

The wisdom of God is His divine insight on any given matter. This wisdom includes strategy, plans, and a deep revelation of purpose. God has been preparing His true church to receive this wisdom through many trials and testing. He has been refining our inner character so that we may be worthy to carry the deep insights of Heaven. We have been tested on {if} and {how well} we will carry our cross.

If we carry our cross, then we are His {true} disciples. This qualifies us for the secrets of Heaven:

Humility and Holiness (Part 12)

Let's go back to Luke 18:11 from last week, "Oh God. I thank Thee that I am not as other men."; we have seen how it is that men like to think of themselves as being better then other men, we have a hard time trying to say that others are better than ourselves and that is what gets us in trouble.

Ephesians 3:8 tells us that we need to count themselves as "less than the least of all saints." Meaning that we recognize that we are nothing and that God is everything, this is the only way that we can become a servant of all.

1st Corinthians 13:4-5 tells us, "Love vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, seeketh not her own".

Ask yourself why people are always trying to get people to recognize them, to put them in a place of honor or power. But it is the power of perfect love that will cause you to forget about yourself; and will find its blessedness in blessing others- in bearing and honoring them, however feeble they may be.

When Christ, the meek and lowly lamb of God is truly formed within you, then the spirit of His love is shed abroad in your heart. When God has entered in in His power and reveals Himself as all, this is when man becomes nothing. And when man sees himself as nothing before God, he cannot be anything but humble towards his fellow men.

The presence of God becomes not a thing of times and seasons, but the cover under which the soul always dwells. Our humility before Him is the only power that can enable us to always be humble with our fellow men.

We need to take warning though, that there is no pride so dangerous or subtle, as the pride of holiness. There is a hidden habit of the soul which cannot help but to see how far it is advanced before others. This happens because we lack humility. It may not be in words, but it may be a posture, a way of talking to others that says, "I am better than you". It reveals itself, not only in words or thoughts, but also in tone.

If you have the gift of spiritual discernment, you cannot help but recognize the power of self. Even people who are of the world will be able to recognize it. The world points to it as the proof that the profession of being a Christian does not bear any especially heavenly fruits. At times we can be hard pressed to recognize the fruits of the Spirit in the lives of our brothers and sisters. That Christians are no different than anyone else.

We need to flee to Jesus, to hide ourselves in Him until we are clothed with His humility. That alone is our holiness. That alone will show the world who Jesus is through us.

The Meaning of Psalm 150 Reverend Astrid Sherriff

1 Hallelujah! Praise God in His sanctuary, praise Him in His mighty expanse of heaven. 2 Praise him for his might, praise him for his great greatness.3 Praise him with the sound of a trumpet, praise him with the lyre and the harp.4 Praise him with tambourines and dances, praise him with strings and flutes.5 Praise him with sonorous cymbals, praise him with resounding cymbals.6 Let everything that breathes praise the LORD!

The meaning of Psalm 150 in the bible depicts a psalm of worship to God by Da Hallelu shares a root with Hallel, the prayer that is recited on many feast days and was imported.

When we look at this psalm, we can see that the psalm refers to the praise that took place in the temple. Nonetheless, this is a place where heaven and earth meet. The third option would be to translate the verse as "Praise God (who is) in his [heavenly] sanctuary." into English in the form of Hallelujah. It means "praise," but in the context of this psalm, it is an imperative, used as instruction for all Israel. The text is more than asking or encouraging, it is imploring the people of Israel: "Praise God!" Unlimited praise to the God who is unlimited in His greatness. (1) Everywhere, praise Jehovah.

Praise God in his sanctuary; Praise him in the magnificence of his firmament. to. Praise God: This last of the five final psalms shares the same opening and ending line as the previous four. Yahweh is praised and His people are encouraged and exhorted to praise Him. There are no crises or enemies in sight; This is pure praise. Praise God in His sanctuary: God's sanctuary is the most appropriate place for His praise. It is a place set apart for His honor and implies a special acknowledgment of His presence. If Yahweh is to be praised anywhere, it must be in His sanctuary.

In light of the New Covenant, we realize that God's sanctuary is not fixed to a particular building in Jerusalem. Jesus serves His people in a sanctuary in heaven (Hebrews 8:1-2) Jesus makes His sanctuary among His people collectively (2 Corinthians 6:16). Jesus makes His sanctuary in the individual believer (1 Corinthians 3:16). In the end, Jesus Himself will be God's sanctuary among His people (Revelation 21:22).

For all reasons, praise Jehovah. Praise him for his prowess; Praise him according to the multitude of his greatness. to. Praise Him for His prowess: These deeds of God are a reason to praise God everywhere. He has done great and powerful things, especially what Jesus accomplished on the cross and the empty tomb.

The singer of this psalm had only a vague knowledge of it, but the ultimate demonstration of God's power would come in the resurrection of Jesus (Ephesians 1:19-20). For this and his prowess, we should praise him." 'His prowess' could be translated as 'heroic [or, brave] deeds.' The reference is to his liberation from his people as a clear manifestation of conquering prowess or power."

Praise Him to the Sound of a Horn: The psalmist refers to an orchestra of

God's people and directs their music in praise of God. No instrument was to be left out. Brass, strings, winds, and percussion must unite in the praise of so great a God. There was good reason to mention the horn first on this long list. "The sound of the trumpet is associated with the grandest and most solemn events, such as the promulgation of the law, the proclamation of the jubilee, the coronation of the Jewish kings, and the fury of war. All that breathes praise JAH: This is a remarkably appropriate conclusion to this psalm and the entire Book of Psalms. Everything that breathes should give its praise to the One who gave it its breath. Every breath is God's gift, and praise is the worthy response we should give for that gift. "Let us praise the Lord with all our spirit." Hallelujah: The last line of the Book of Psalms could not be anything other than Hallelujah! Yahweh is to be praised and honored, and so it will be between His people and all creation.

WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT POSTNASAL DRIP

It is excess mucus that the nose and throat glands secrete that helps prevent the airways from drying. Mucus usually mixes with saliva harmlessly throughout the day and a person either swallows it or blows it out of the nose. It becomes more apparent if the body produces too much or too thick mucus.

CAUSES

* Allergies - the most common cause

* Cold weather or dry air

* Eating overly spicy food

* Pregnancy – due to an increase in blood volume and hormone fluctuations

* Irritating chemicals from perfumes, cleaning products or environmental fumes

* Medications including birth control and blood pressure

SYMPTOMS

* Need to clear your throat frequently * Sore throat, cough and raspy voice

* Nausea due to extra mucus in the stomach

* Bad breath

* A cough that worsens at night

* Excess mucus clogs eustachian tubes in the sinus passages causing painful ear infections

TREATMENT

* Saline nasal sprays will flush out mucus buildup

* Mucinex can help out by thinning the mucus

* If mucus buildup increases at night, prop your head up with pillows to promote drainage

* Drinking plenty of liquids can help thin mucus, keep it flowing smoothly and prevent dehydration

* Warm teas and broths can ease a sore throat and the steam may help clear sinuses.

Humidifiers or steam vaporizers can help clogged sinuses

* Bacterial infections require antibiotics

* Inhaling through a warm-damp cloth is a quick way to return moisture to the nose and throat.

* Do not use suppressants when experiencing a nagging, phlegm-filled cough. Coughing is the body's way of keeping secretions out of the lungs and throat. Spit out thick mucus rather than swallow it.

* Eucalyptus products subdue coughs and reduce mucus. Apply directly to the chest or add a few drops to a warm bath to help clear the nose. Do the same thing with Vicks vapor rub.

* Avoid smoking and secondhand smoke. It will cause the body to produce more phlegm and mucus

WHEN TO SEE A DOCTOR

* Discolored mucus that does not clear up

* Foul smelling mucus

* Symptoms that accompany a significant fever

* Symptoms lasting 10 days or more


In the scriptures there are support beams to hold up this truth... In Proverbs 17:22 "A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones."
