

Next Leap Year is 2020

Leap year isn't going to happen this year. Only once every four years you get an extra day. Saturday, February 29th, 2020 is the next time an we'll get to have a 366-day year instead of 365 days. Leap days are necessary to keep our calendar inline with the earth's revolutions around the sun. Here are some other fun facts about leap years and days:

Leap years are needed to keep our modern day Gregorian calendar in alignment with the earth's revolutions around the sun. It takes the earth approximately 365.242189 days – or 365 days, 5 hours, 48 minutes, and 45 seconds – to circle once around the sun. If we don't add that extra day on February 29th every four years, we would loose almost 6 hours every year. After 100 years, the calendar would be about 24 days off.



There is a leap year every year whose number is perfectly divisible by four - except for years which are both divisible by 100 and not divisible by 400. The second part of the rule effects century years. For example; the century years 1600 and 2000 are leap years, but the century years 1700, 1800, and 1900 are not.

A few countries that have a different "leap" ... the Chinese calendar adds a whole leap month every 3 years. The name of a leap month is the same as the previous lunar month. The last Chinese calendar leap month began on October 24, 2014. The next leap month will be in 2020, when a second lunar month 4 will be observed. A leap year in the Ethiopian calendar occurs when an extra day is added to the last month of the year every four years. A year in the Ethiopian calendar is 13 months long, with 12 months of 30 days each. The last month has 5 days in a common year and 6 days during leap year. So, like in the Julian calendar, a leap year in the Ethiopian calendar happens every 4 years without exception.

A fun Leap year tradition — It's acceptable for a woman to propose to a man on Feb. 29. The custom has been attributed to St. Bridget, who is said to have complained to St. Patrick about women having to wait for men to propose marriage. Patrick supposedly gave women one day to propose. There is a movie starring Amy Adams and Matthew Goode from 2010 called "Leap Year." It's about a woman who travels to Ireland to ask her boyfriend to accept her wedding proposal on leap day, when tradition says that men cannot refuse a woman's marriage proposal.

People born on leap day are often called "leaplings" or "leapers." Most of them celebrate their birthday on Feb. 28 or March 1 on non-leap years. The twin cities of Anthony, TX and Anthony, NM are the self-proclaimed Leap Year Capitals of the World. They hold a four-day leap year festival each leap year that includes a huge birthday party for all leap year babies. There's even a leap year club called The Honor Society of Leap Year Babies. It's a club for people born on February 29th. More than 10,000 people worldwide are members.

Some famous leapers are Bryce Paup – NFL linebacker of the Green Bay Packers and Buffalo Bills, Antonio Sabato Jr – actor who played Jagger Cates in General Hospital, Chris Devine – Pennsylvania diver in the 1996, Fabien Bownes – an NFL wide receiver for the Chicago Bears, Dave Williams – American singer for Drowning Pool (d. 2002), Ja Rule – American rapper and actor from NYC, Terrence Long – American baseball player.

George Armstrong Custer fought the Battle of the Little Bighorn on a leap year in 1876. Some others are the Titanic sank in 1912, Benjamin Franklin proved that lightning is electricity in 1752 and gold was discovered in California in 1848.



Football Q & A – Not Commonly Known Pro Football Facts



Where did the name football come from? - Although the accepted source of the word football, or "foot ball," originated in reference to the action of a foot kicking a ball, this may be false. An alternative explanation has it that the word originally referred to a variety of games in medieval Europe, which were played on foot.

Who is the highest paid football player in the NFL? - As of January 2018, just a couple of months after Carr signed his record-breaking contract, Lions quarterback Matthew Stafford made history with a five-year, \$135 million deal that earned him the top spot on the list of highest-paid NFL players. He gets paid \$27 million annually – the NFL's highest-ever salary.

What is the average height and weight of an NFL Football player? - NFL players are big in terms of both height and weight, with the average player height running 6 feet 4 inches. Players can be as tall as 6 feet 8 inches and as short as 6 feet. It's unlikely for an NFL player to weigh less than 250 pounds. The average defensive tackle in 2013 weight in at about 305 pounds.

What is the average salary of an NFL football player? – The average salary of an NFL player is \$2.1 million, according to Forbes, but Brady's salary still ranks far below some of his peers.

Who is the oldest active NFL football player? – It's not Tom Brady, quarterback of the New England Patriots. Tom comes in at number four at age 41 (born August 3, 1977). Tom has been active in the NFL for 19 years (2000-present).

Adam Vinatieri, placekicker for the Indianapolis Colts, is currently the oldest active player in the NFL at 46 years old (born December 28, 1972). Adam has been active in the NFL for 23 years (1996 – present).

Where can you find the official rules and regulations of Pro Football? - Many websites dedicated to the NFL have the official rules and regulations of Pro Football that can be downloaded or viewed for free. There are also books that can be purchased locally with the official rules and regulations.
