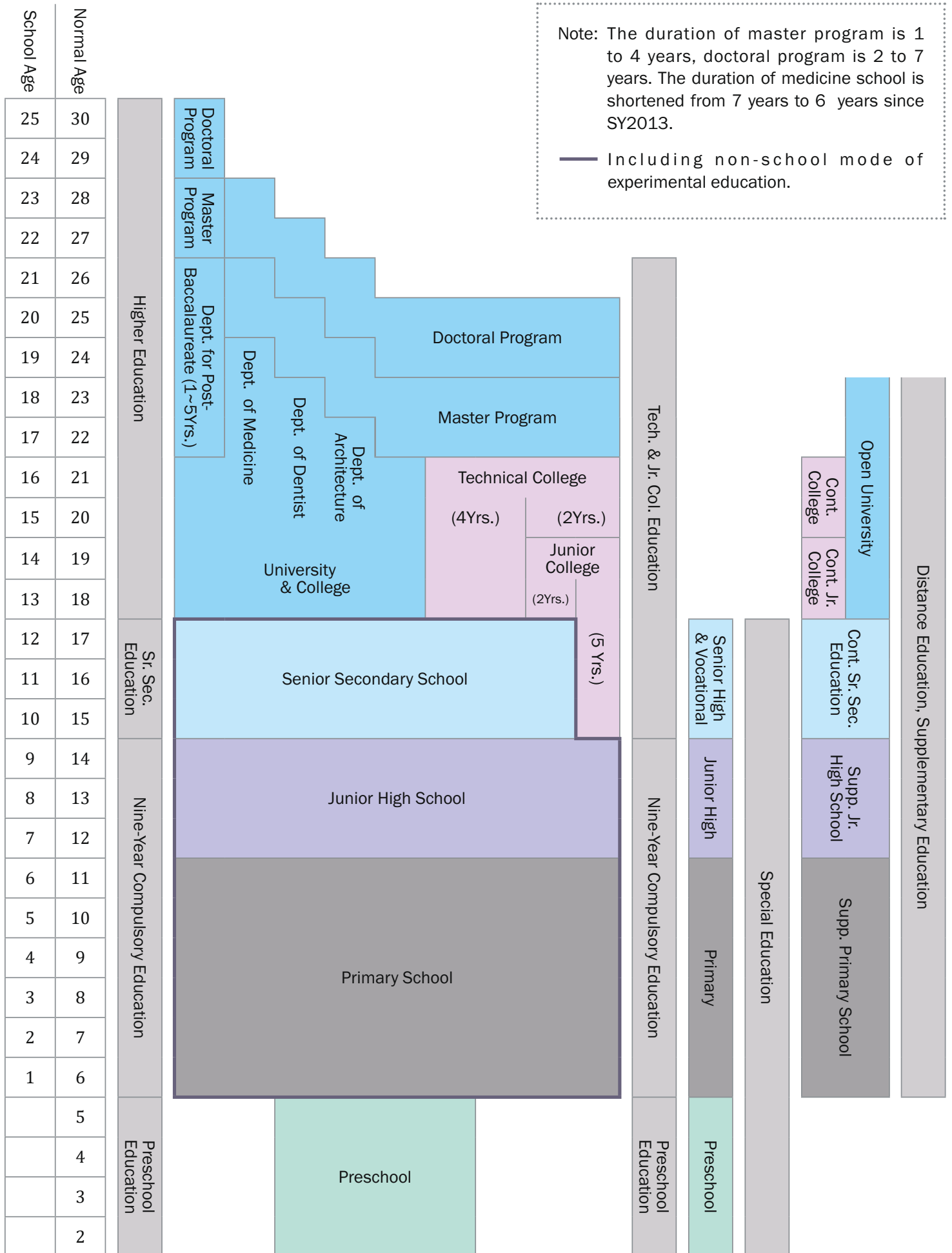

Scholarship

Name of Scholarship: The regulations of the scholarship for International Students of CTU Outstanding academic performance Scholarship

Types of Scholarship may include:

- Tuition Subsidy: Up to 50% reduction in tuition and miscellaneous fees for the top 30% of students; 33% reduction for the top 50% of students - Beginning in the second year

Duration of Award: Undergraduate students: The designated years of study for the program. Master's students: Up to 2 years

Available Departments/Programs: All available departments and programs for international degree students

Eligibility: All international degree students can apply.

Application: Applicants only need to check the scholarship application box in the degree online application system.

1. International students applying for admission must submit the admission application form, scholarship application form, and transcripts from their previous school.
2. International students who already enrolled at CTU may apply for the scholarship separately through the Office of International Affairs by submitting their official transcripts from the university along with the scholarship application form before the end of July each year.

Central Taiwan University of Science and Technology



Central Taiwan University of Science and Technology (CTUST) is located in Dakeng Area, Beitun District, Taichung City. It is surrounded by natural mountains and rivers with poetic scenery. CTUST is an educational institution that emphasizes not only professional expertise but is also a full of humanistic care and environmental sustainability. In terms of talent cultivation and industry-university cooperation, it is not only well recognized in Taiwan but also in the Asia-Pacific region (especially Southeast Asia). CTUST was selected as “Enterprises' favorite college in the central region of Changtuo” in 2021 in the survey of 1111 Manpower Bank. Noticeably, our university was ranked among the Top 6 universities most favored by healthcare institutions in 2024.

1. Priority will be given to those who list the University as their first choice and have financial difficulties or hold proof of financial hardship.
2. From the second semester of the first academic year onward, the application requirements are as follows:
3. Undergraduate and junior college students must have an overall average score of 75 or above.
4. Applicants must be within the top 50% of their class ranking.

Current students (Undergraduate: second to fourth academic years; Master: second academic year; PhD.: second to fourth academic years): Students who reach the scores of one's conduct in each semester over 80 and have not received any punishment by recording a demerit, and the average score for their previous academic year should reach over 80. Qualified students may apply according to the deadline of the announcement.

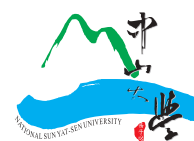

- Amount and duration: Once the Graduate Assistantship Committee granted the applications, international graduate students will be awarded 100 % or 50 % tuition waiver. Full-stipend graduate assistantships: NT\$ 8,000 per month; half-stipend graduate assistantship: NT\$ 4,000 per month. For the fall semester, the assistantship will be granted from October to March; for the spring semester, the assistantship will be granted from April to September. The stipend is provided from the month of registration to the month of graduation. Suspended students will receive the stipend until the month of suspension. The stipend will be provided to Master students for up to two years and to Ph.D. students for up to three years. The Committee may extend the period after evaluation if necessary.

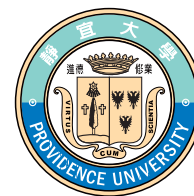

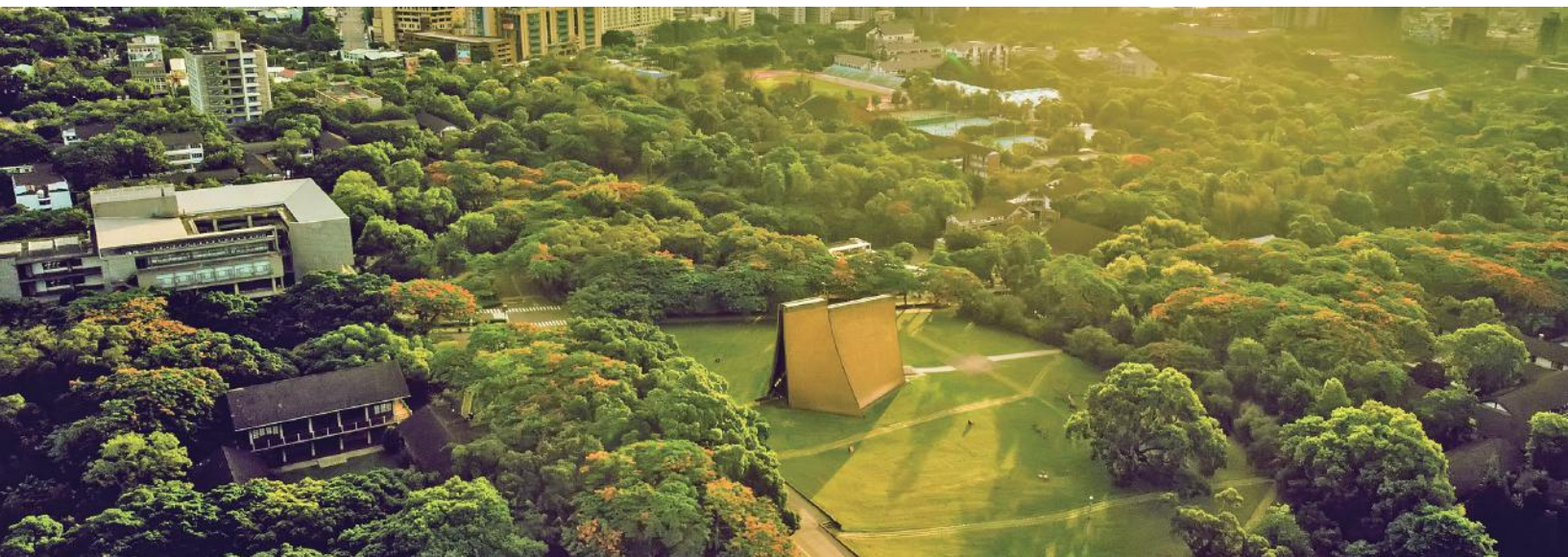

Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language

The Ministry of Education of R.O.C.(Taiwan) requires foreign students applying for Chinese-taught programs to achieve at least Level 2 on the TOCFL.

Introduction

Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) is developed by Steering Committee for the Test Of Proficiency-Huayu (SC-TOP). Since TOCFL was launched in December 2003 in Taiwan, it has been administered in Japan, South Korea, Vietnam, Laos, Thailand, India, Malaysia, Indonesia, Canada, New Zealand, Australia, the United States, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Brazil, Paraguay, Argentina, Belgium, Sweden, the United Kingdom, France, Netherlands, Germany, Switzerland, Poland, Austria, Russia, and Turkey. More overseas test centers will be established in the near future.

Target Test-Taker

TOCFL is a foreign language proficiency test for non-native speakers of Chinese. Anyone who wants to know their Chinese proficiency level, and anyone who wants to study, work, or do business in Chinese-Speaking countries or contexts is welcome to register for the test.

Purpose

Test-takers are eligible to receive a certificate for each test that they register for and pass.

The TOCFL certificate can serve as evidence of Chinese proficiency for the purposes below:

- (1) Requirement for Taiwan scholarship programs.
- (2) Admission requirement for colleges and universities for international students in Taiwan.
- (3) Proof of Chinese proficiency for employment applications.
- (4) One of the Chinese admission requirements for the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students (UECOCS) in the test-exempt areas.
- (5) Obtaining bonus points under the Points System for foreign and overseas Chinese students to work in Taiwan.

Test Framework

TOCFL is aligned to the CEFR and the ACTFL proficiency guidelines. The evaluation range includes 4 bands and 8 levels. The development of Band Novice provides more opportunities for Chinese beginners to prove their Chinese proficiency.

Features

In the drawing up level descriptions, designing test takers, testing, and scoring, TOCFL has been standardized and developed under strict scrutiny of researchers and scholars in the field of linguistics, and language teaching and testing.

As a proficiency test, TOCFL does not develop its test items based on any specific language textbooks, but extracts the content from language materials in daily life, such as natural life dialogue, advertisements, radio programs, public announcements, lectures, weather forecasts, notices, letters, and memos. The topics cover literature, science, arts, astronomy, history, and so on.

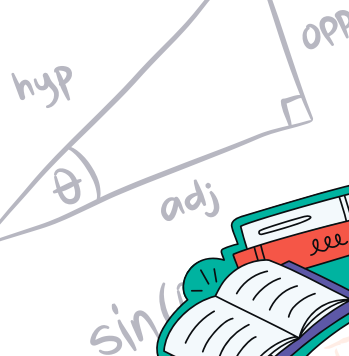

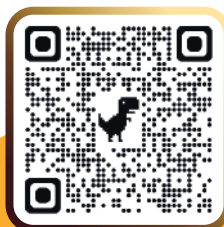
