Our Junior School offers a rich and varied clubs programme designed to inspire, challenge and nurture every child. Clubs run predominantly after school: Reception – Year 2 finishing at 16:20 and Year 3 – 6 at 16:40, although some clubs for Years 3 – 6 and external provider options finish slightly later.

A wide selection of teacher-led clubs is offered free of charge, allowing pupils to explore new interests and develop new skills in a supportive and familiar environment. These include a strong STEM offer, such as Greenpower engineering, alongside technology focused clubs that encourage curiosity, problem-solving and creativity. Outdoor learning is a key feature of our provision, with opportunities through Adventure Club, gardening and outdoor exploration enabling children to build confidence, resilience and a sense of responsibility for the natural world. Practical life skills are also nurtured through cookery clubs, where pupils develop independence, teamwork and an understanding of healthy living.


These opportunities sit alongside an exciting range of specialist-led activities and together provide rich and varied experiences that further develop the PGS Skills and Core Values. Our Music Department offers age-and-stage appropriate ensembles and groups, ensuring children can develop their instrumental skills progressively. From beginners to confident performers, there are music clubs for all abilities, encouraging every child to experience the joy of making music together.

Sport is another key element of our provision. Our Sports Department runs a broad programme of clubs that promote teamwork, resilience and physical confidence. In addition, we offer the convenience of on-site external providers, with Ballet, Karate and Rugbymums available for families who wish to access specialist sessions delivered within our school facilities.



Our club options are organised across five enrichment strands: Academic & Self Enrichment, Physical Challenge & Exploration, Community & Pupil Voice, Creativity & Expression and Service & Leadership. This structure ensures a balanced and holistic offer that supports children's personal growth, curiosity, and character. Each term, pupils can choose from a diverse menu that reflects their interests, sparks new passions and helps them develop confidence beyond the classroom.

Together, our clubs programme enriches daily school life, encourages children to step beyond their comfort zone and enables them to develop skills and passions for life.



Wrap-around care

In addition to our teacher and external professional led clubs taking place after school, we also offer wraparound childcare options to support families needing greater flexibility with drop off and collection times. There is a free Breakfast Care and Morning Care provision from 07.30, with hot breakfast and lighter options available to purchase before 7.50am, and our popular Afterschool care provision (for a small fee per session) until 18:00 .
