WHO WE ARE

Since 1964, in collaboration with community partners, Integrated Family Community Services (IFCS) has provided an immediate response to hunger, the most basic need. **IFCS has become a safety net to support families and children during difficult times** by providing food access to those who are hungry or facing food insecurity and other issues associated with poverty.

OUR BEGINNINGS

In 1964, south metro Denver resident Maida Navis noticed that some of her neighbors needed extra help. Working families were not making ends meet, neighborhood children went without necessities, and elderly residents were losing their independence. Mrs. Navis gathered neighborhood leaders for a “Neighbors Helping Neighbors” effort, forming the original **Inter-Faith Task Force for Community Services**. The task force provided services designed to help struggling neighbors achieve independent living.




IFCS TODAY

Over sixty years later, **Integrated Family Community Services** has become a well-known resource for those experiencing **inequities, food insecurity, and financial emergencies in the community**. Thankfully, the IFCS Food Market has become a staple of assistance for those who need it most:

- Providing both fresh and shelf-stable, culturally responsive foods, with no-cook meals for those who are unsheltered;
- Offering food source alternatives that allow IFCS to supply larger quantities, and more varied options, of high-value proteins;
- Creating a “market of choice” where participants may select the ingredients they most like and need, while reducing waste.

It is the **support of our community that allows IFCS to continue alleviating hunger.**

DID YOU KNOW?



According to the most recent hunger data*, Feeding America’s Map the Meal Gap study reveals:

- In 2023, 12.7% of Coloradans were food insecure. That’s 1 in 8 Coloradans.
- In 2023, 14.3% of Coloradan children were food insecure.
- Hundreds of thousands of children and families living in Colorado face hunger and food insecurity every day.
- Every county in our state is home to families who face hunger, including rural and suburban communities.
- Many households that experience food insecurity do not qualify for federal nutrition programs and rely on their local Feeding Colorado food banks and network of partner agencies for support.

IFCS’ service area includes various neighborhoods designated as “food deserts” and zip codes identified as having highest needs, as you can see by the maps below.**




Throughout FY 2024-25, an average of 4,000+ individuals were served each month at the Market @ IFCS.


IFCS is able to respond to great needs thanks to our team of volunteers and various funding sources.

** The USDA defines food deserts as areas with low access to supermarkets or grocery stores. The CNI measures economic and demographic data, creating an “index score” by measuring barriers to various socio-economic capital for each community at the zip code level.

- ★ You can bid the next increment, set a max bid, or build a “Watch” list to watch packages that you might be interested in bidding on later.
- ★ Select the link in the message; it will open your browser and take you directly to the bidder interface.
- ★ Enter your one-time login code and confirm when prompted.
- ★ Search packages by number, keyword, or category and select the package you wish to bid on. You can also click **All Items** to browse items by category
- ★ Click Details for more information on the item.
- ★ Click **Place Bid** to place a Fast Bid for the next amount or set a Max Bid. If your max bid is the highest, the system will automatically bid in your favor until you are outbid or until the silent auction closes. ***Setting a max bid is the best way to ensure you don't miss out on your favorite items!***
- ★ You will receive a text message whenever you are outbid on an item.
- ★ To create a wishlist of items - click on the heart icon to add the items to your favorites list.
- ★ To view your current bids - click **Menu - Auction - All Items - My Items**.
- ★ **NEW THIS YEAR!** Once you have made either a purchase and/or a donation you will see a shopping cart at the top of your screen with a red indicator. Click that link to review your purchases and check out.
- ★ You can use a credit card, Apple Pay or bank transfer for payment.
- ★ You will receive a receipt via email once your payment is processed.
- ★ If you prefer to pay with a check or if you have any questions – please visit the Bolder Events help desk.
- ★ The auction will close at 7:00PM MST just before the program begins.
- ★ Please ask any of our Concierge Bidders (wearing bright green lanyards) for help using your smartphone or to place a bid for you.
