# **PUC Summer Experience**

PacificQuest programs for grades 6-12. Each program is a week-long summer intensive held on the PUC campus. Students participate in academic programming with daily worship, recreational opportunities, team-building exercises, and evening activities.

Students who complete the program earn 1 unit of college credit.













**STEM I Program:** Students will participate in daily academic programming focused on engineering, zoology, and creative writing classes taught by PUC professors.

#### PQRise - June 30-July 5, 2024, grades 9-11

**STEM II Program:** Students will participate in daily academic programming focused on marine science and art classes taught by PUC professors at the Albion Field Station.

#### PQTune - June 23-28, 2024, grades 8-12

**String Orchestra Program:** Intermediate and advanced string students will have an immersive and fun enrichment experience alongside other musicians during this orchestral intensive.

#### PQSoar - June 23-28, 2024, grades 9-12
