Crown Point Cemetery was platted in Kokomo in 1866. There are approximately 33,000 people buried there including many of Kokomo's founding fathers. All fees and services are set by the Crown Point Cemetery Board of Regents. Medicaid burials are available for Kokomo residents. Genealogical inquiries, space purchases, and all questions concerning cemetery services can be directed to the Park Office.

Individuals should remove all flowers or decorations they wish to keep from graves and the mausoleum in Crown Point Cemetery ahead of the annual cleanups on **March 16 and October 15**. Any decoration with a flower attached is considered a decoration. Please do not redecorate graves until March 25 and October 25.
