GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THE SHOW COVERING ALL SECTIONS

1. Entries should be emailed to blakesleyshow@gmail.com and entry fees transferred to the bank account detailed on the entry forms using the reference Name/Class No. The closing date for online, email and postal entries is Friday 24th July 2026. Please note that entries received after Wednesday 15th July will not appear in the printed Programme. Entries may be made on the day in Equestrian classes but may be subject to an additional fee. **No late entries will be accepted in any Sheep class.**
2. Prizes will be awarded as follows: if 3 or less catalogued entries in a class, 1st prize only; if 5 or less, 1st and 2nd prize only awarded.
3. All competitors must be on the showground at least half an hour before judging commences.
4. All objections must be lodged in writing with the Secretary within half an hour of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £10 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld. This rule only applies to classes not run under other Societies Rules.
5. Trade Exhibitors will be admitted to the Show only on production of an Exhibitor pass which will admit ONE person only. If additional guest passes are required, these can be purchased at a cost of £10 (inc. VAT) each. Trade exhibitors should contact the Trade Secretary to purchase additional guest passes.
6. Competitors in Equestrian and Livestock classes will be issued with two Exhibitor passes. If additional guest passes are required, these can be purchased at a cost of £10 (inc. VAT) each. Please contact the Secretary to purchase additional guest passes.
7. Dogs are permitted on the Showground **but must be kept on a lead at all times.** Dogs are not permitted inside the Member's marquee, with the exception of registered assistance dogs. However, Members' dogs are able to access the Members' lawn area

provided they are kept under the control of their owners. Any dog causing a nuisance will be required to leave.

8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and its decision on all matters shall be final.
9. The Committee reserves the right to make any adjustment in the order of the Schedule if necessary.
10. No exhibit may leave the Showground before 4pm without the consent of the Committee.
11. As a One Day, Open-Air Show, there is NO requirement for pre or post movement TB testing under **current** DEFRA regulations.
12. BCMS require all cattle exhibitors to record movements to and from the showground in cattle passports. Showground Holding Number 29/307/8000
13. All senior bulls must have nose rings fitted.
14. Handlers of senior bulls must be aged 16 years or over.
15. Every horse and pony being shown is liable to be dope tested.
16. Every rider who is mounted must wear a hard hat at all times which complies with relevant safety standards and back protectors are strongly recommended (and mandatory in some classes).
17. Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses attending the Blakesley Show. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 – 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old. This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the Showing Council and ASAO websites. Blakesley Show reserves the right to carry out spot checks, so please ensure that in accordance with regulations your horse/pony passport accompanies them to the show.
18. All exhibitors should carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property. The company does not accept any liability for accident, damage, loss, injury, or illness to owners, horses, riders, livestock, spectators, trade stands or any other persons or property.
19. If any section of the Show is cancelled before the closing date for entries, 50% of entry fees will be refunded.
20. The Show will be adhering to all current Public Health Guidance and reserves the right to restrict entries should classes become oversubscribed.

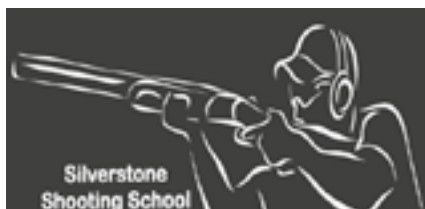

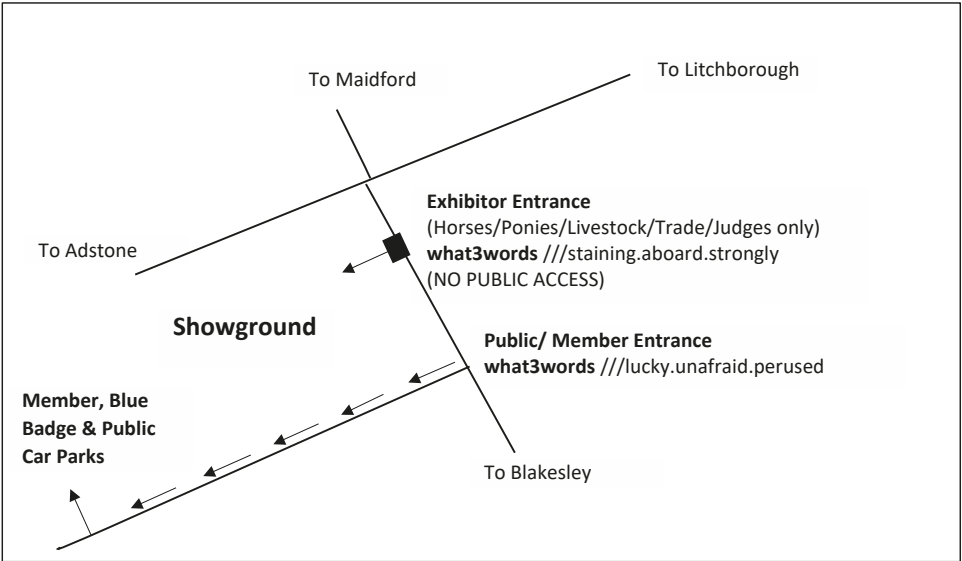
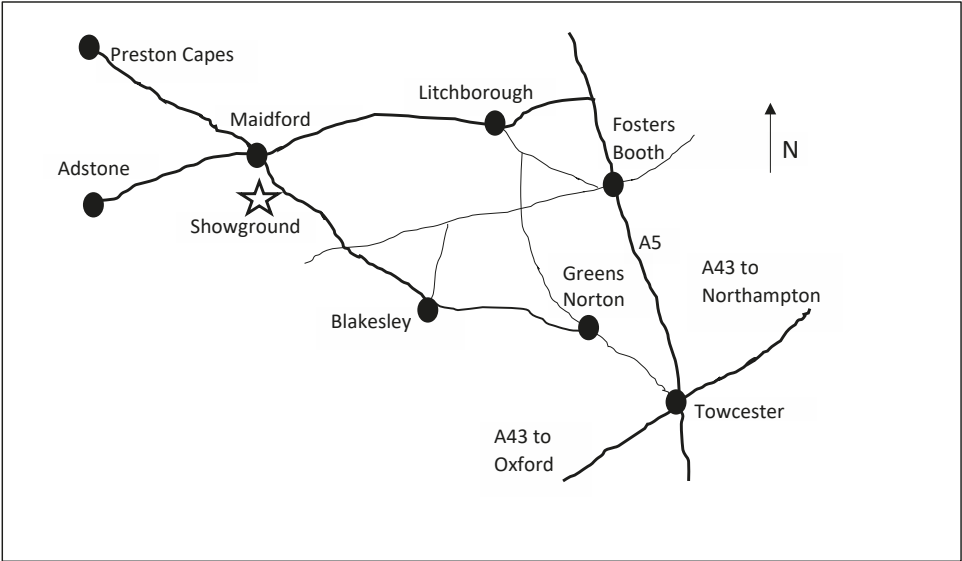

BSPS

The Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and is a qualifier for the following: -

- BSPS Championships
- BSPS Thor Atkinson Steel Fabrications Ltd Challenge
- BSPS Anthony Evans Insurance Champion of Champions
- BSPS Summer Championship Show

BSPS New Horizon Plastics Heritage Ridden

The Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and is a qualifier for the New Horizon Plastics BSPS Heritage Ridden Championship Show at Arena UK.

1st, 2nd & 3rd prize winners from classes 42-45 will qualify for the semi-final (qualification will not pass down the line). **Ponies, Owners & Riders must be BSPS Members to compete in classes 42-45.**

BSPS London International Showing Series supported by Horse & Hound

– LIHS 2026 17th – 21st December

The Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing, or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS, are subject to the Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

The show is a qualifier for the London International Horse Show 2026. Only one pony in each of classes **4 to 9** and classes **52 to 56** will qualify. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first three ponies in each class will qualify. Non-members of the BSPS have seven days to complete their registration and membership to keep the qualification. If not, this will pass to the next exhibitor.

The BSPS Performance Coloured Classes are open to mares, geldings and CHAPS(UK) or BSPA graded stallions, 4 years old or over to be registered in and complying with the showing requirements of the main body of the stud book of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society (CHAPS(UK)) or the British Skewbald and Piebald Association (BSPA). Ponies can be registered with either of these societies or BSPS, and owners and riders must be, or become, members of the BSPS within 7 days to take the qualification.

BSHA London International Showing Series supported by Horse & Hound

– LIHS 2026 17th – 21st December

Competitors and horses must hold a minimum of LIHS Qualifier-Eligible Membership/ Horse Registration with the Association to be eligible to compete in the LIHS BSHA Showing series.

Any competitor who qualifies for a LIHS Showing Series Supreme Final, must then complete full LIHS Qualified registration within 14 days of qualification for their qualification to stand, or it will pass to the next eligible exhibit (the nominal cost of Qualifier-Eligible membership will be taken off the cost of Full LIHS registration). Any competitors/ horses which have existing BSHA membership / registration for 2026 will not be required to complete any LIHS Membership / Registration for these classes.

BSHA LIHS RISING STAR CLASSES 2026

Please note: Rising Star Amateur Rules 2026 are separate from BSHA Amateur rules in the main BSHA Rulebook. Please see the separate Rising Star Rulebook in the Rising Star section available on the BSHA website.

If you are in any doubt regarding your Rising Star Amateur status, please contact the BSHA Office directly, to have your status confirmed.

Classes **1, 2, 10, 12, 46, 48, 49, 50 and 51** qualify for LIHS BSHA Showing Series Supreme Finals at the London International Horse Show, highest placed unqualified in top five to qualify.

A results points table will run for all qualifying classes, and a 'wild card' will be awarded to those unqualified with the highest points in each section following the final qualifier. The Judge will NOT ride exhibits in these classes or at the Finals.

Retraining of Racehorses (RoR)

The Show is affiliated to Retraining of Racehorses (RoR). Class 47 is a qualifier for The Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree in August 2027.

The Showing Register

The Show is affiliated to The Showing Register (TSR) Amateur of the Year Final, taking place at Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire on 28th and 29th November 2026. The two highest placed **Amateurs** not already qualified in each affiliated class (classes 57-68) will qualify.

Competitors do not need to be Members to qualify – TSR membership **will be required** to compete in the final.

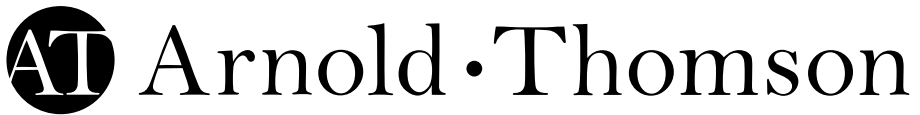
