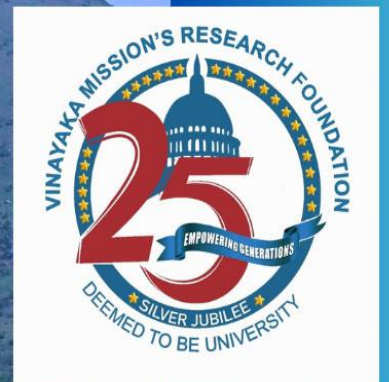

SWASTH NARI SASHAKT PARIVAR ABHIYAAN (SNSPA) CAMP

From 20th to 26th September 2025, the Department of Community Medicine organized a series of Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan (SNSPA) camps across various locations, in collaboration with multiple clinical departments.

The first camp was held on 20th September at FAP Field Area, Neikarapatti, with support from the Departments of General Medicine, Paediatrics, and OBG. A total of 62 beneficiaries attended, and 15 were referred for further medical care.

On 21st September, the camp at Vengayanoor saw active participation from the Departments of General Medicine, Ophthalmology, OBG, ENT, and Dermatology. It served 110 beneficiaries, with 25 referred for advanced evaluation and treatment.

The 22nd September camp at UHTC, Agraharam, organized by General Medicine and Psychiatry, benefitted 31 participants, and 8 were referred for specialized care.

On 23rd September, the camp at Poolavari was conducted with the involvement of OBG, Paediatrics, and Ophthalmology departments. It reached 93 beneficiaries, with 27 requiring referrals.



The subsequent camps at Poolavari were organized by Community Medicine and Paediatrics, serving 23 beneficiaries on 24th September and 30 beneficiaries on 25th September, providing essential healthcare services and consultations.

The final camp in the series was held on 26th September at UHTC, benefitting 26 individuals with medical consultations, screenings, and follow-up referrals.

LECTURE ON “LIBRARY EXCEPTIONS UNDER THE INDIAN COPYRIGHT ACT: AN ANALYSIS OF THE SCI-HUB CASE”

Sakthivel, Professor and Dean (Research) at Tamil Nadu National Law University. The lecture, titled “Library Exceptions under the Indian Copyright Act: An Analysis of the Sci-Hub Case,” traced the evolution of library science from Ranganathan’s Five Laws to contemporary legal frameworks.
