UNIRAZAK Main Campus is a 5-minute walk from The Intermark Exit, Ampang Park LRT station and the MRT Putrajaya Line Phase 2 for Ampang. The station is served by the Kelana Jaya LRT Line. Attending classes at the main campus will be highly convenient now with MRT Putrajaya Line Phase 2. The station is just next to the main campus, whilst getting to the city campus requires transits to other bus and/or light rail lines.
