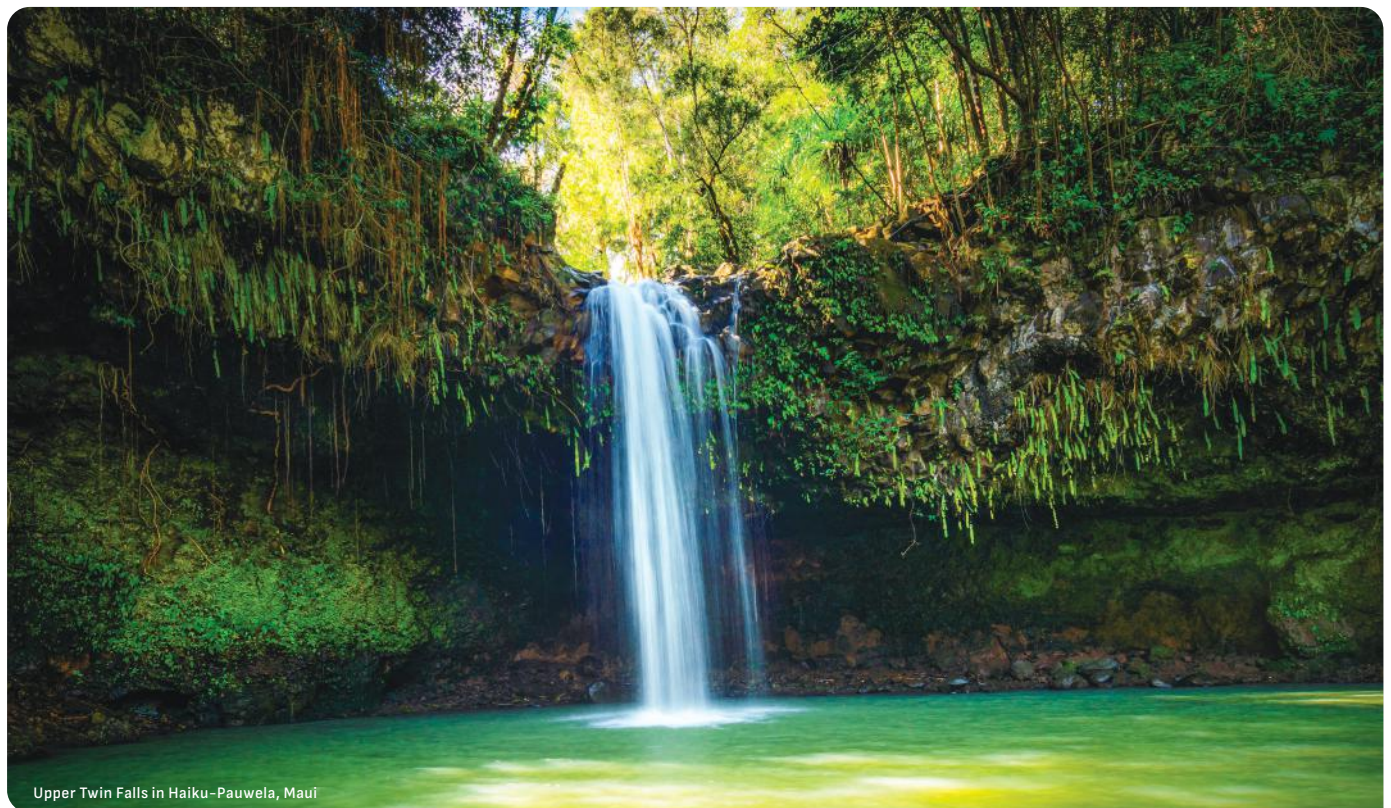

TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

Like anywhere in the Northern Hemisphere, the summer months (June, July and August) are the most popular, but also the most crowded. For this reason, the spring and autumn months are recommended, due to their mild climate and fewer people to contend with.

There's never a bad time to visit the USA West Coast, as you'll find sunny days year-round in California. The middle of summer (July to August) can get extremely hot in Las Vegas, but the casinos are all air-conditioned, and the Grand Canyon, despite being in the desert, gets snow each winter (January to March).

If you are planning to travel in winter, then head to Florida, which experiences the sunniest winter weather on the East Coast.

TIME

California, Nevada, Washington state and Oregon (Pacific Coast Time) are 20–21 hours behind New Zealand, depending on Daylight Saving Time, which is observed from mid-March to early-November. Arizona and Utah follow Mountain Standard Time (1 hour earlier), but do not observe Daylight Saving Time.

The Eastern and Southern states of the USA are 16–18 hours behind New Zealand, depending on Daylight Saving Time, which is observed from mid-March to the beginning of November each year.

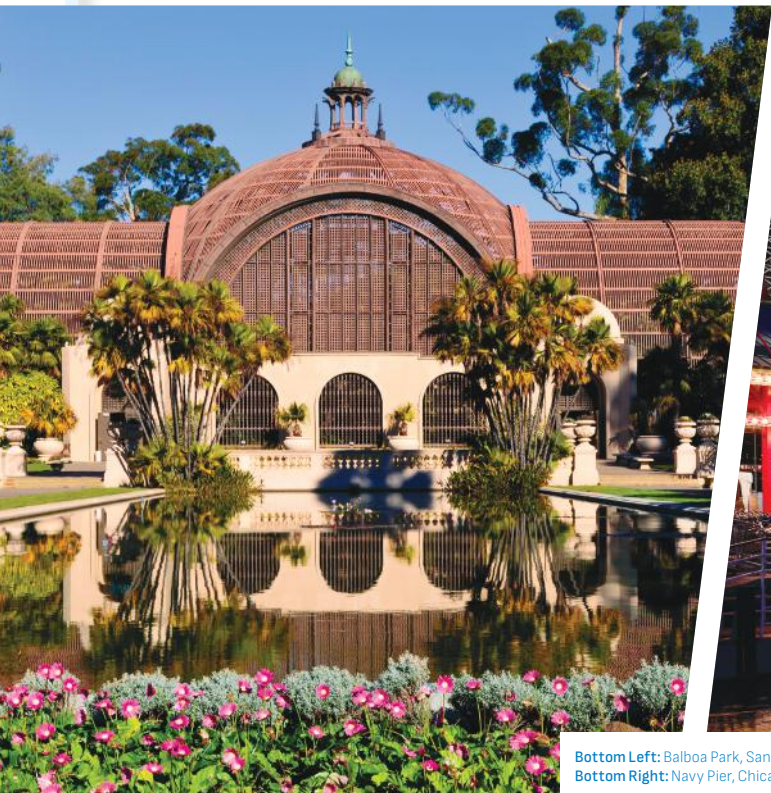

Fortress of Solitude – San Francisco

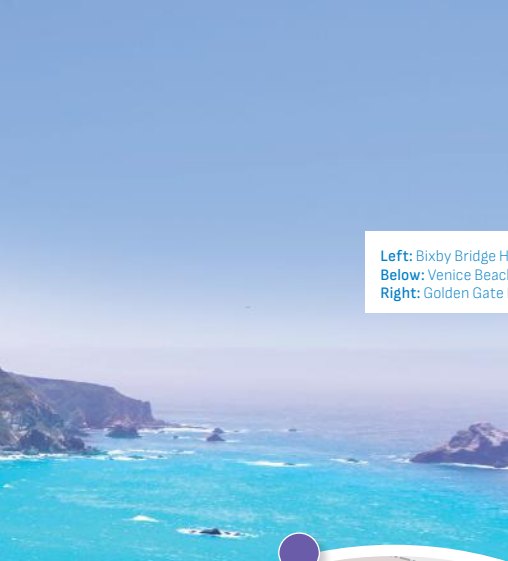

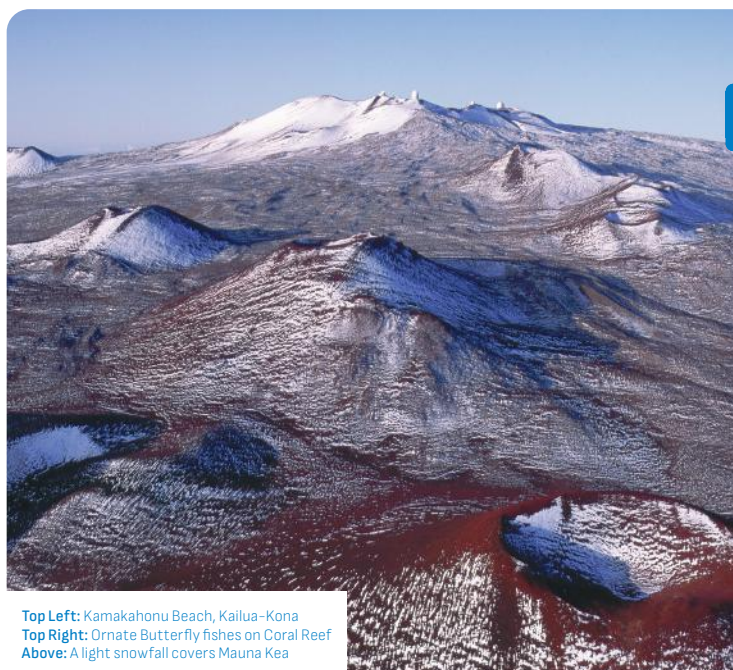

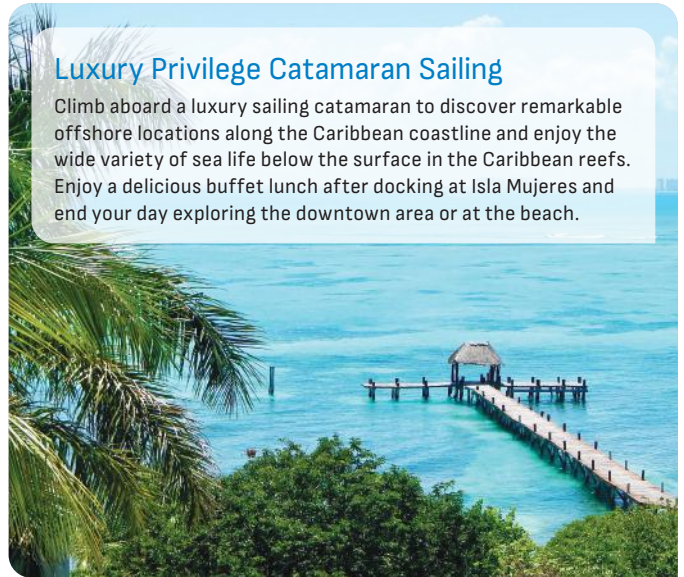

Subject to any rights and/or remedies you may have under the Australian Consumer Law, we cannot be held responsible or liable for any errors, omissions, interruptions (for example, aircraft substitutions, renovations occurring at hotels, swimming pool closures, accommodation inclusions or changes to inclusions, resort fees payable, breakdowns, repairs, upgrade or maintenance of systems), or inaccurate, misleading or untrue information or non-delivery of information by the travel service provider. GOVERNING LAW: If any dispute arises between you and us, the laws of Australia will apply. You irrevocably and unconditionally submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Australia and waive any right that you may have to object to an action being brought in those courts.
