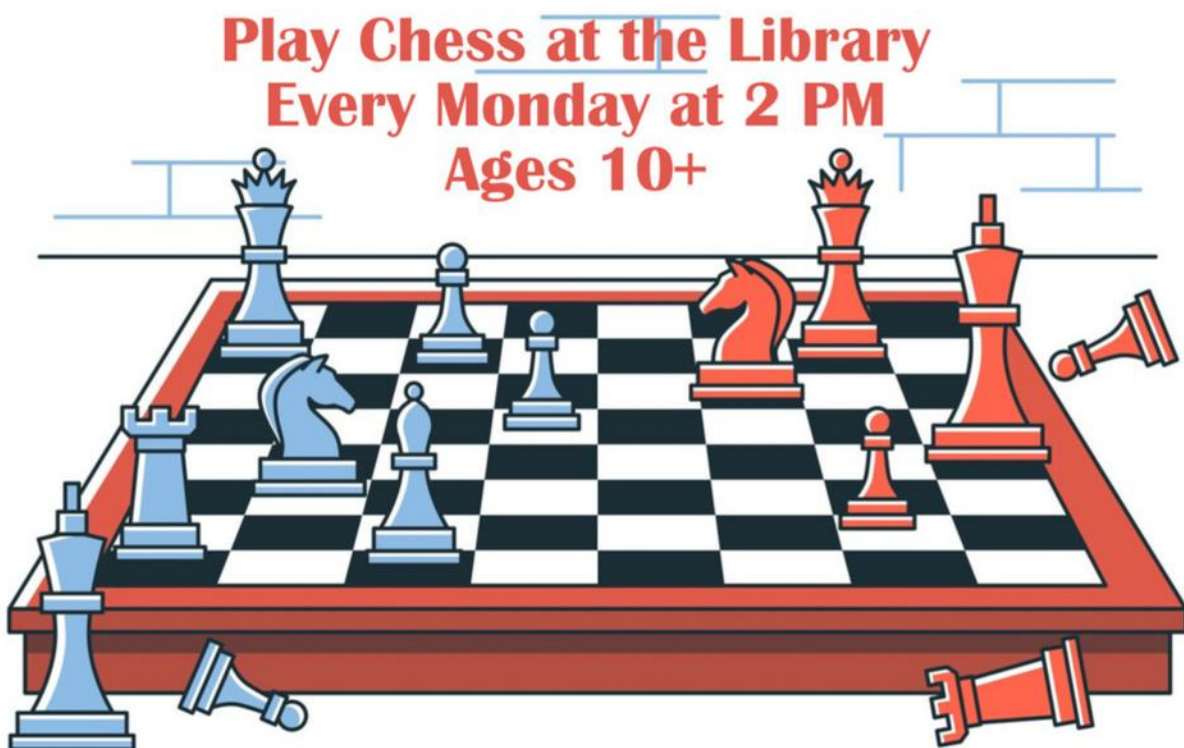

# DEL MASSEY PARK

THE LAND ON WHICH THIS PARK IS SITUATED WAS WILLED TO THE CITY OF MARSHFIELD BY DEL MASSEY "IT BEING MY DESIRE THAT THEY USE THE SAME FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CHILDREN OF THE COMMUNITY, EITHER AS A PARK, OR FOR ANY EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES AS THEY SHALL DEEM THE TRACT BEST SUITED FOR." DEL WAS BORN IN MARSHFIELD, PROBABLY IN THE YEAR 1891. HE DIED ON NOVEMBER 6, 1958. HIS WIFE, ROSETTA MOSBY, PREDECEASED HIM BY A FEW MONTHS. DEL AT THE TIME OF HIS DEATH WAS THE LAST SURVIVING BLACK IN THE COUNTY. THE BLACK COMMUNITY IN MARSHFIELD NUMBERED OVER 100 IN THE EARLY PART OF THE 20<sup>TH</sup> CENTURY.

HIS FUNERAL WAS ONE OF THE LARGEST IN MARSHFIELD HISTORY. THE CHILDREN--AND TOWNFOLK--LOVED AND RESPECTED HIM. HE LOVED THEM, ESPECIALLY THE CHILDREN.

DEL WORKED FOR MANY PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNITY--HE BROUGHT AND TRAINED THEIR PUPS, BROKE THEIR HORSES, AND SPUN FASCINATING YARNS FOR THE YOUNG.

HE HAD NO FORMAL EDUCATION AND COULD NEITHER READ NOR WRITE, EXCEPT FOR HIS NAME. HIS KNOWLEDGE OF PERSONS AND ANIMALS, HOWEVER, FAR EXCEEDED THE MORE EDUCATED. AND HE HAD A FRIENDLY COMMUNION WITH WHAT HE CALLED "THE OLD MAN UP THERE."
