

BCPC SIGNING DAY

The mission of the program is to provide an avenue for CTE students that have taken industrial-based courses in high school to have the opportunity to work in the industry.

APPLY

Prior to Career Signing Day, eligible students will have to complete an application consisting of a letter of recommendation, transcript, and student essay.

INTERVIEW

Afterward, students will be called to interview with several contractor companies. Over the past years, students had the opportunity to interview with four companies over the course of 4 hours. Based on the interviews, contractor companies will make offers to the students to start work after graduation.

SIGN

Over the past six years, the BCPC Career Signing Day has signed over 250 graduating high school seniors into fulltime craft careers that include on-the-job training and classroom instruction that often leads to professional certification

TIMELINE FOR 2025:

- High School Presentations Start: November 1, 2024
- Applications Due: February 14
- Interviews: March 25


