

Our Bristol In Focus programming begins with a screening of the 1950 adaptation of Treasure Island. This swashbuckling adventure begins with scenes shot on location in Bristol's Floating Harbour, and also includes Geoffrey Keen among the cast, who was educated locally and made his stage debut in the city.

Besides the local links, this was Disney's first ever fully live-action film and the first colour adaptation of Robert Louis Stevenson's novel, making it a notable milestone in pop culture history as the studio moved beyond its animation roots – plus Robert Newton's legendary performance as Long John Silver has forever linked the West Country accent with "pirate talk"...!

The Titfield Thunderbolt tells the story of villagers trying to keep their local railway running in the face of closure by British Railways; their misadventures

are the epitome of the quintessential, mildly anarchic wit of Ealing Comedies. The film was shot on the recently closed Camerton Branch of the Bristol and North Somerset Railway, and even features Temple Meads doubling in for a fictional station. It's a winning combination of local history and the spiritedness that defines the Ealing hallmark.

You can't get much more "Bristol In Focus" than Clive Donner's slice-of-life drama *Some People!* Shot entirely on location in Bristol and showcasing everywhere from South Bristol Baths to Lockleaze – and even featuring a test flight of the Bristol 188 – it's a time capsule view into a bygone era of the city.

Besides the fascinating reminder of 60s Bristol, it's also a snapshot of early 60s teen culture, as seen through the eyes of Kenneth More's aeronautical engineer-turned-youth worker (and as commissioned by the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme!). Our Bristol In Focus programme in the Lexus Pavilion programme continues with the film noir classic *The Third Man*. Joseph Cotton and Orson Welles lead this murky drama that winds through the streets and sewers of post-WWII Vienna (filmed almost entirely on location), but Trevor Howard steals every scene as the irritable Major Calloway, who becomes embroiled in the conspiracy surrounding the death of an American in suspicious circumstances.

Howard was educated at Clifton College, just down the road from The Mall Gardens, and there is a plaque in his honour on the nearby Redgrave Theatre. He called *The Third Man* his proudest achievement in a long and diverse career spanning over 100 films – so it feels fitting to include this seminal piece of British cinema history in our Bristol In Focus lineup.



Saturday's programming in Screen 2 begins with a 40th anniversary of An American Tail, Steven Spielberg's first foray into animation (as executive producer). Directed by Don Bluth (The Land Before Time, Anastasia) and with an Oscar-nominated James Horner score, it's an odyssey that's both magical and moving, and sure to tug at the heartstrings.

Follow young mouse Fievel as he and his family emigrate to the USA in the late 19th Century, only for him to become separated in a freak accident en route. 


