Art on a Postcard (AOAP) is very proud to be working with the charity **War Child UK** and raising money for the outstanding work that they do.

In 2014 Art on a Postcard was intended to be a one-off secret postcard auction, it went so well that it has gradually spawned a small industry of regular auctions, art prints, postcards and greetings cards. 2023 will see AOAP launch **The AOP Gallery** whose inaugural show will be with **Andrew Torr** in partnership with **Liminal Gallery** in Margate.

This auction has been a year in the making and features artists of such calibre it is like a mini Frieze.

AOAP Founder **Gemma Peppé** was keen to support War Child as her mother is effectively a war child. Like many of her generation she was affected by the Second World War. "My mother was arrested in 1939 along with her mother in Lviv (formerly Lvov in Poland) when she was nine months old. They spent four years in a camp in Siberia before being released and eventually ending up in the UK, having been exiled from their native Poland. These difficult beginnings leave their mark on the adults that these children become, what War Child does to ease their passage is essential and I'm proud to support them."

HOW TO BID WITH THE AUCTION COLLECTIVE

STEP 1: REGISTER FOR THE AUCTION

Visit our auction page and register for the auction. You will need to have an account with The Auction Collective to register for the auction. **Click here to register.**

STEP 2: BEGIN BIDDING

Once bidding opens you will be able to place your 'Maximum bid'. The platform will automatically bid for you against other bidders in bidding increments. You will be notified if you have been outbid and will be given a chance to counter. Any bids placed last minute of the auction extend the entire auction by two minutes so that everyone has the chance to bid again. STEP 3: WIN YOUR BID!

The bidder with the highest bid when the countdown times out will win the piece. The winning bidder will receive an email notifying them of their success and will be provided further instructions on payment from the AoaP team.
