Gather friends, get family togeather, and indulge your tastebuds with luscious banquets and BBQ's.


Part of the house's rich and varied history, The School Room, at Ballyeriston, was used as a school for local children over 100 years ago.

Guests are even welcome to play the Piano if the mood strikes.



Keep an eye out for our natural inhabitants too.


Regular visitors include Wild Irish Hare, Deer, Birds of Prey, and


Red Squirrels.


