Set in the quiet suburban area of Elderslie, at the foot of Gleniffer Braes, Adams House provides a supportive, caring and loving environment.

Our skilled and caring staff are on hand 24 hours a day to provide the care and support you need.

- Namaste care. This is a holistic approach to care for people living with advanced dementia, focussing on their emotional and physical wellbeing.

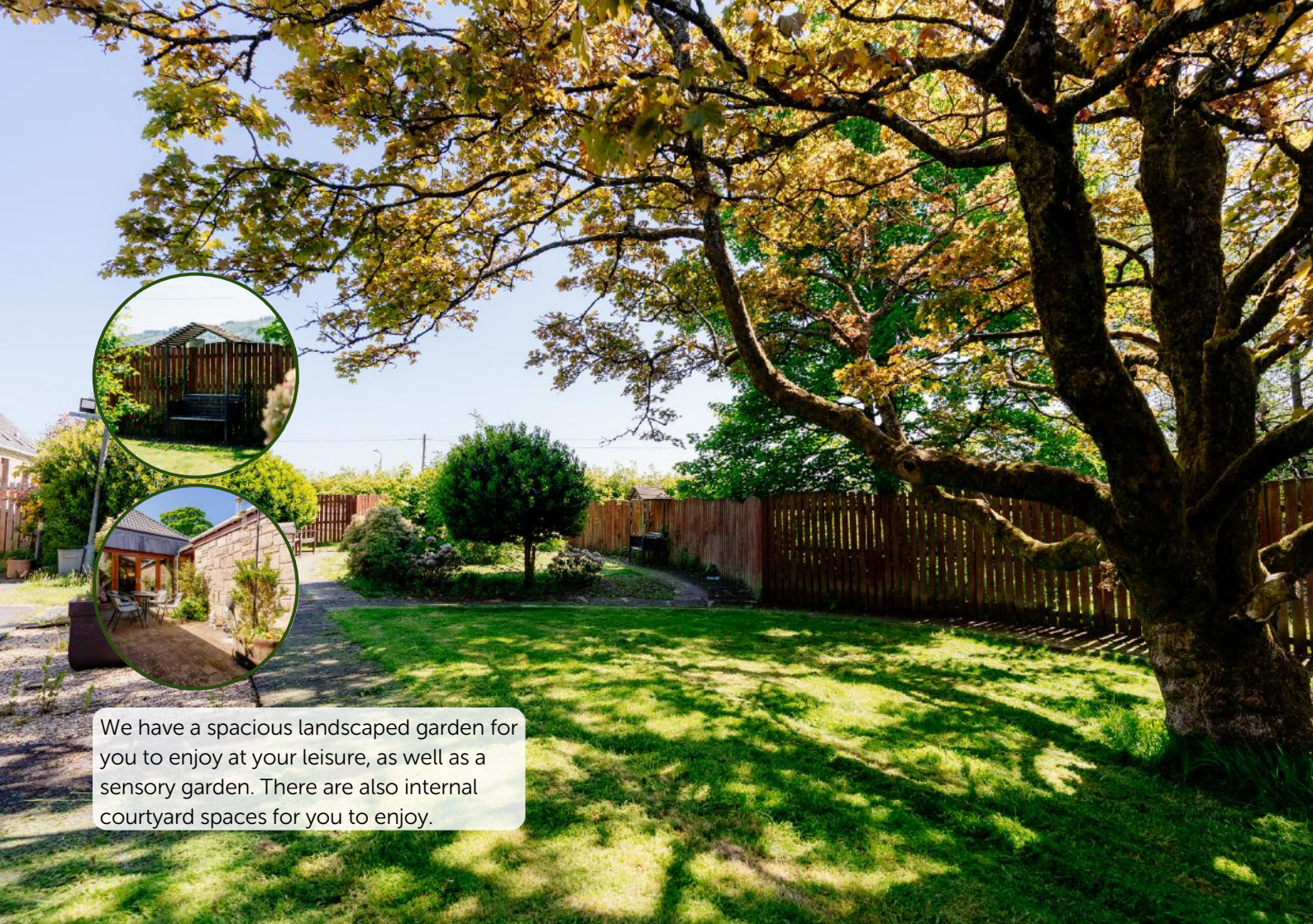
All 30 bedrooms have en-suite facilities.

There are several light and spacious lounges where you can relax, listen to music and socialise with other residents. We use the lounge spaces for most of our group activities and entertainment.







We have a spacious landscaped garden for you to enjoy at your leisure, as well as a sensory garden. There are also internal courtyard spaces for you to enjoy.



Within our specialist staff team we have dedicated Dementia Ambassadors. Who also have enhanced skills and knowledge in dementia care. Their role is to promote best practice, assist colleagues and provide a point of contact for families and carers.

We also host a monthly dementia clinic at Adams House. These are facilitated by our specialist dementia development team who are on hand to offer advice to staff, answer questions and provide support for families.

All staff are registered with the Scottish Social Services Council and undertake regular training with a specific focus on dementia care.



When you come to live in Adams House you will be introduced to your keyworker who will work with you to develop a personal care plan to meet your interests, preferences and support needs.
