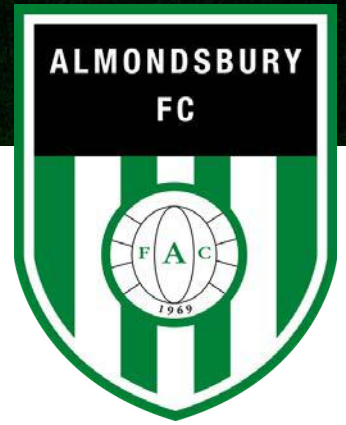

The result, a truly remarkable season, culminating in a league win and the title of Gloucestershire County League Champions. Was it straight forward? Absolutely not! Did we leave it until the last 8 minutes of the season to secure promotion? Yes we did! Would we change anything about it - probably. I'm sure Ash would have preferred it to be done and dusted much sooner.

# AEK BOCO



## TODAYS VISITORS

AEK-BOCO F.C. was formed during the summer of 2003 as the result of a merger between two long-established clubs (AEK Rangers and Boco Juniors).

Today we have approximately 500 children on our books playing in the Hanham Minor League, Avon Youth U18

Combination League and Bristol Girls League. As well as three men's teams and also an U18 Floodlit team along with our very successful three ladies' teams making us one of the largest Clubs in the South West.

We are proud to be one of the first Clubs in the Gloucestershire area to achieve the FA 3 Star Accreditation status.

Our home ground is Greenbank Rd Playing Fields, Greenbank Road, Hanham, Bristol, where through hard work and determination, funded along with the Football Foundation we built our New Clubhouse in 2011. Further development followed enabling us to progress up through the leagues.

### **History of Boco Juniors**

Boco Juniors was formed in 1978 by Bob Boyd, a former director of Bristol City FC, and John Cummins. Named after Bob's company Boyd & Co and the name sake of the Argentinean side Boca Juniors. Bob Boyd's son Robert is now one of the Marcliff Glos County League main sponsors" Boca Teamwear" while John Cummins Grandson Tom recently finished playing for our Junior section.

Famous players that have emerged through Boco Juniors are Mark Cooper (Current Yeovil Town Manager) who is the son of Terry Cooper (Ex England international). Julian Dicks who played for Liverpool and West Ham United. Paul Mardon played for Bristol City & West Brom & was a Welsh International. Darren Lloyd played for West Brom & Darren Carr who played for Chesterfield in the 1997 FA Cup semi-final versus Middlesbrough. Martin Willmott for Bristol City & Darren Harvey for Watford were also former players that played professionally. Mark Johnston- Allen the ex-snooker professional started his career at right back for Boco Juniors. Even Manchester United's' Alex Ferguson spotted a young Ross Millard playing for Boco Juniors and Ross was signed as full time professional only to see his dubbing career cut short by injury.

### **History of AEK Rangers**

In 1977 the club was formed, named after someone who had just holidayed in Greece and an original player being Scottish wanted Rangers in the name, mainly from a group of workmates from DRG, they played at Dundry Playing fields, the first team won The Senior District League in 1995, the team also played at BAWA club.
