What is the ADRC

The Aging and Disability Resource Center, or ADRC, of Door County offers the general public a single source for information and assistance on issues affecting older people (age 60 and older) and people with disabilities (age 18 and older) regardless of their income. Our services are free and completely confidential. We are a welcoming place for you and your family to get information, advice, and access to a wide variety of services.

ADRC Specialists (ADRCs)

ADRC Specialist staff are available to meet with individuals and families to provide information on resources and services throughout the community. ADRC Specialists staff are able to provide non-biased Options Counseling in which the ADRC Specialists staff will provide specific resources and services after first listening to and discussing your wants and needs. Topics that ADRC Specialists staff have helped with include, but are not limited to housing, home care, youth transitioning into adult services, Long Term Care program assessments, transportation, dementia resources, and much more.

Elder Benefit Specialist (EBS)

The Elder Benefit Specialist (EBS) provides assistance for people who are over the age of 60, and are in need of public benefits or other programs. The EBS is able to help navigate the systems of Medicare, Medicare Part D, Medicare Saving Program, Senior Care, Medicaid, and Social Security. The EBS is also able to assist with finding your right plan during the Medicare open enrollment.

Disability Benefit Specialist (DBS)

The Disability Benefit Specialist (DBS) provides assistance for people who are 59 years old and under, and are in need of public benefits or other programs. The DBS is able to help navigate the systems of Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI), Supplemental Security Insurance (SSI), Medicare, Medicaid, and insurance options. The DBS is also able to assist with finding your right plan during the Medicare Open enrollment.
