A massive re-imagining of Katherine Rose Memorial Park that began in early 2024 is moving at lightning speed, considering just how much dirt has to move to bring Mansfield a stunning, adaptive and inclusive destination playground nearly triple the size of the existing space, including new restrooms and lots of really exciting features, like a giant squirrel play sculpture that's the first of its kind in the whole world!

All of those amenities are included in Phase 1, which should be open by late Fall/early Winter 2025.

Phase 2, in the design process now, will add tennis, pickleball, volleyball and basketball courts, outdoor fitness amenities, restrooms and a pavilion to the Hardy Allmon soccer fields across the street, creating even more welcoming spaces for all ages to play.

Once plans are complete, that phase will begin construction and should be open by Summer 2026.



#### mans best field dog park

Your favorite furry friend will have new ways to play soon, as Phase 2 of the dog park will begin construction this summer, adding a pond for water play, pavilion, paddock lighting, and trail connection to the future linear trail expansion, also in the works.

The project is expect to be completed in Fall 2025.

#### walnut creek linear trail

Work continues on the expansion of Mansfield's favorite park amenity, the Walnut Creek Linear Trail. Phase 3, connecting Cannon/Carlin Roads to Oliver Nature Park, began construction this spring.

The section will complete/improve sidewalks along Cannon and Matlock Roads, as well as add a safe pedestrian crossing under Matlock at the Walnut Creek bridge. Construction should be complete in Winter 2025.



#### julian feild park

Construction began in January 2025 to add restrooms, a pavilion, a reflection pond, a veterans memorial, and an event plaza with amphitheater seating at Mansfield's first park, which is now closed until work is completed this Winter.

#### james mcknight park west

Design work continues at James McKnight Park West, funded in large part thanks to a \$750,000 grant from Texas Parks and Wildlife.

The project includes a playground, pavilion, looped walking trail with exercise equipment, and the City's first disc golf course, and should be complete and open for play in Summer 2026.



#### mcclendon park east

McClendon Park East is getting a long-overdue new playground, with rubber, poured-in-place surfacing and swings in an expanded footprint near the existing pavilion and trees. The new playground should be ready for play by Fall 2025.

Phase 2 of the project will add a connection to McClendon Park West through the woods. The soft-surface trail will include boardwalks and nature overlooks for a unique new way to explore. Design work on Phase 2 is ongoing, and construction should be complete by Spring 2026.

#### playground shade & upgrades

What do you want? Shade! When do you want it? As soon as possible! This year, playground upgrades, including shade, equipment refresh, and surfacing repairs, are a high priority across Mansfield.

New and/or full replacement structures will have shade structures if not located in an area with natural shade, which is our first priority. Shades and/or canopies are also in the works for those playgrounds still in great condition not scheduled for replacement in the near future, as possible based on the location and budget.

This year, shade is in the works at Mills, Bell, Birdsong, and Gertie Barrett Parks. Other upgrades include outdoor exercise stations at Killian Park and Watson Branch Park.

#### oliver nature park tree house

The tree house overlook at Oliver Nature Park will be closed briefly this summer for necessary structural repairs, replacing both the wood planks and portions of the steel frame. The modifications will improve safety and increase the lifespan of the amenity, which has been a favorite feature at the park since opening in 2014.

#### parks master plan update

All of the projects underway are based on goals and priorities established in the 2020 Master Plan. The plan uses inventory assessments, benchmark analysis, and community feedback to outline the highest needs and demands for parks, amenities and programs over the next ten years. Now almost five years in, the department is conducting a detailed review of the plan to assess progress, confirm priorities, and identify any key changes in inventory, population or demand. 



Tis the season for blooms and wings across our parks, but especially at Elmer W. Oliver Nature Park! This May, the park will once again be affutter with excitement at the annual Monarch Festival. The free event, sponsored by Methodist Mansfield Medical Center, celebrates pollinators and their impact on the environment, and is timed to align with seasonal migration patterns.

The 2025 festival will again include arts and crafts, interactive educational games, story time with Mansfield Public Library, and, by popular demand, an immersive tent where guests can walk among live butterflies. Nature Education Supervisor Tiffany Chrzanowski says the festival is not just a fun activity, but an integral part of the department's larger environmental efforts. "Mansfield has participated in the statewide Mayor's Monarch Challenge since 2016, a program designed to support and sustain these pollinators."

In addition to the festival, Mansfield maintains three butterfly gardens and prioritizes planting milkweed and pollinator-friendly native nectar plants whenever possible to help the insects grow and thrive.

"Butterflies are more than pretty additions to our garden," said Chrzanowski. "They are a crucial part of our environment's life cycle and every little bit we can do makes a difference!"

The Oliver Nature Park Monarch Festival is Saturday, May 10, from 9 a.m. to Noon. More information and free registration can be found at bit.ly/2025MonarchFest.

#### **MAC MEMBERSHIP FAQ**

- Each member of the family 2Y+ must have their own MAC card to participate in programs where membership is required.
- MAC cards must be scanned at the front desk on each visit.
- Waiver must be signed with each membership purchase or renewal.
- Membership is good for 12 months from the date of purchase.
- Proof of residency is required (i.e. drivers license.) Membership is open to anyone regardless of residency; rates are based on Mansfield residency.
- Family membership includes up to six family members who live at the same address. Additional family members are \$5 each.
- See front desk for information about scholarships.
- MAC membership includes access to the gymnasium for open court basketball, volleyball or pickleball.
- See Gym Schedule online at bit.ly/gymscheduleMAC.

#### **MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS**

- MAC membership is required for Kids Zone and any recreation programs held at the Mansfield Activities Center.
- MAC membership is required for participation in Senior Lifestyles.
- MAC membership is not required for Nature Education programs.
- MAC membership is not required for rentals.
- Membership is not required for special events but members may be eligible for special discounts.

#### **RESTRICTIONS**

- Parent or legal guardian must be present to sign for a waiver for children 17Y or younger.
- Organized practices or training sessions are not allowed during open gym.
- Children under 8Y must be accompanied by a guardian at all times.
- Children 12Y and under must have a guardian at the MAC after 6 p.m.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

- Mansfield Parks and Recreation may cancel, postpone or combine courses, or change instructors as deemed necessary.
- Classes which do not meet minimum requirements two business days prior to the start date may be canceled.
- Weather-dependent programs will have a hold/cancel decision made at least 1 hour prior to the start time.
- The department will make every effort to reschedule any canceled programs. If a make-up date is unavailable, a full or pro-rated refund will be processed.
- Refunds must be processed to the same payment method used at registration. Cash/check payments will be issued via check within 30 days; credit card refunds will post based on provider.
- Customers may withdraw from a program at any time. Refund requests must be made in writing; refund due based on timing.

#### **RENTAL POLICIES**

- Fields are rented for 1-4 hours with a max of 2 dates booked.

- Renting party must remain on site for the duration of the rental.
- All fees due at the time of booking, including rental fees and any applicable deposits.
- MAC rentals have a 1-hour minimum during operating hours;
   3-hour minimum during non-operating hours.
- Pavilions are rented in half-day (7 am-1 pm or 3-9 pm) or full-day blocks (7 am-9 pm).
- Terms and rates subject to change; for the most current pricing and full policies, visit mansfieldparks.com.
