FROM THE DIRECTOR

On February 6, we opened the long awaited museum expansion, The Steven Alan Bennett & Dr. Elaine Melotti Schmidt Pavilion to the public. That first week we welcomed several thousand visitors with the entire museum filled with the MMA collection including the promised gift of The Bennett Collection in a special exhibition in our new feature gallery, called *Transcending Tradition: Selection of Works from The Bennett Collection of Women Realists*. Even the historic building feels brand new as we have reinstalled all the galleries with more of the permanent collection as well as a new dedicated studio glass gallery.

We've always said, it's not what you build, but what you put in the building. We have an active exhibition and programming schedule up to 2028, which we will announce in the future, and the rest of 2025 will be one of the most exciting in years.

Spring was all about family and students at the MMA with *Expressions: The 43rd Annual Muskegon County Student Art Exhibition*, Spring Break Party, *Postcard Salon*. If you have not yet dropped into our new art activity studios, grab the kids, get a coffee in the new gift store, and pay it a visit.

The Bennett Prize: Rising Voices 4 opened in our new modern spaces on May 15 with a major reception and always exciting reveal of the winner. In conjunction is the solo exhibition of the winner of the 2023 Bennett Prize winner, Deng Shiqing. After these exhibitions close, they will travel the country for two years.

Julia Child: A Recipe for Life, an immersive exhibition around her life, opens on June 5 and is our first major summer exhibition in the new galleries. Look for an invitation to a special members-only preview event.

Thank you for all your amazing support over the last several years. You made this happen! If you have not been to the new MMA, what are you waiting for? Please come by and enjoy your new art museum.

JANET DAY



Janet Day was an active MMA volunteer and donor for over 40 years. She passed away in December and as an organization, we wanted to recognize the many ways that she enriched the MMA.

Janet served as a MMA board trustee from 1995 to 2003, which included a term as board chair. She generously gave her time and talents serving on a variety of MMA committees including the Gala Committee and the Collections Committee where she served from its inception. She was a devoted member of Friends of Art and was its president from 1985–86 as well as serving as president of the West Shore Graphics Art Society from 1993–94. Janet organized the MMA's first volunteer corps and was key in setting up the MMA Museum Store. She was the leader of the Reach-Out Committee providing a task force of speakers, docents and receptionists and played a large role in organizing the MMA's Affair of the Arts, Designer Show Houses, and Holiday Carousels. Janet was named the MMA's first Volunteer of the Year at the first ever volunteer recognition event in 1986. And most recently, she received the MMA Gala Star Award in 2022.

We are grateful for Janet's passion and dedication to the Muskegon Museum of Art over the decades. Her contributions to this institution have been immeasurable. As we welcome in this new chapter of the museum's expansion, we cheer to Janet and her spirit that we hope to carry on into the future.

LEAVING A LEGACY TO THE MMA

Maxine Joyce (Hallberg) McLean

Maxine Hallberg was a longtime patron of the Muskegon Museum of Art even though she moved from here many decades ago to the Chicago area. Maxine passed away on December 23 and left to the MMA a significant gift that will help to endow our children's programs here into the future including Project-Based Learning (Aesthetic Education), funding School Bus Tours, our Spring Break program, and *Expressions: The Muskegon County Student Art Exhibition*. Maxine shows that remembering the MMA in your estate plans can make a tremendous difference.

Maxine J. Hallberg (known as "Max" to her friends) was born July 9, 1931, in Muskegon. She grew up in Muskegon enjoying summers in a cottage on the shores of Lake Michigan and visiting the Muskegon Museum of Art, which was a few blocks from her house. Maxine graduated from Muskegon High School in 1949.

After high school, Maxine graduated from Muskegon Junior College 1951 and went on to Michigan State College of Agriculture and Western Michigan College earning her BA and MA respectively. She married and moved to Illinois beginning her teaching career in the Wheaton Community Unit School District 200. In 1962, she began teaching kindergarten in the newly opened Sandburg School and continued instructing kindergarteners at Sandburg until her retirement in 2002.

After her retirement from teaching Max continued to reside in Illinois, but her heart never left Muskegon, Michigan. She owned a townhouse a few steps from the Muskegon shoreline, visiting her childhood home as often as possible. Donations in Maxine's memory can be made to the Muskegon Museum of Art and will be used for our Children's Educational Programming.

DENG SHIQING: THE COST OF LIFE

MAY 15 - AUGUST 24

Surrogacy is the inspiration behind 2023 Bennett Prize winner Deng "Demo" Shiqing's solo exhibition, *Deng Shiqing: The Cost of Life*. The paintings in this series were created during her two-year Bennett Prize grant and represent the freedoms it provided to explore new directions in how, and what, she creates. Combining realistic rendering with passages of loose, expressive brush work, drawing, and abstract patterns and mark-making, the artist's maturing style establishes an engaging emotional tension, building upon her signature motifs of exaggerated, elongated limbs and fantastical costuming to establish a new level of art-making.

A Recipe for Life



June 5 - September 1

Julia Child: A Recipe for Life explores the key ingredients in Julia Child's personal journey, which became part of America's culinary revolution, through a series of immersive experiences. Julia's insatiable curiosity and tenacious spirit drove her to endlessly try, test, and teach how to make delicious food. Learning to cook empowered Julia, and she empowered others, profoundly transforming American cuisine and food culture in the process.

Visitors will experience interactive spaces like The French Chef television studio, where they can operate a vintage video camera, mix "ingredients", and feel like part of the show. Photographs by Julia's husband, Paul Child, are also included, along with her personal correspondence and favorite kitchen tools.

COLLECTIONS

HIGHLIGHT

Upon entering the Muskegon Museum of Art's new expansion, guests are greeted by a sculpture of glass and resin that hangs suspended from the atrium ceiling to reach down through the grand stair. *One's Self I Sing*, by Wisconsin-based sculpture artist Beth Lipman, was over two years in the making, a site-specific work commissioned by the MMA in honor of our expansion.

One's Self I Sing references our current marking of human existence to "Deep Time," or geologic time, a vast span of years beyond our immediate comprehension. The clear glass objects that comprise the work are drawn from records of human making, items found in museums and the artist's personal collection, as well as the MMA's own permanent collection. Keen-eyed visitors will see the apron bow from Edward Hopper's *New York Restaurant*, the scythe from Winslow Homer's *Answering the Horn*, a gate, wagon wheel, and fence post from John Steuart Curry's *The Tornado*, and the archer's bow from Frederick MacMonnies' *Diana*, among others. Set against the glass are white resin blocks, the foundation from which the glass emerges and ascends. The glass pieces are a tribute to the collective of humanity, of growth and achievement marked by the objects we make and the history they hold.

The title is drawn from the Walt Whitman poem of the same name.

*One's-Self I sing, a simple separate person,
Yet utter the word Democratic, the word En-Masse.*

*Of physiology from top to toe I sing,
Not physiognomy alone nor brain alone is worthy for the Muse,
I say the Form complete is worthier far,
The Female equally with the Male I sing.*

*Of Life immense in passion, pulse, and power,
Cheerful, for freest action form'd under the laws divine,
The Modern Man I sing.*

Beth Lipman is a nationally recognized sculpture artist with works in the permanent collections of the Smithsonian American Art Museum, Brooklyn Museum of Art, Corning Museum of Glass, Detroit Institute of Arts, Rhode Island School of Design Museum, and many others. She recently completed *ReGift* for the Toledo Museum of Art and *Living History* for the Wichita Art Museum, and is currently at work on an outdoor sculpture for Iowa State University's campus.
