Ann's vision is to build a space where people can explore creativity, connect with nature, build relationships, and discover new opportunities. Over time, the Creative Arts & Wellness Place will grow into a hub for recreation and accessible family getaways, bringing to life an environment that truly welcomes everyone.

Thanks to Ann's ongoing commitment, the project continues to move forward. We are now beginning Phase 2 of development, which will focus on building the exterior of an addition to the current building, laying the groundwork for what's to come. Future phases will complete the interior and introduce accessibility features that make the entire property accessible. Plans include lifts throughout the building, wheelchair-friendly pathways, including one leading directly to a dock so everyone can enjoy the lake as easily as the building itself, and a fully accessible kitchen and bathroom, ensuring that families can prepare meals, gather, and experience the serenity to its fullest. These long-term plans will help bring Ann's vision to life: a space where creativity, wellness, and belonging are at the heart of every visit.


