KUANG SI WATERFALLS

MAGICAL WATERFALLS & LUSH JUNGLE: DISCOVER THE UNTouched NATURE OF LAOS

Kuang Si waterfalls are the biggest in the Luang Prabang area with three tiers leading to a 50-metre drop into spectacular azure pools before flowing downstream. Walk through the jungle, take a dip in dazzlingly blue waters, visit the bear sanctuary and relax within this incredible nature.

Tip: The pools make great swimming holes and are very popular to both tourists and locals. You can change clothes and jump into your swimming gear at the wooden huts located close to the entrance.

• ITINERARY •

- Set off from the hotel either early morning or afternoon and head towards the waterfall (roughly a 50-min drive by minivan).

Duration: 1/2 day.

KHOPFA MEKONG CRUISE

SUNSET CRUISE ON THE MAJESTIC MEKONG RIVER

Enjoy the beauty of the Mekong and relax as the boat takes you along stunning sunset scenery in the Luang Prabang areas.

The Khopfa boat is specially designed to give you 360° views of the scenery from its terraces, so that you can enjoy every minute of your Sunset Cruise.

While on board, you will be served you a refreshing welcome drink and snacks so that you start the Sunset Cruise serenely. The boat sails for 2 hours, and the Sunset Cruise starts between 4.15pm and 5.30pm depending on the season and the sunset time.

Guests need to arrive at the pier 20 min prior to departure.

Sunset Cruise duration: 2 hours.



AN INTIMATE NON-RIDING EXPERIENCE
FOCUSED ON EDUCATION AND ELEPHANT WELFARE

I/2 DAY - THERAPEUTIC TREK

You will trek through the jungle alongside two adult elephants, surrounded by jungle streams and luscious rice fields as you trek (2.5km round trip). Once your trek is completed, a delicious lunch will follow at the MandalaO property.


• ITINERARY •

- **8:30am or 9:15am.** Set off from Luang Prabang. Your tour guide will pick you up from the Sanctuary Luang Prabang Hotel and drive you to the Conservation Center.
- **Arrive at MandalaO.** Get an in-depth introduction into elephant behavior and communication.
- **Meet the Elephants.** Cross the river for a first introduction to the elephants.
- **Begin Trek.** Pass beautiful Lao gardens before exploring the jungle.
(The trek is 2.5 Km and takes about 1.5 Hr it is flat and shaded most of the way)
- **Say Goodbyes.** After some final treats for the elephants, begin the trek back to MandalaO.
- **Lunch.** Enjoy traditional Lao cuisine made primarily from our own organic produce.
- **Around 1.30pm or 1.45pm** Head back towards.

MANDALAO ELEPHANT CONSERVATION

I DAY INSIDE THE HEARTS OF ELEPHANTS

This highly personalized full-day expedition begins with the Therapeutic Trek described previously followed by another half-day of incredible experiences.

The Inside the Hearts of Elephants tour ensures you to deeply connect and interact with your own special elephant. After you enjoy a fresh, traditional Lao lunch in the jungle, you will start off on a walk to a seldom-seen and hidden gem of a waterfall. You will end this full and deeply satisfying day by escorting your elephant companions to their feeding grounds before honoring them with your friendship and bidding them farewell.

• ITINERARY •

- **12:00.** Split off from Therapeutic Trek and continue walking up the 5.5km trail. The trek is flat and goes at a slow pace.
- **Lunch.** A traditional Lao lunch will be served in banana leaves in the jungle.
- **Visit of Tad Kuang Song Waterfall.** Take a cool refreshing dip in this hidden treasure.
- **Visit of Ban Hua Tad khmu Village.** Walk through the village and see local life.
- **Mahout Demonstration.** Watch and learn as the mahouts demonstrate how they communicate with their elephants. Use what you have learnt to try the same.
- **Walk back to feeding grounds.** Guests leave the elephants and mahouts at the night enclosure and begin the trek back to MandaLao with their guide. Enjoy a drink and snack as you recollect on the day.
- **Around 4pm or 4:45pm** head back towards the hotel.

On this tour, discover the "Rice Experience": situated in an idyllic countryside setting surrounded by mountains in the middle of ancient rice terraces, discover how rice is grown on the farm and experience the life of a traditional rice farmer.



SKETCH WALK LUANG PRABANG

For sketchers of all levels, this relaxed workshop offers guidance tailored to your needs and is a great way to experience and record what you see in this beautiful town.

Who is Paul Bloxham: Paul has 40 years of experience working in illustration and graphic design and has exhibited in galleries in London and in Laos. He has a postgraduate art and design teaching qualification and experience lecturing in the UK. He has lived in Laos since 1997.

DAYTIME COOKING CLASS (JOIN-IN)

- Set off from Tamarind Restaurant at approximately 8:45 am to the cooking class venue.
- Visit the major food market: discover the main ingredients used in Lao authentic recipes before heading to the 'Tamarind Gardens' to cook:
 - ✓ Varieties of Jeow: the fundamental Lao spicy dipping sauces
 - ✓ Mok Pa, a popular dish of herbed fish steamed in banana leaves
 - ✓ Tamarind's speciality: lemongrass stuffed with chicken & herbs
 - ✓ Laap, a national favorite of herbs with minced meat, fish or tofu & mushrooms
 - ✓ Dessert: a surprise!
- Of course you'll learn the art of making the perfect sticky rice and its eating etiquette.

The lesson ends by a degustation of the homemade dishes.

BAMBOO EXPERIENCE

1/2 DAY BAMBOO WEAVING & COOKING CLASS

(Morning class: 8.30am-1.00pm or Evening class: 4.00-8.00pm, open every day)

You will be transferred to the Bamboo Experience's venue where you will have an interactive cooking class and 'bamboo weaving' exercise to learn about the importance of the ubiquitous bamboo plant to Lao culture.

Your Experience

- 'The Bamboo Experience', a rustic pavilion modeled on a traditional Lao house, perched in a picturesque setting next to rice fields.
- An introduction to the importance of bamboo to Lao culture and to the use of bamboo in a diverse range of household items found in rural Lao dwellings.
- A relaxing bamboo weaving activity, where you'll weave a souvenir mat made from strips of the bamboo plant, using a technique which has been

practised for centuries.

- A fun, interactive cooking class, using the bamboo plant as a key ingredient; make dishes such as bamboo shoot soup, bamboo shoot steamed in banana leaf, and bamboo shoot dip and more.
- A delicious meal (made by you), and photo opportunities of semi-rural Laos, from the relaxing pavilion terrace.

DISCOVER LAOS THROUGH TEXTILES

Set in lush tropical gardens and located on the banks of the Mekong, the Living Crafts Center is the perfect place to learn more about the fascinating world of Lao textiles and handicrafts. The Centre brings the concept of "East Meets West" alive.

Alongside our Master Weavers and experienced teachers, learn more about the textiles and traditional crafts of Laos. Try your hand at silk weaving, natural dyeing, batik drawing and bamboo weaving and bring home a one-of-a-kind souvenir

NATURAL DYEING CLASS

Get your hands dirty! Experience the colours of Laos during this introduction to natural dyeing and learn how the Lao have been using plants and other ingredients from nature for generations to colour textiles.

Gather plants and bark from our garden, and crush roots, seeds & leaves whilst following traditional dye recipes. Leave with your own naturally-dyed set of napkins, t-shirt or scarf.

SILK WEAVING CLASS

How would you like to bring back home your very own silk scarf that you wove yourself? Alongside a master weaver and a guide — for translation — learn the art of silk weaving.

Spend the day in a lovely riverside sala and learn how weave your own textile on a traditional floor loom from start to finish.

BAN CHAN POTTERY VILLAGE

A HIDDEN GEM

The town of Vang Vieng is most famous for its lagons, its caves and the splendid karst landscapes that surround it, reminiscent of a land-based Halong Bay.

The Nam Ngum Lake has a rich history and is actually a large artificial lake dating back to the early 1970s when the first hydroelectric dam was built in Laos on the Nam Ngum River.

The Sanctuary Nam Ngum Resort is a little piece of paradise still unknown to travelers, nestled in the middle of nature. It offers a superb environment for non-motorized activities (swimming pool, pedal boats, kayaks, bicycles...) and allows an immersion with the possible meeting of locals including a community of fishermen installed on its banks. A space dedicated to nature that calls for relaxation





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
