

# The clever thing about Bale Convoy?

## - it's in the details

### Revolutionary dual-arm technology meets practical logistics

Bale Convoy redefines the traditional bale handling process with its unique gripper system that handles two bales simultaneously. The gripper mechanism grabs the bales from both sides and lifts them safely onto the platform - an innovation that not only increases speed but transforms the entire working process.

### Collection and controlled unloading

The gripper arms ensure precise placement of the bales on the platform, after which the bales are guided backwards with a chain drive system. As more bales are loaded, the guide forks automatically adjust for optimal space utilisation on the trailer and stabilise the bales during loading.

The gripper arms hold the top bales in place whilst the trailer is tipped to a 90-degree unloading position. The push-off arms then push the tractor and trailer forward, ensuring precise placement of the bales in stable stacks, up to seven high - ready for collection without restacking.

## Flexible adaptation to your working method

Bale Convoy can be adapted to your preferred workflow. Do you work with a bale trailer on your baler? The powerful arms match perfectly if the bale trailer unloads two bales at a time, resulting in faster collection in the fields.

Bale Convoy's strong arms can be used to rotate the bales 90

degrees during collection, thereby maintaining a continuous flow. Between collecting each bale, it can lift the first bale clear of the ground during transport, so it doesn't get damaged or

The side shift function ensures better overview of the work and makes it possible to drive across the rows - resulting in fewer turns, less soil compaction and faster work.

Whichever method you choose, the machine ensures fast and efficient collection every time.

With a working productivity of up to 180 bales per hour and full control from the tractor cab, you get maximum efficiency without leaving your seat. When the bales are unloaded, it happens in a perfectly organised stack up to seven bales high - ready for collection without restacking.



### Efficient operation through smart design

With the side shift function, you can drive Bale Convoy across the rows without having to turn constantly. This saves the contractor time and protects the soil. When the stack is ready, even a standard front loader can handle the loading without the need for a telehandler - keeping logistics simple and flexible.

The bales can be loaded directly onto lorries with standard equipment, minimising waiting time and maximising efficiency throughout the entire chain.
