REGISTERING FOR CAMP

ymcacny.org/ myaccount

STEP ONE

Go to ymcacny.org and click on the My Account button the in top right corner (if you are on your phone, click the Menu button in the top right corner, then My Account)



STEP TWO

Sign into your account if you have one. If you don't, click the Sign Up button to create a "Non-Member" account. There is no charge for the "Non-Member" account.



STEP THREE

Once you have signed in, click the Programs button on the top of the screen.



STEP FOUR

Find the program category labeled Summer Camp. If you cannot find that program label, make sure you have the Branch you are looking for selected at the top!



STEP FIVE

Find your camp at the top of the screen where it says "Programs that match your search" and click that camp. If you don't see the program you are looking for, check the Locations on the left side of the screen and make sure you location you want is selected. If you are on your phone, you can find the Locations under the Filters button at the top of the screen.





STEP SIX

Click the sessions of summer day camp you would like and follow the prompts to fill out your child's information. You can select multiple sessions at a time.



If you are registering your child for different summer day camps, complete your registration and pay your first deposit before starting your next registration. If you do that, your child's information will auto populate for the next registration.

BASIC POLICIES

Registration is happening in two waves this year: member-only registration beginning January 15th and open registration beginning January 22nd.

In order to qualify for member pricing, you must have a family membership for the YMCA of Central New York at the time of registration and sustain your membership through your summer day camp season. Youth memberships qualify for early registration, but not for member pricing.

If you have to cancel your membership before summer day camp, you will be charged the non-member rate for your summer day camp weeks, even if you rejoin before the summer.


Camp Dependent
