



The event started in 2021 with only 27 backcountry skiers before growing to 200 in its second year and 350 in its third. This year over 1500 are expected as the Boot Tan Festival is gearing up for its fourth year of inviting women to hit the slopes fully nude for an after-hours ski run at Sunlight Mountain Resort in Glenwood Springs. Founder Jenny Verrochi, said the event started "unintentionally to create a safe place for female skiers that would allow women to be free in a private place." This year, she has opened up the festival to femme-presenting nonbinary individuals as well.

Verrochi also said that "her first and foremost priority is to protect the women." When asked if she feared men might try to sneak in under the disguise of nonbinary she said "We never had an issue with men or men-identifying." As for women who may be weary, they don't have to take their clothes, Jenny who also participates in the event continued to say "they won't want to by the end of the event. There's not a single person with clothes on by the end of the day," she revealed.

She described the experience as "collective joy" and said most of the women feel free to strip to their birthday suits because they're among like-minded people and no prying eyes are around. The women will be clothed going up the ski lift and fully dressed before re-entering Sunlight Mountain Resort's facilities. In addition, there will be only a female staff on the mountain when the women and femmes zip down, and male employees will have their phones taken away during the event for security reasons.

The resort will be open to everyone, including men during the day, but after its 3pm closing time, only those with a Boot Tan Festival ticket will be allowed to stay and shred. During the day, women-owned vendors will be spotlighted in a merchant village and festivities include a comedy show, live music and a tailgate party. Every year, Verrochi hopes the women find a "newfound love for their bodies" and walk away with "friendships" and new experiences. www.BootTanFest.com


# In CONCERT

### **EMERSON, LAKE & PALMER**

The trio of Emerson, Lake, and Palmer, formed in 1970. The group performed a combination of classical music, jazz, and symphony. All sounds rolled into the classic rock category.



The showmanship of Emerson and his keyboard talents were first observed as he played multiple keyboards, as many as 6 keyboards at once. Their first self titled LP was released in 1970 on Atlantic Records (U.S.), followed by Tarkus, back in 1971.

Throughout the 70s, other noteworthy albums such as Trilogy and Brain Salad Surgery all climbed the charts, though Works Vol.1 and Works Vol.2 (*late 70s*), allowed each member to showcase their talent.


It wasn't until the late 70s when the band broke up, however, with the passing of Emerson and Lake, after 2010. Palmer resurfaced with a tribute to his fellow members, and is now touring. Sole surviving member Carl Palmer, in association with the legacy estate of his bandmates Keith Emerson & Greg Lake, then decided to announce "The Return Of Emerson, Lake, and Palmer 2023 Summer Tour".

The tour reunites the ELP original bands live on stage through modern technology. The voice and instrumentation of Greg Lake and the unmistakable keyboard mastery of Keith Emerson is mixed with Palmer's on-stage live drumming to magically reunite ELP once again.

Emerson and Lake passed away nine months apart in 2016, leaving Palmer to carry on the band's enormous musical legacy. Current line-up includes Paul Bielatowicz (quitarist),

and Simon Fitzpatrick (bass/stick player), performing instrumental versions of ELP songs as Carl Palmer's ELP Legacy.

What can be said about the talented Keith Emerson who can play 6 keyboards at once, and the great vocals of Greg Lake who went on to become part of ASIA.



This was an evening of sitting back and enjoying the music, so few pics and vids were taken, but listening to "Lucky Man" and "Fanfare" were the 2 tracks that brought back great memories.



Since boiMAGazine has reached milestone 24, here's the story behind the name boi.

The term "boi" has undergone a fascinating evolution in recent years, transitioning from a slang term within LGBTQ+ communities to a broader expression embraced by individuals across the gender spectrum. While its roots lie in the gay male and butch communities, where it often denoted masculinity, its meaning has blossomed to encompass a wider range of identities and expressions.

For some people assigned female at birth, "boi" offers a way to reclaim and redefine masculinity outside of the confines of the "man" box. It' can be an embracement of masculine aesthetics and traits, or simply a comfortable way to identify with their gender experience. Lesbians who are neither butch nor femme are often called androgynous. Some say that the term boi is typically used by younger LGBT women.

By 2003, the dominant definition on Urban Dictionary was a young butch lesbian, and so it remained until 2016, where now it's been updated to include intersex, trans, genderqueer, nonbinary and those who identify as cis persons or trans men, and there's possibly more inclusions to come.

Beyond the binary, "boi" resonates with non-binary individuals who navigate a spectrum of gender expression. It can represent a rejection of the gender assigned at birth, a way to express a fluid or non-conforming gender identity, or simply a comfortable label that avoids the rigidity of traditional gender categories, since it 's neither all male or female by definition.

In other words, it's fluid and it dependents on how it's intended or what context it's used in. The beauty of "boi" lies in its fluidity and defiance of categorization. It's not a fixed label, but rather a term that individuals can use and define for themselves. It can be a statement of personal power, a way to reclaim agency over one's gender expression, and a celebration of individuality.

However, it's important to remember that the term "boi" can be male, female or neither, due the intention of use by the user. Not everyone assigned female at birth or non-binary individuals will resonate with the term, and to be mindful that it's not a blanket description or appropriation.

Just like a qubit can exist in a state of 0 and 1 simultaneously, the term "boi" can embody both masculine and feminine (or neither) qualities at the same time. This aligns with the concept of nonbinary gender identities that exist outside the binary spectrum.

Ultimately, the evolving usage of "boi" reflects a growing understanding and acceptance of diverse gender identities and expressions. It's a term that celebrates individuality, challenges binary norms, and offers a powerful tool for self-reclamation and self-expression. As we move towards a more inclusive and understanding world, "boi" serves as a reminder that gender is not a fixed box, but a kaleidoscope of possibilities.

As if that's not enough to absorb, several years ago we gave boi and acronym, which stands for "Bet On It." If you're thinking why does B.O.I. stand for Bet On It, well that's a loaded question! The short answer is, years ago, we built a prototype for a boiApp to be released sometime in the future, when funds became available to make the App come to fruition. Since the idea is proprietary, it's been in the top-secret vault, so the only thing I can reveal is that it's similar to casino app, but this has never been done before. It's free to play the user is the winner. I'm not talking about winning virtual coins, or baiting the user to buy coins, they actually win! The brilliance behind the creative design is there's gratification to using the App. It doesn't use the user, it's fun to play and win. Hopefully some day soon I can reveal more, so you can play it to unleash its amazing attributes. But until then, it must remain in the vault

### Dear Char,

"My family doesn't approve of my partner. How can I navigate this tension without compromising my values or my relationship?"

### Dear Painful in Plainfield,

This is such a painful issue! Let's start with your family. If you have a mostly (no relationships are perfect) healthy relationship with the family members who are part of the conflict, and you think the talk can be free of yelling and abusive communication, find out why your partner is not liked. Is there a real reason or past history that is driving the objections to your chosen relationship? When you talk, be honest about your feelings. Make sure they understanding the stress and pain it creates for you and your partner.

This will not be an easy conversation to have. It is going to be important not to let an issue like this fester. Get to working it out or, at least talking about it right away. Try getting the points of discussion solid in your mind before you chat with your family. Even writing down what you want to say may help. Keep respect a priority and do your best to keep emotions in check. Your best active listening skills will be needed. Don't skirt around the issue, talk to them and ask key questions like:

- It seems you have an issue with [name].Is this true?
- Can you tell me why you don't like/respect/want me associated with [name]?

If they are sharing things you have not recognized, pay attention. Hear them! Are they telling you that you are not safe? Are they feeling isolated because this person is controlling you and your time? Are you tolerating abusive language or poor treatment because you are in a new relationship? Is your family just worried about you? Might they be right?

Try to see their concerns through their eyes and listen! Your family may be picking up on things you are dismissing because you are in love or because you don't know how to leave someone without hurting.

Do you have a friend who is a good sounding board? If you do, tell them what your family is saying and be willing to hear if your friend feels the same. If they agree with your family, do you know what you will do? This is going to require you to pull from strength you didn't know you have. If everyone agrees that this person is not for you, you will really have some thinking to do.

If the issues relate to safety, you can call your local domestic violence programs to hear warning signs for yourself. This will give you more to consider, and may save you from danger in the future.

Keep your partner in the loop! They're not in a vacuum and they know that there's negative feelings about them and your relationship. Make sure you're sharing what and when you're beginning conversations with your family. Are their family members feeling the same way about you? It's something to consider. Your conversations as a couple should explore all of this.

Now, here's the hard part. If your family doesn't "like" your partner for reasons that are prejudicial in nature, that may not be so reparable. These kinds of issues: race, religious practices, political views, sexual orientation or work preferences, make it tough because people don't change their minds easily on these issues. This could clearly be a "we'll agree to disagree" situation and you may have to tell them that your relationship will continue, sadly and respectfully, without their approval. If there are times where your partner can naturally be included in family events to create some comfort between the two, then try giving it a shot.

Be an advocate for your partner. Consider their best qualities and be ready to share the best of who they are with your family. Perhaps, they are missing some key assets.

As you can see, there are overall goals here. The goal is to make sure, first and foremost, that you are in a healthy relationship. Secondly, the goal is to make sure that you are able to manage relationships with family and with your partner, and be happy.
