Oxford Falls Grammar is a school with an inspiring and dynamic foundation that celebrates Christian faith in many ways.

hrough active involvement in a caring and vibrant Christian community, students gain authentic experiences as they see Christianity lived in practice. Under the guidance of our Dean of Ministry, Chaplains and Christian Studies teachers, students develop into self-aware, respectful and compassionate adults.

In the classroom, our contemporary Christian Studies program engages students from Kindergarten, as they explore how God connects with people in a meaningful and purposeful way.

Our ministry team deliver the Chapel Program, facilitate Christian courses, connect groups and organise prayer meetings. These activities ensure our students have a relevant and positive experience of the Christian faith. Our School Community Chaplain also has a significant ministry with our parent community including supporting families and staff facing a challenging season.

Outreach

Our Christian ethos is meaningfully demonstrated through the OFG Outreach program, a Kindergarten to Year 12 philanthropic initiative that raises money for families and communities across Australia and Asia.

In Years 10 and 11, students have the opportunity to participate in an annual overseas mission trip, fostering a strong culture of generosity.

Expansive Grounds

Nestled in the hinterland of Sydney's Northern Beaches, we have some of the finest school grounds in the area.

ur spacious Junior and Senior School campuses are thoughtfully designed to enhance students' learning, social experiences and physical activity.

The Junior School features the Southwell Oval, an adventure playground, basketball court and a dedicated play area for Kindy to Year 2, providing our youngest students with a fun and safe space to grow. Senior School students benefit from flexible learning environments, including fully equipped Science laboratories and specialist Visual Arts, Technological and Applied Studies workshops for electronics, woodwork, plastics, Textiles and Design and Food Technology.

Our Performing Arts Precinct includes purpose-built dance and drama studios, music tuition rooms, a production studio and a dedicated rehearsal room for concert and stage bands. The Sports Precinct adds further excellence with additional basketball courts, a fitness centre, a grass oval for recreation and a large undercover car park.



Building Confidence

Through the 'OFG Way', students build essential learning dispositions and character traits by sharing a unified language centered on respect, learning and growth. Ensuring all individual learning needs are met, our Learning Support program provides a warm and inclusive environment for students needing additional support.

Junior School students proudly participate in a variety of local, national and global outreach initiatives. They research and present information on relevant causes and services for Oxford Falls Grammar to support. This integration of inquiry-based learning with a compassionate mindset shows students how a culture of generosity can

positively impact other people's lives and their community. Through the Oxford Falls Grammar Outdoor Education program, students develop a deep appreciation for the environment while experiencing the great outdoors in safe, sustainable ways. Each camp is designed to build a student's resilience and encourages collaboration through positive interactions with peers and nature.

Camino Program

The Camino Program at Oxford Falls Grammar nurtures high potential and high achieving students beginning in Kindergarten with the early recognition of students' strengths and talents. Specialist teachers lead extension classes that encourage creative, divergent and higher-level thinking. For Years 5 and 6, we offer dedicated classes designed to inspire students who excel academically, helping them realise their full potential.









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A Culture of Academic Excellence

Oxford Falls Grammar's Senior School provides an education that is rigorous, engaging and forward thinking.

e empower our students to aspire, learn and work to achieve their full potential. We set high expectations to promote a positive-growth mindset and encourage confidence and self-belief as students push through comfort zones to obtain new knowledge and skills.

In the Senior School, students embark on a challenging and stimulating curriculum that offers a breadth and depth of study, with access to a large range of courses including accelerated coursework.

Students build intellectual confidence through the development of critical analysis and creative thinking as they pursue their educational areas of interest. Senior School students are placed into mentor groups under the care of Year Advisors and Mentors who

are responsible for the academic progress and wellbeing of their students and are the first point of communication with parents. At Oxford Falls Grammar, we recognise that student wellbeing is integral to their development and we are committed to nurturing well-rounded individuals who grow in resilience, independence and integrity. To ensure all individual learning needs are met, our specialist Learning Support teachers provide direct and timely assistance to students that require additional support.

Life in the Oxford Falls Grammar Senior School is both exciting and rewarding, as students are encouraged to pursue academic and personal excellence whilst observing Oxford Falls Grammar's ethos of For Greatness, For Excellence, For Christ.

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Our Camino Program continues through Senior School from Years 7-10 and offers appropriate differentiation for our high potential and high achieving students.

Dance

Additionally, students in Years 9 to 12 have the option to pursue dance as an elective curriculum subject with specialist teachers.

Music

At Oxford Falls Grammar, whether your child is drawn to guitar, percussion, woodwind, vocals or brass instruments, there are a variety of ensembles and performance groups to cater to their musical passions. In Years 9 to 12 Music can be taken as an elective curriculum subject.

Students develop voice and movement skills to create character and mood while building self-confidence through acting techniques. Students have opportunities to perform through the year and can also engage in interschool competitions. In Years 9 to 12, Drama can be taken as an elective curriculum subject.

Join our Community

Oxford Falls Grammar is a co-educational, Christian school that welcomes all students through our Open Enrolment policy.

Enrolment Process

1. Apply

Our main points of entry are Kindergarten, Year 3, Year 5 and Year 7; however, we accept applications for all years.

To apply:

- Complete our online Enrolment Application form;
- ✓ Upload supporting documentation; and
- Pay the non-refundable application fee of \$330 (incl GST) per child.

2. Review Process

Stage 2 of the enrolment process is the collection of recent information about your child or children such as recent school reports or NAPLAN results. The Registrar will be in contact to retrieve this information. An Enrolment Committee, consisting of executive and teaching staff from both Junior and Senior School, will review all enrolment applications. After reviewing applications, some families may be invited for a formal interview. Please note; being on the waitlist does not guarantee an interview or offer of enrolment.
