READ & WIN PRIZES!

All ages earn Prizes and Badges by reading and completing activities on our reading tracker—**BEANSTACK**. Available online or via the Beanstack app. Beanstack manages your online log and awards you prizes!

New to SummerBASH?

We are happy to help! Stop by or give us a call.

RETURNING READER?

No need to create a new account. Use your login from last summer. Can't remember your username/password? Beanstack has prompts to help you recover them. Need further assistance? Contact the library at 913-837-2217. *Creating a second account may delay the prize pick-up process.*

Beanstack Account Holders:

Go to your account and add the SummerBASH program appropriate for your age group to your Beanstack account.

NEW to Beanstack:

Download the BEANSTACK TRACKER app to your phone/device or Create a Beanstack account online at LOUISBURGLIBRARY.BEANSTACK.ORG

Individual Account:

Click "register an individual or family" then "I'm registering myself." Submit your information and start logging!

Family Account:


Click "register an individual or family" then "I'm an adult registering a child." Fill in adult account creator information, then continue to add reader(s) information as needed. Once an adult is logged in, they have access to all members.

Only one email address per account can be used, this includes family or individual accounts.

GUIDE

KIDS: (Babies - going into 5th grade)

Badges are earned for every hour that you read or someone reads to you. These badges are awarded in your SummerBASH online reading tracker, Beanstack.

Kids badges and prizes can only be earned when LOGGING MINUTES

YOUNG ADULTS: (going into 6-12 grades)

Earn points for raffle tickets and badge prizes.

You will receive a badge prize at 400 points, 2,000 points, 4,000 points, 10,000 points, and 20,000 points. Electronic raffle tickets for Big Prizes will be available for every 400 points (up to 40,000 pts).

1 Book = 400 points; 1 Minute = 1 point

ADULTS: (Ages 17 and up)

Earn points for badge prizes and raffle tickets for big raffle prizes. You will receive a badge prize at 2,000 points, 4,000 points, 10,000 points, and 20,000 points. Electronic raffle tickets for Big Prizes will be available for every 400 points (up to 40,000 pts).

1 Book = 400 points; 1 Minute = 1 point

Activities in Beanstack will also give you points that you may use for raffle tickets.

Adults, we encourage you to read to your children or grandchildren and count the minutes in Beanstack. Please feel free to count the minutes you spend reading a magazine or for work.

Where do I find out if an event location or time has been changed?

Visit louisburglibrary.org or Louisburg Library's Facebook page for current location and inclement weather information.

What happens if I am not feeling well and want to visit the library?

Be safe. If you are feeling sick, stay home. It's not personal.

What happens if I need to cancel an event registration?

There are a couple of easy ways to cancel. Cancel registrations in the library's web calendar (Communico), reference your confirmation email, or call us at 913-837-2217.

How much does an event cost?

Not all events have a fee. Some do. All events that have a fee, require registration.

What if the event registration is full?




