She asked, "What is your name?" I said, "Shreeji and yours?" She said, "Pragati." She also said that she was studying in the 6th standard and had

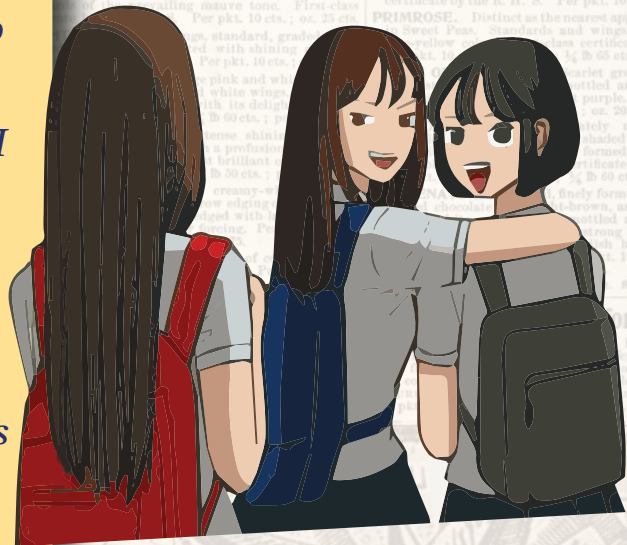


joined the drawing class. From that day, I spoke with her. She helped me, supported me, and told me about the mistakes I had made. Soon, we became best friends.

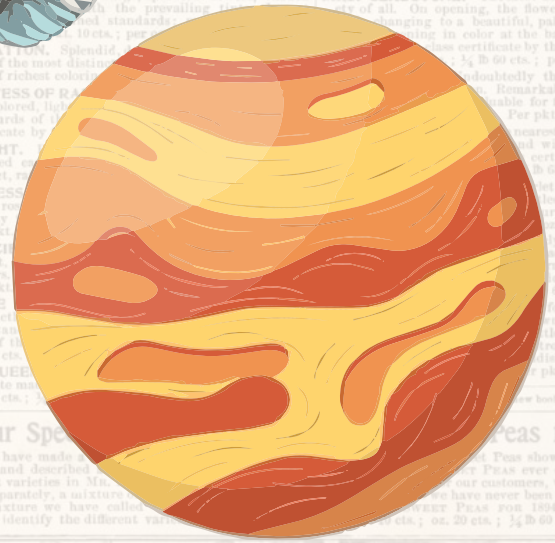
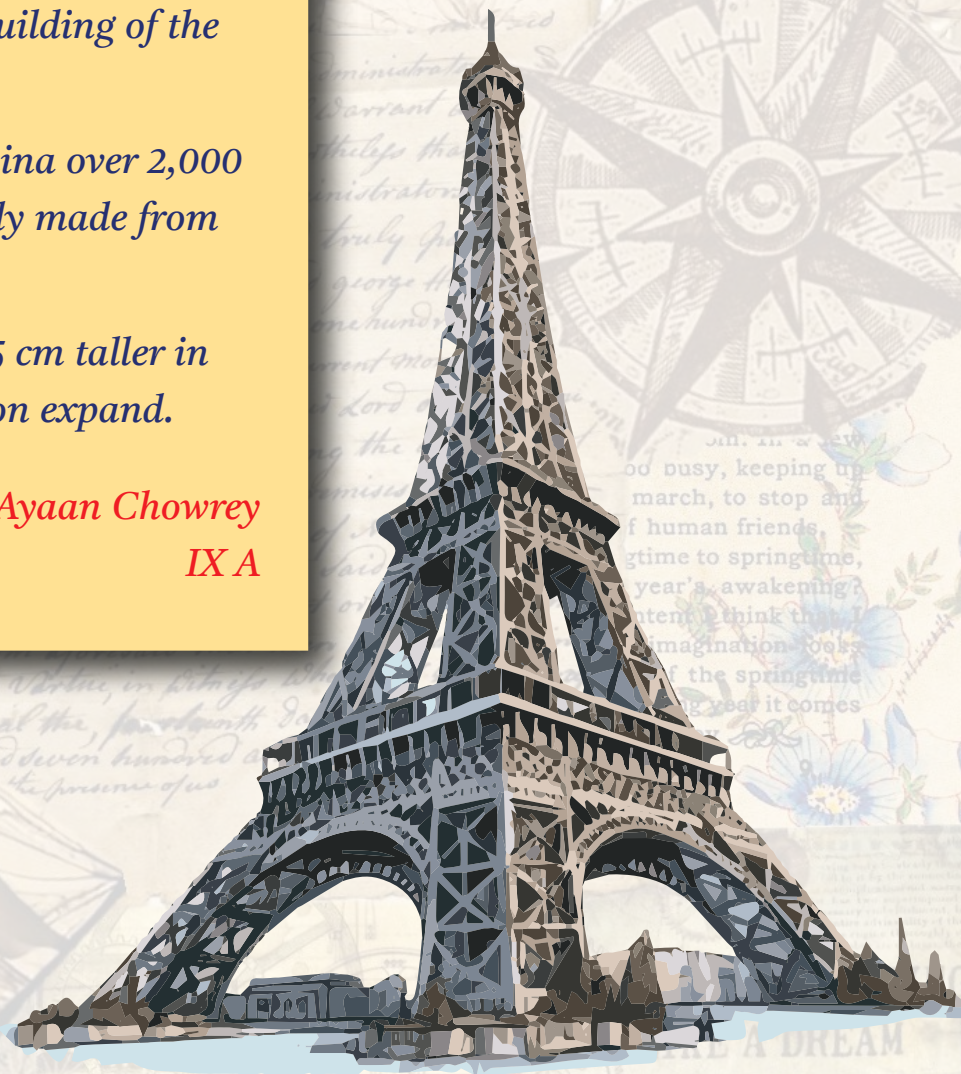

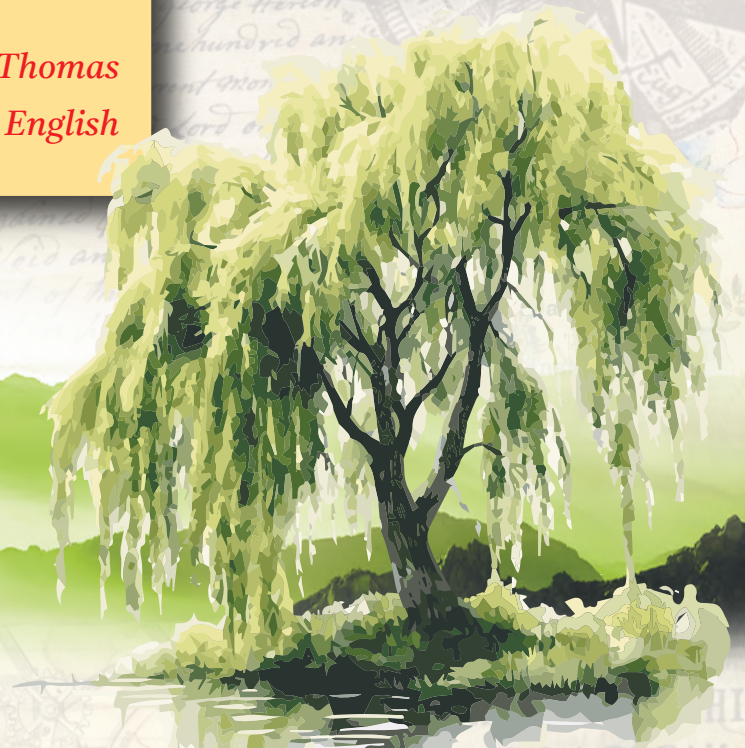

How Parents Can Support Learning at Home?

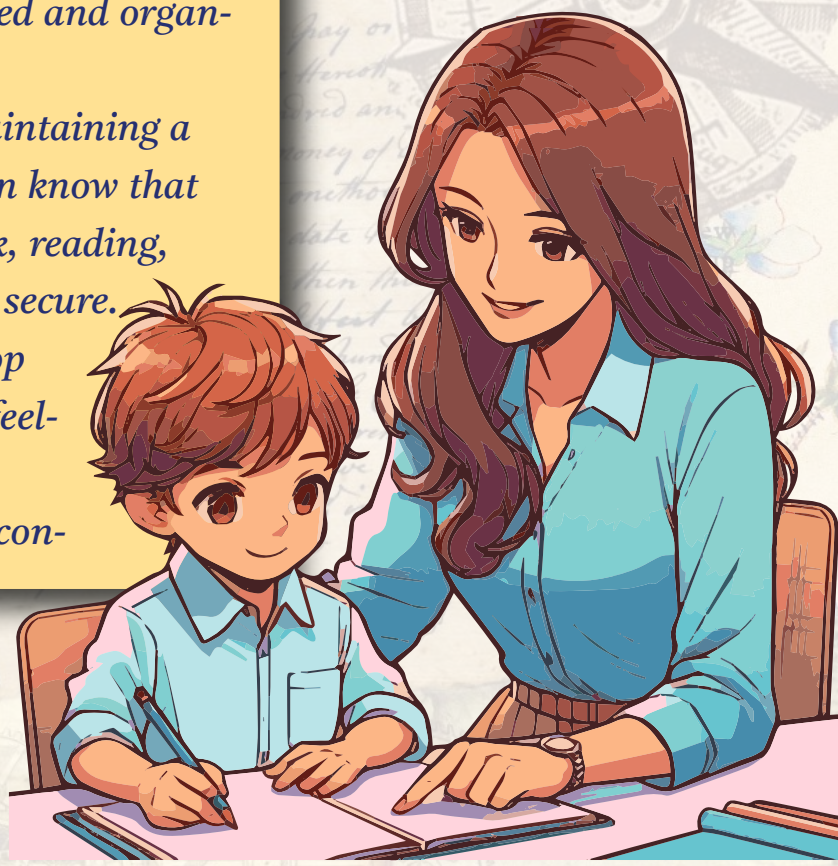

versations at home strongly influence learning.

Asking children about their day, what they learned, or what they found interesting encourages them to think, recall, and express themselves. These small discussions make children feel valued and confident.

One practice that always shows positive results is reading together. Even 10 minutes of shared reading builds vocabulary, concentration, and imagination. Many students tell me proudly that their favourite time of the day is when someone at home reads with them or listens to them read.

Lastly, I encourage parents to appreciate effort rather than only the final score. When children feel supported and encouraged, they develop a healthier attitude towards learning and are more willing to try new things.

From my experience, I have learned that when the school and home work together, children grow into independent, motivated, and confident learners. The support you provide—through attention, routine, and encouragement—creates the foundation for your child's success.
