Question: What's the most effective way to promote responsible gambling?

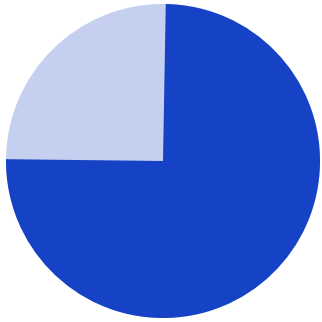

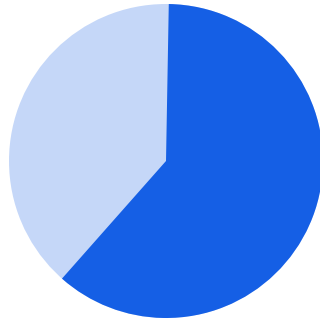
Purpose: To understand which methods people believe are best for encouraging safe gambling behaviour.

Poll Results (%)

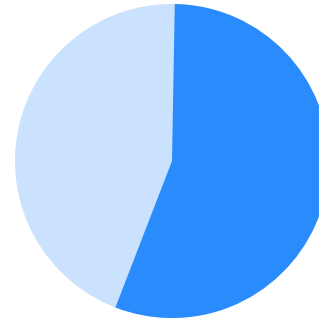

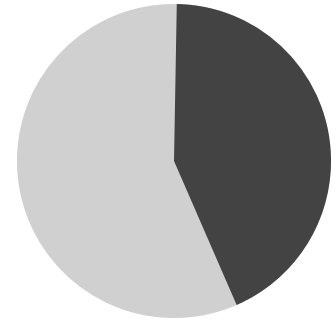

Most voters prefer real-time reminders and limits inside games to prevent risky behaviour.

What This Tells Us

1

Real-time action is preferred: Gamblers and stakeholders want tools that work while the game is being played.

2

Education still matters: Nearly 1 in 3 believe teaching people about gambling risks is essential.

3

Policy is important: Regulations are seen as useful, but less so than direct intervention.

4

Self-exclusion tools may need more awareness or improvement.

What's Next?

For operators and educators

Include clear in-game alerts and spending limits. Share easy-to-understand educational content. Work with regulators to enforce fair play. Improve access and visibility of self-exclusion tools.

A Key Question for Future Research

Why do so few people believe in self-exclusion tools (only 8%)? Are they hard to access? Do users lack trust in them? Are they poorly promoted?

Promoting responsible gambling needs a mix of smart tools, good education, and a deep understanding of player behaviour.
