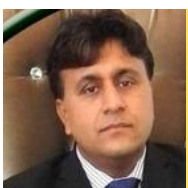

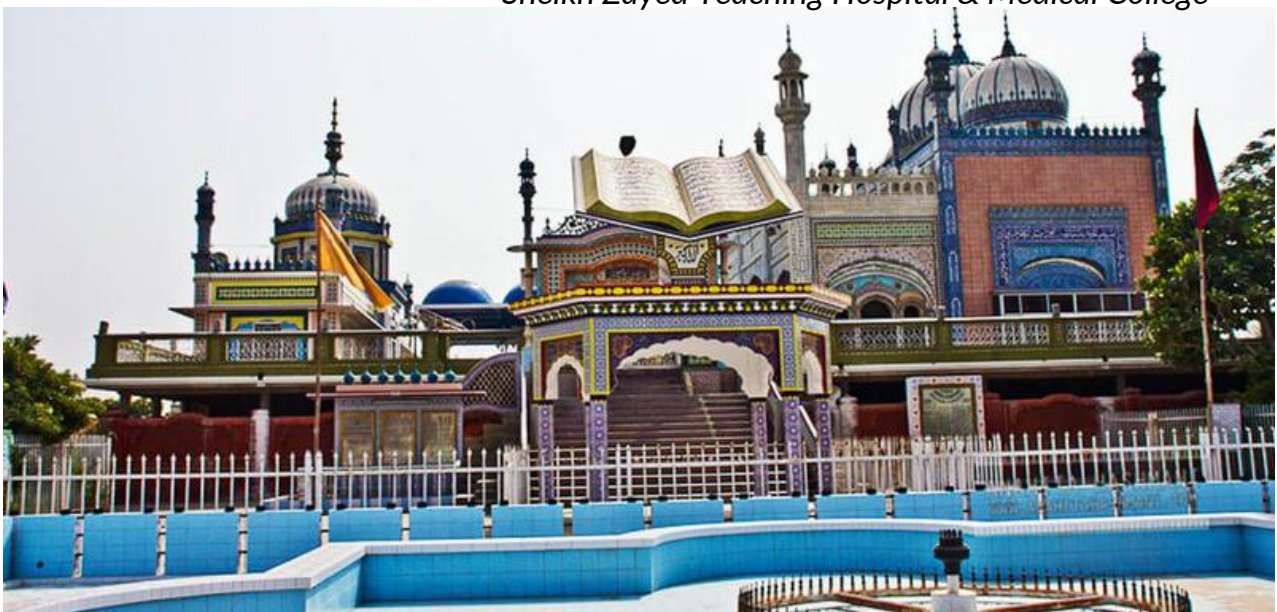
Short History

Under the supervision of Mr. Khuram Pervaiz, Deputy Commissioner Rahim Yar Khan, the District Education Authority (DEA) has launched a major initiative to solarize schools through community engagement and local resources.

So far, the DEA has provided 6 KV solar panels to 45 schools, while 120 schools have successfully partnered with their communities to install solar systems of up to 20 KV. For the current year, 100 additional schools have been selected for solarization—one of the largest district-level solar projects in Punjab.

GPS 263/P Sadiqabad Welcomes Students Back to Classrooms after Eight Years

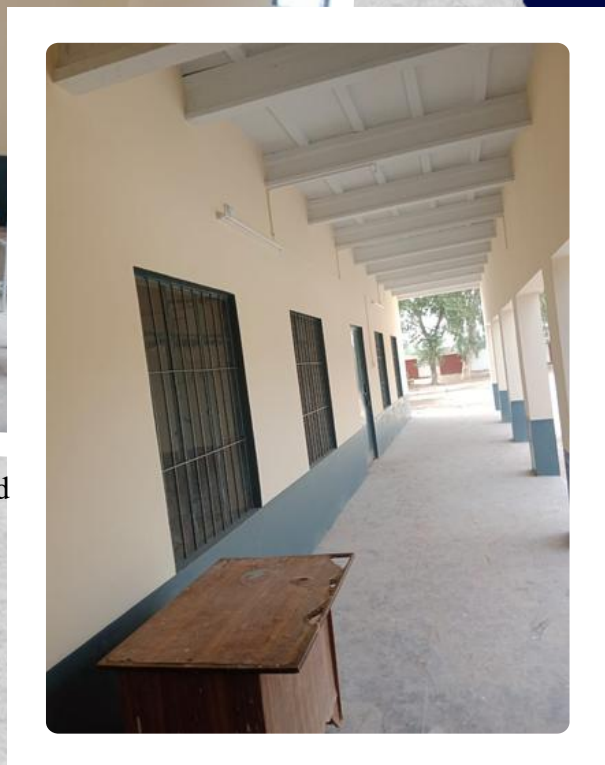


After eight years of closure, Government Primary School (GPS) 263/P Sadiqabad has reopened its doors to students.

Under ILMpact Project



The District Education Authority (DEA) Rahim Yar Khan has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the National Rural Support Programme (NRSP) to strengthen education services for disadvantaged communities.

Under this agreement, 29 qualified teachers will be provided to selected public schools for a period of two years. These teachers are specifically assigned to:

- Deliver remedial learning for students who have experienced significant learning losses.
- Support the inclusion of out-of-school children, helping them transition into the formal education system.
- Improve overall learning outcomes, with a special focus on minorities and girls who face the greatest barriers to education.

This initiative is funded by UK's Foreign common wealth and Development office (FCDO) under the British Council, reflecting a collaborative effort to address educational gaps and promote equity in Rahim Yar Khan. The project aims to provide targeted support where it is most needed, ensuring that vulnerable children receive quality education and the opportunity to thrive academically and socially.

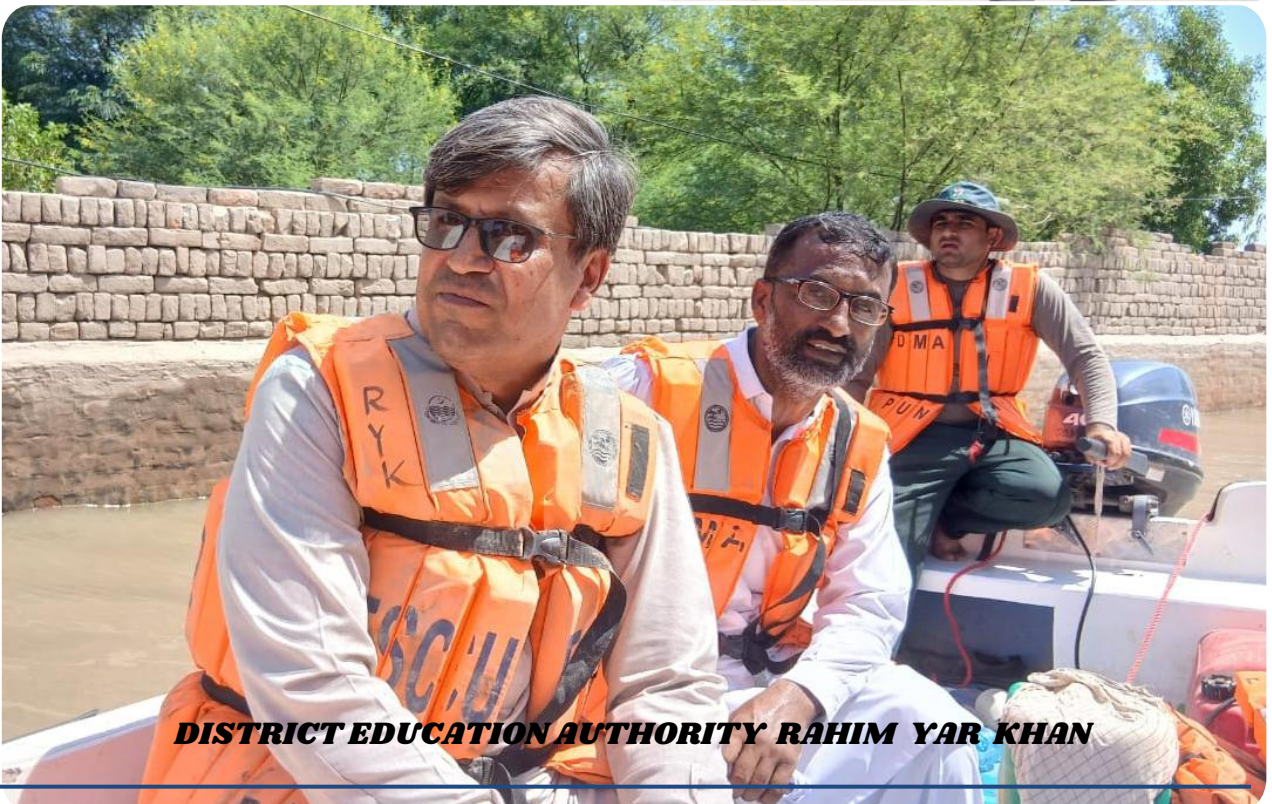
